Millers Road - Spring Campaign



Phase 1 of works undertaken from 19 August to 16 September 2022

Inbound entry ramp works completed:

- Pavement rectifications works - asphalt placed on ramp and tied into Millers Rd
- Guardrail installation
- Drainage improvement works
- Eastern Shared Use Path poured under WGF – completion works ongoing
- M2 island infill and signals works
- Bus stop installed
- Incident Response Staging Area

Phase 2 works commenced 17 September

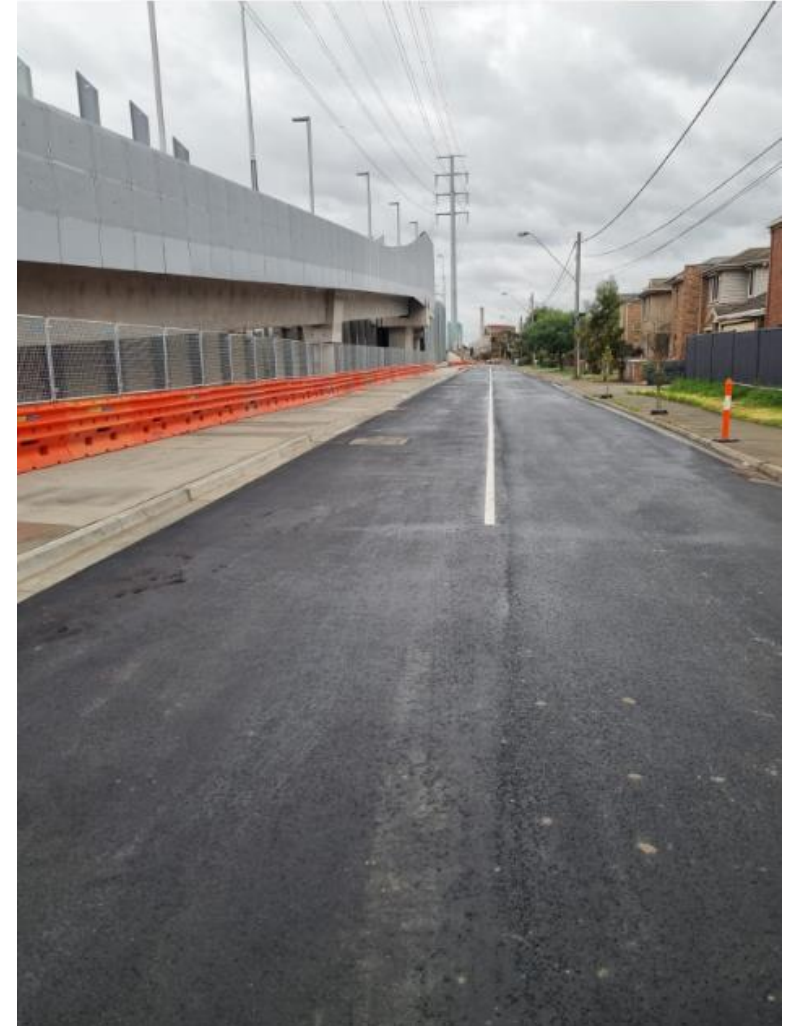


Hyde Street ramps

- All Hyde St off-ramp beams (east of Williamstown Railway Line) have been installed
- The next beam installation campaign for Hyde St off-ramp is earmarked for November 2022 (5 spans over the Williamstown inbound on-ramp)

Fogarty Avenue

- One-way traffic arrangement in place along The Avenue under West Gate Freeway until late November
- Full closure on Fogarty Avenue between the Hockey Club and Wembley Avenue finished on 8 September
- As an acknowledgement of their patience, local café vouchers were gifted to Fogarty / Wembley residents as a small thank you.
- Day closure on Tuesday 11 October
Fogarty Avenue between the Hockey Club and Tenterden Street (7am -5pm) Access to the Hockey Club will be maintained via The Avenue underpass.

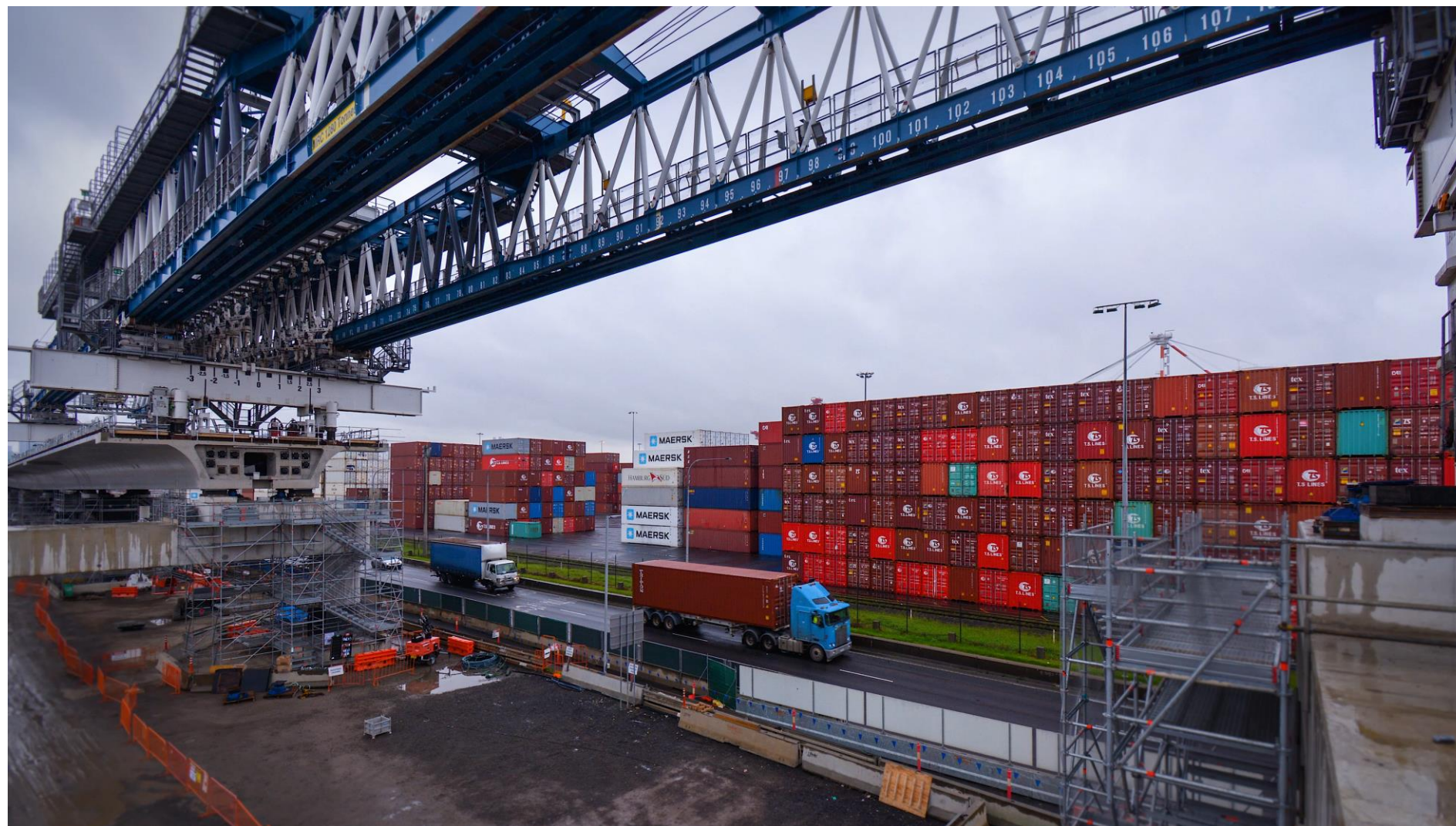

Upcoming Closures

- Maribyrnong River - intermittent full closures of the Maribyrnong River south of Shepherd Bridge during the day from late-October 2022 and early-February 2023
- Dynon Road Bridge (over rail) – West Bound carriageway closure with contraflow arrangement on East Bound carriageway between Dryburgh St and CityLink inbound exit ramp, 1 August – 31 December 2022. Closed November/ December 2022 (TBC).

Notifications

- Southern outbound portal - 18 August
- Northern portal – mid September
- Southern inbound portal – mid September
- Two week rolling notification – ongoing for households under tunnel alignment

Engagement six months recap

We had 143 enquiries via the call centre since tunnelling underway

- 34 for backyard planting queries
- 15 queries about the tunnel alignment & depth
- 12 queries regarding property condition queries
- 10 queries regarding 2 week notice
- 10 total queries regarding noise or vibration
- 62 other including traffic enquiries, request for general information, haulage routes, safety hazards etc.

How many two week notifications have we dropped?

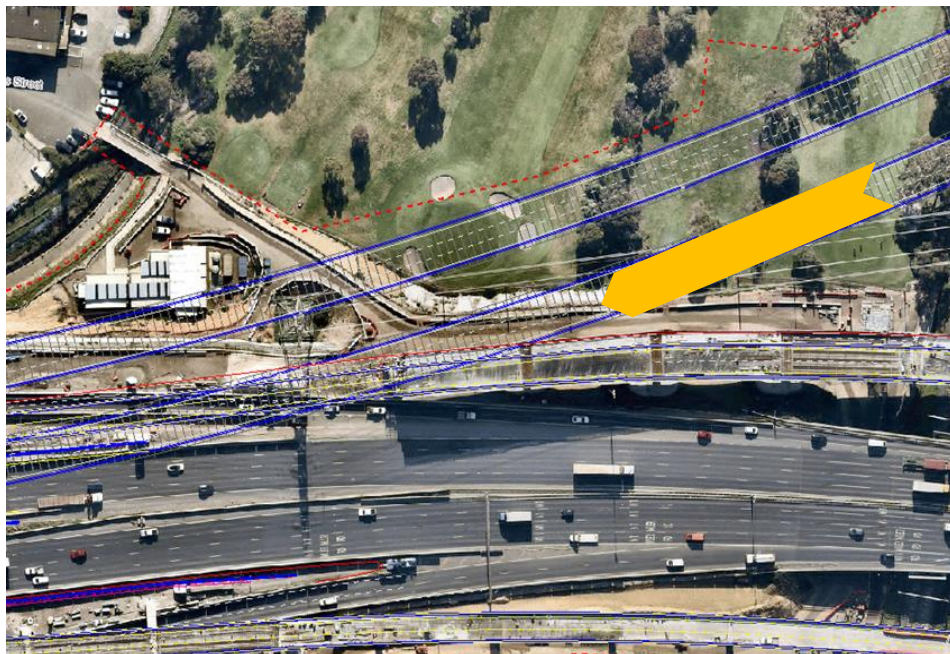
589 in total: 368 for TBM1 - 221 for TBM2.

How many people we've had in the info centre since tunnelling started?

1122 total, including the count for the open day, estimated at 700 people.
We've had 412 visitors otherwise.

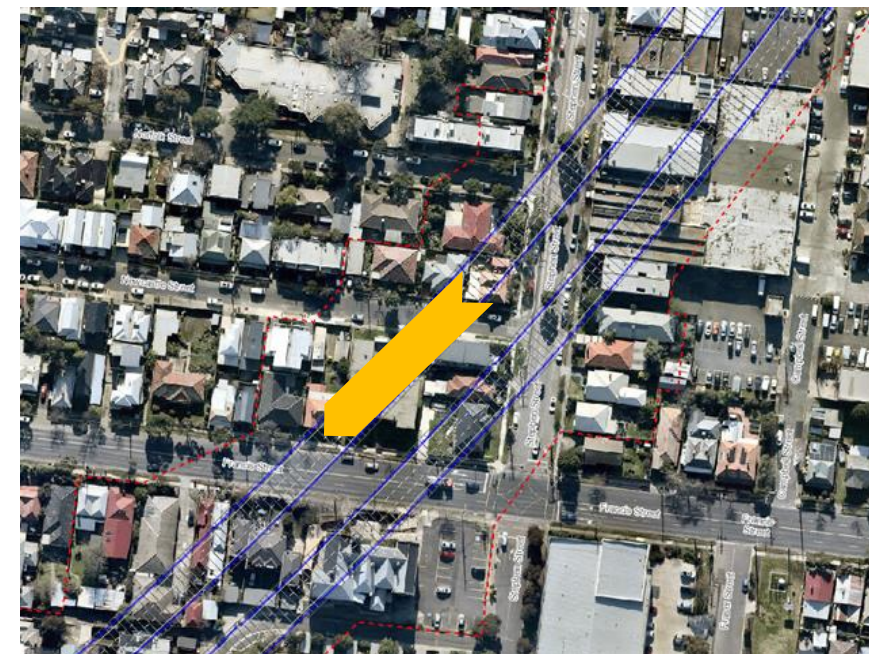
Tunnelling progress

BELLA



- Bella has bored over 1850 metres of tunnel and is in the vicinity of Westgate Golfclub / West Gate Fwy and running according to schedule.

VIDA



- Vida has bored over 1145 metres of tunnel, currently passed Newcastle Street and running according to schedule.

Hi-Quality update



The Hi-Quality soil disposal site in Bulla includes 59 engineered holding bays where material is first placed when it arrives on site, three pre-treatment ponds, a purpose-built water treatment plant that removes any contaminants and returns the water to safe drinking levels, and an approximately 25-hectare containment cell with multi-layer lining to safely store remaining soil.

In March, construction was progressed to allow them to begin accepting soil and as of August all construction at the facility is now complete.

Trucks continue operating 24 hours a day, seven days a week, following the primary approved transport route.

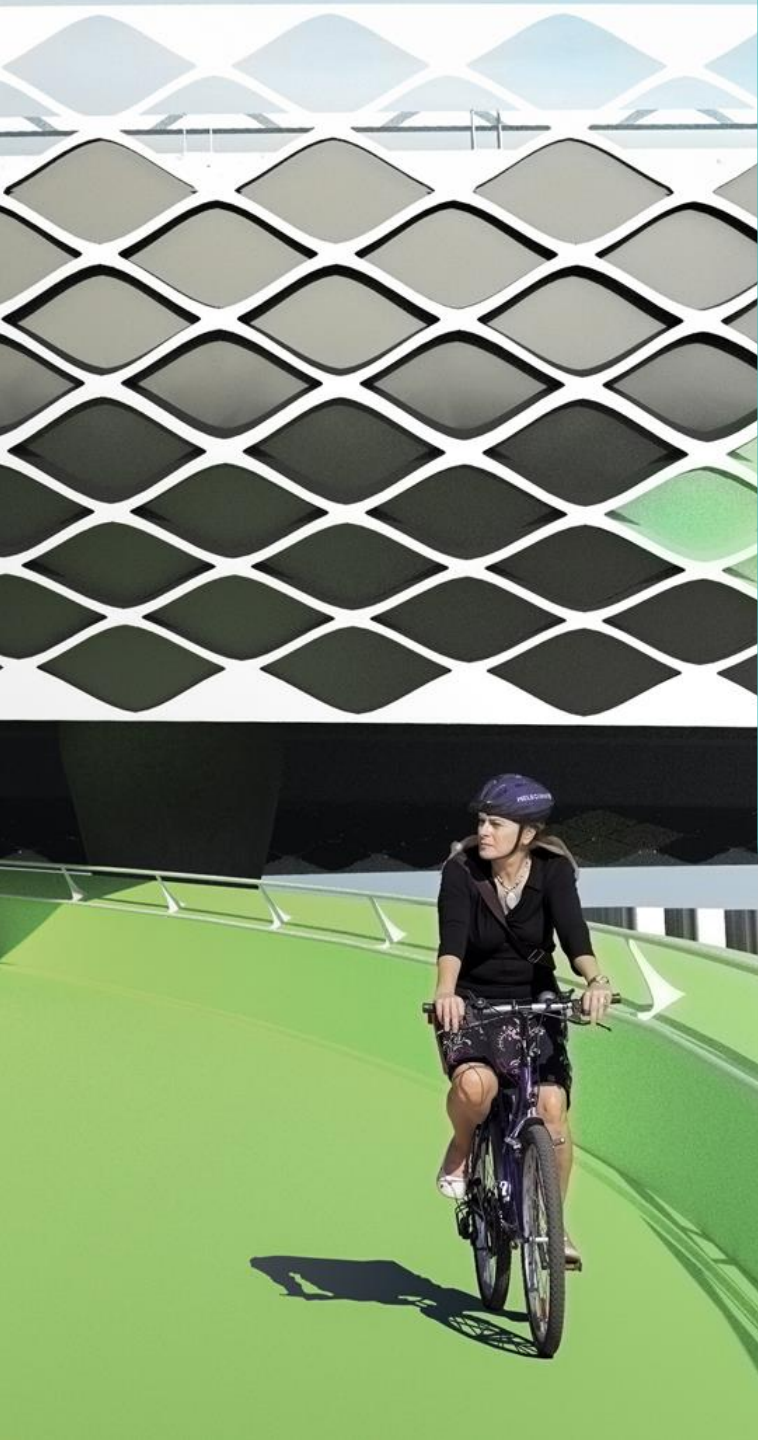
Substructure, foundations for superstructure and retrieval pit constructed. Construction of Ventilation Tower expected to commence October.
