

Untangling the City Loop so more trains can run more often across Melbourne




The proposed Suburban Rail Loop is a new underground rail network connecting Melbourne's suburbs.

Up to 13 minute faster trips to the Port of Melbourne




Up to 20 minutes in travel time savings between the city and Melbourne's west






WGTP TIMELINE






CONSTRUCTION TIMELINE - WEST GATE FREEWAY












