Project overview

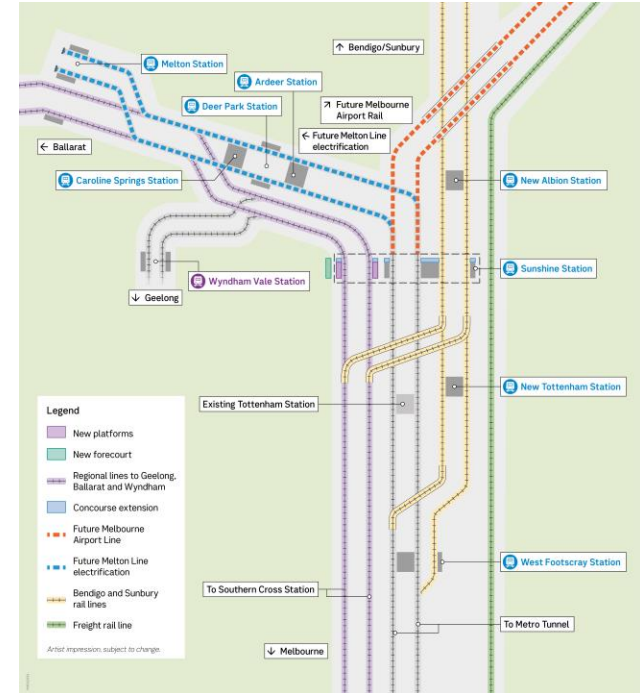


The West Footscray to Albion Rail Upgrade is funded by the Australian and Victorian governments and is the first stage of Melbourne Airport Rail. It will also enable the future electrification of the Melton Line.

The program of works spans 6 kilometres from West Footscray to Albion to untangle this complex rail junction, making way for a rail line to Melbourne Airport. The project includes:

- turning Sunshine Station into a superhub
- two new rail bridges
- a new rail underpass
- new and upgraded tracks
- new signalling technology
- realigned passenger and freight lines
- a new modern and accessible Tottenham Station
- a new modern and accessible Albion Station.

The West Footscray to Albion Rail Upgrade is now underway and will be complete in 2030.

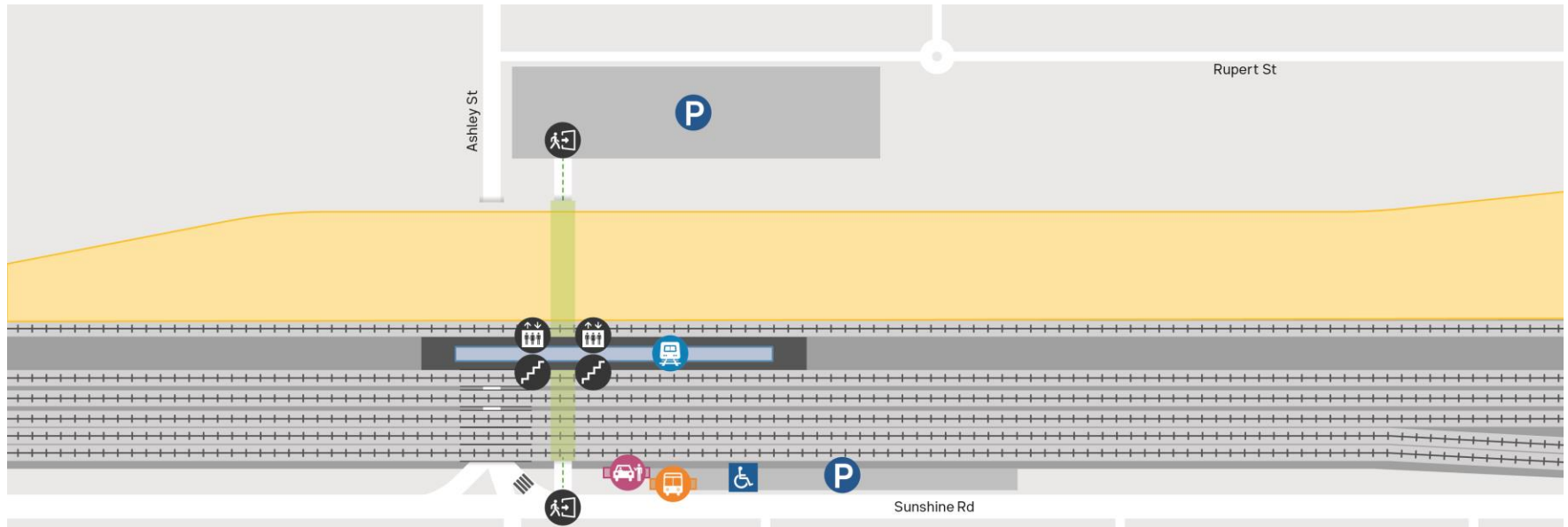


New station location, on the realigned Sunbury Line

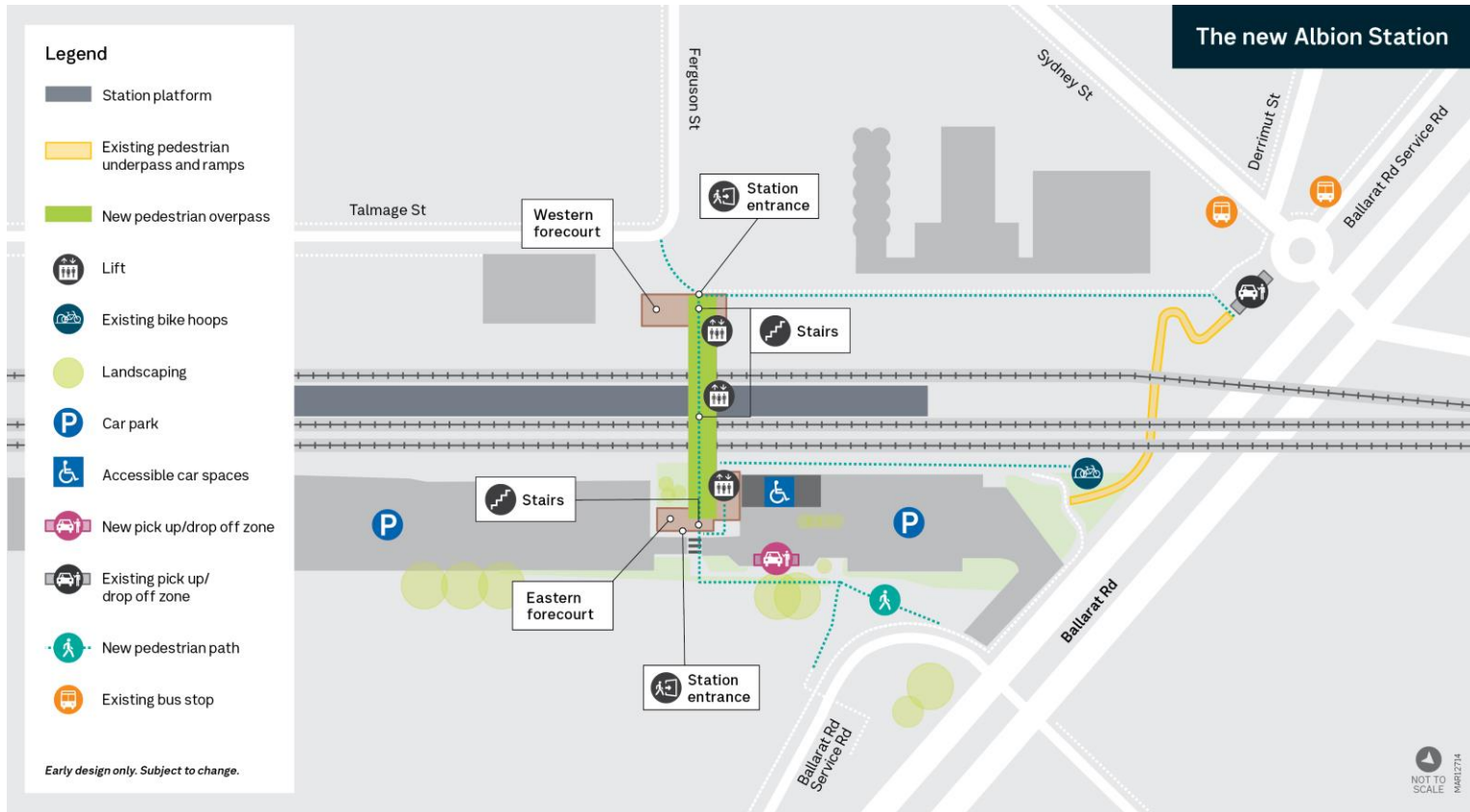
