Day/night works

Road closure and service relocation works on Moorwatha Street, Macleod

We're continuing works to relocate utility services before major construction of North East Link starts in late 2021.

We previously notified you that works to connect the new water pipes on Moorwatha Street would start in mid-April. These works were delayed and will now begin next week.

What we are doing

These works will involve:

- Excavating a small section of Moorwatha Street near the intersection of Greensborough Road
- Connecting new water pipes installed earlier this year with the water supply network
- Reinstating the road surface at the intersection of Moorwatha Street and Greensborough Road.

When are we working

Works will take place for eight weeks from **Monday 10 May** until **early July**. Normal working hours are **7am to 6pm** on weekdays and **7am to 1pm** on Saturdays.

Please note 24 hour works will also be required from early to mid June and we will be in contact with adjacent residents in advance with more information.

What to expect

During these works you may notice:

- Moorwatha Street will be closed between Wilmot Street and Greensborough Road with local detours in place (see map overleaf)
- Short term lane closures northbound on Greensborough Road with reduced speed limits
- Traffic management, personnel and signage in place to assist with access

- Pedestrian footpaths will remain open near work areas
- Access to the Greensborough Road Early Learning and Kinder will be available off Greensborough Road
- Construction vehicles and trucks accessing Moorwatha Street via Erskine Road and Wilmot Street
- Usual rubbish collection and postal/delivery services will be maintained for residents adjacent work areas, however hard rubbish collection will be unavailable
- Temporary parking restrictions to allow construction vehicles and trucks to navigate through the area
- Restricted driveway access for some properties on Moorwatha Street. We will be in contact with affected residents in advance with more information.

Managing impacts


CPB Contractors are committed to minimising construction impacts for residents and the community and will implement the following mitigation measures where appropriate:

- Noise control equipment and sound blankets may be used on machinery and tools
- Detours will be in place to safely direct road users, cyclists and pedestrians around the works
- Designated access route to site for construction vehicles and trucks
- Dust suppression measures including the use of water carts and binding agents

Health and safety
