## Day/night works

### Start of tunnelling activities at Freeway Golf Course, Balwyn North

We've started moving close to 100 above and underground services such as power, water, gas, sewerage and telecommunications to make way for North East Link.

CPB Contractors will start tunnelling activities at Freeway Golf Course, Balwyn North, from **Tuesday 20 April 2021** to support construction of the Yarra East Main Sewer (YEMS).

#### What we'll be doing

Ongoing works include:

- Assembling the mini Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM) to prepare for the start of tunnelling works for the YEMS
- Installing a crane to assemble the mini TBM at the launch shaft
- Continuing construction of the reticulation sewer and the mini TBM launch shaft
- Lifting the mini TBM into position in the launch shaft
- Starting ongoing tunnelling operations in an easterly direction.

#### When are we working?

Tunnelling activities will commence on **Tuesday 20 April 2021** and will continue until **Mid 2021**.

24 hour operations **6am Monday to 6pm Saturday**, from **Tuesday 20 April until Saturday 8 May**.

Work hours will then increase to 24/7 continuous operations, from **6am Monday 10 May 2021 until Mid 2021**.

#### What to expect

During these works you may notice:

- Work crews in the area
- Light from the work site

- Noise from machinery and equipment, such as an excavator, bobcat, generator, slurry separation unit and vehicles
- Dust from the work site.

#### Managing impacts

CPB Contractors are committed to minimising construction impacts for residents and the community and will implement the following mitigation measures where appropriate:

- Covering loads on trucks, when transporting excavated material and clean fill
- Directional lighting to avoid light spill
- Dust suppression using water carts and binding agents
- Use of rumble grids on roads to reduce the transfer of dirt on local roads
- Noise control equipment and sound blankets may be used on machinery and tools
- Tree protection zones to retain as many trees as possible.

Our community engagement team will be onsite and available to assist residents during the works. Safety is our priority and we ask for your assistance with obeying instructions, signage, and maintaining social distancing during the coronavirus pandemic.

The phasing of these works is indicative only and subject to change within the times specified in the works notification.
