

Works Notification

Site Investigations

Park Street and Kings Way intersection,
South Melbourne

December 2021

Utility investigations are taking place to help inform future tram works associated with the Metro Tunnel Project

Rail Projects Victoria will conduct night time utility investigations at the intersection of Park Street and Kings Way (see map overleaf).

What we are doing

Phase 1

Utility detection surveys along Park Street, from Clarendon Street to Kings Way, will include:

- A mobile team of a few site workers with laser scanners and traffic management to protect workers
- These low impact works will take up to **five nights**.

Phase 2

Works at the intersection of Park Street and Kings Way will include:

- CCTV and laser scanning of the Hanna Street main drain via access to maintenance holes within the intersection
- Non-destructive digging (NDD) involving use of a vacuum truck to excavate carefully into the ground
- These works will take up to **two nights**.

What to be aware of

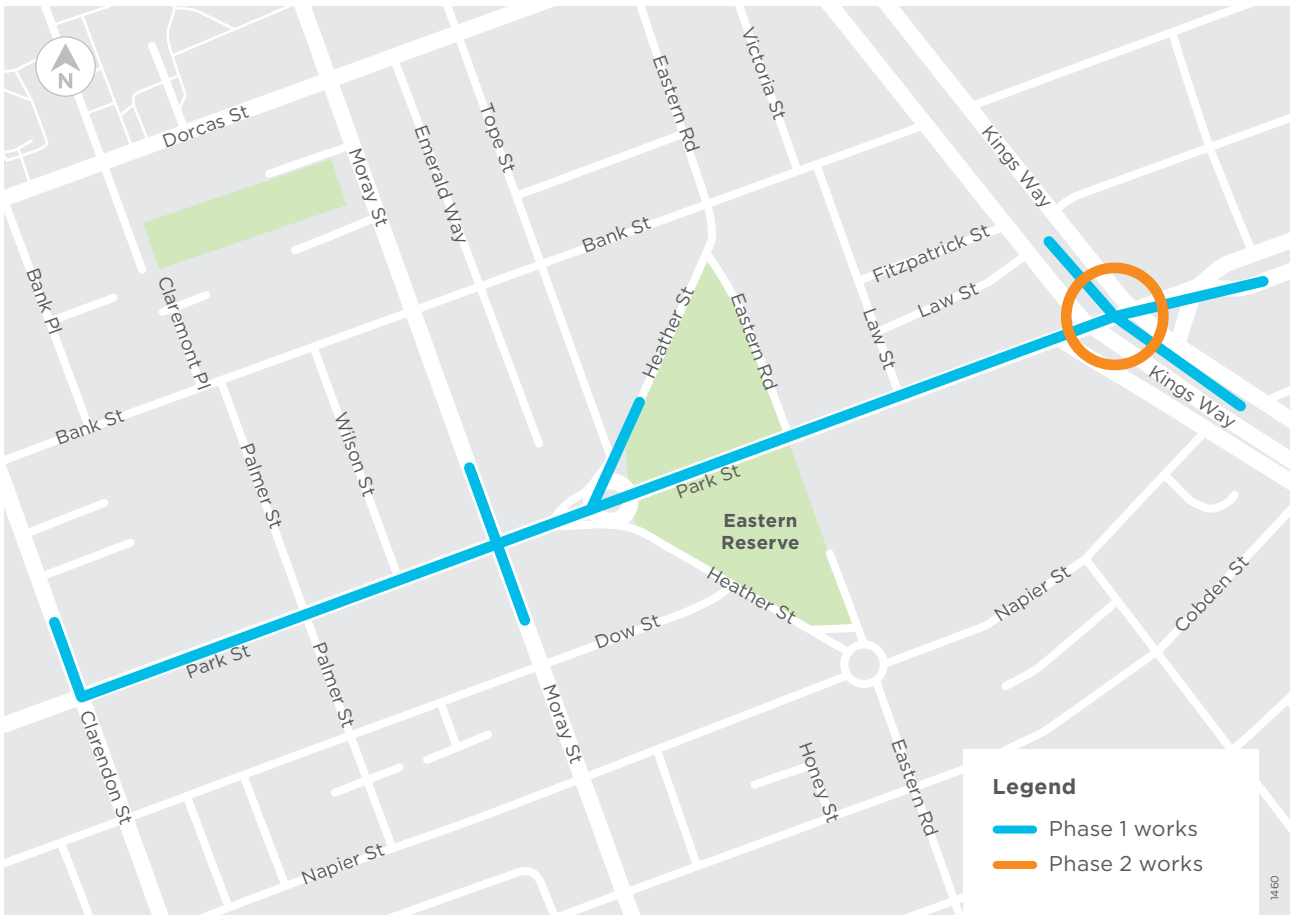
- These works are expected to generate low to moderate levels of noise
- Temporary traffic changes along Kings Way and Park Street
- The speed limit will be reduced to 40 km/h around the worksite
- Traffic controllers and signage will be in place to assist with pedestrian and vehicle access and wayfinding
- All works will be conducted in line with strict COVID-19 protocols which are being updated regularly based on the latest government advice.

When

Works will begin around 13 December and take up to seven days.

The works will take place outside peak traffic periods and during weeknights, from 9 pm to 5 am, to avoid adverse disruption to traffic in the area.

The timing of these works may change depending on weather and ground conditions.
