How to post on your Business Profile

Step one: Log in to the Google account you use for your Business Profile.

Step two: Open your Business Profile by entering your business name in the search bar.

Step three: Click *Promote* and choose the type of post that you want to create.

Step four: In the dialogue box, write your post.

Step five: To see a preview of your post, click *Preview*.

Step six: To publish your post click *Publish* in the top right. If you want to change your post, in the top left, click *Back*.
