The Australian and Victorian governments are investing more than \$1 billion in rail upgrades between Geelong and Waurin Ponds.



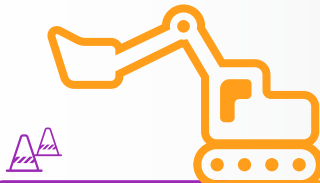
Upgrading the Shepparton Line

Stage 1

Fast-tracked to enable an additional **10 weekly services** on the Shepparton Line in 2019.




Stage 2

Work is underway to enable **modern and reliable** VLocity trains to run on the line.

Signalling and track upgrades to enable **nine return services a day** and faster journeys.

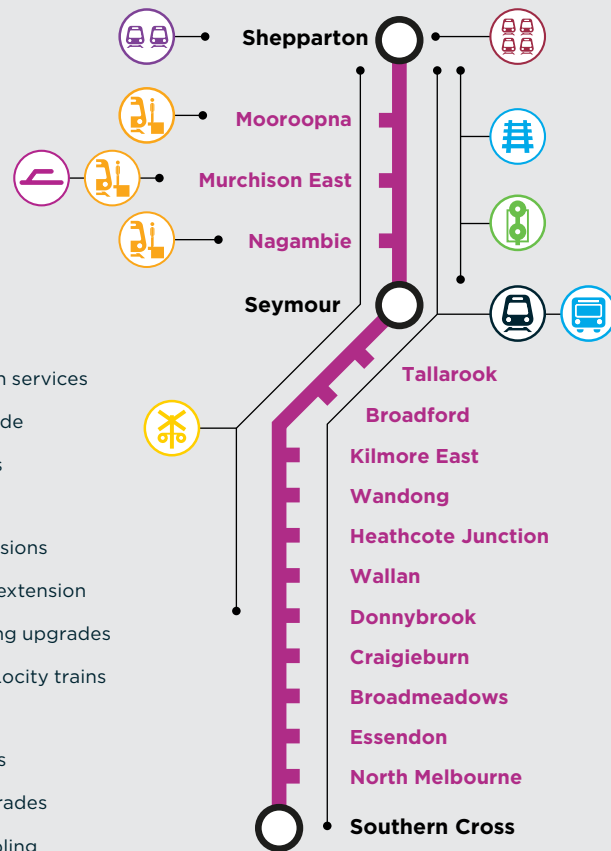

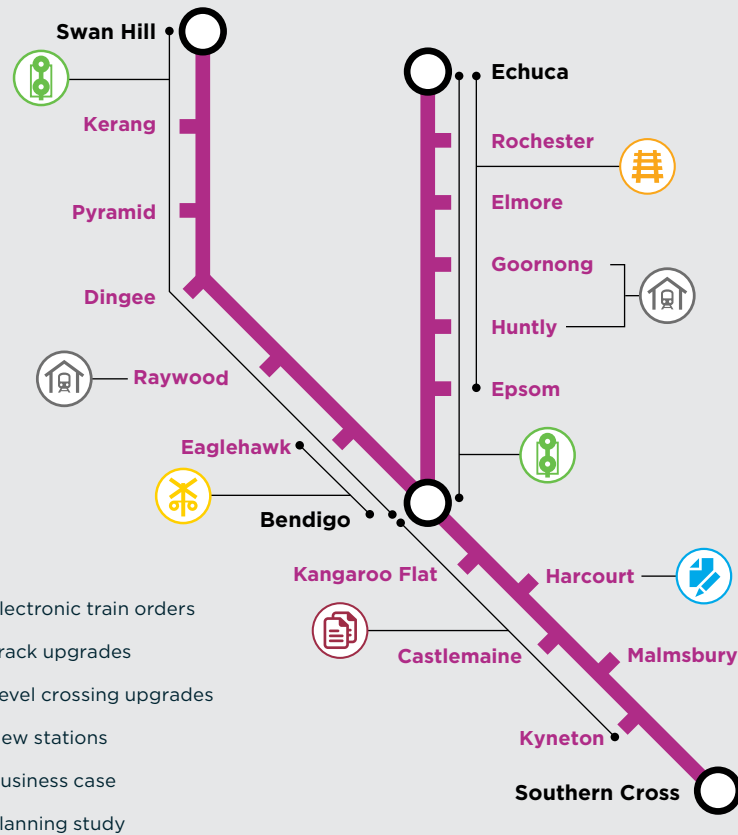

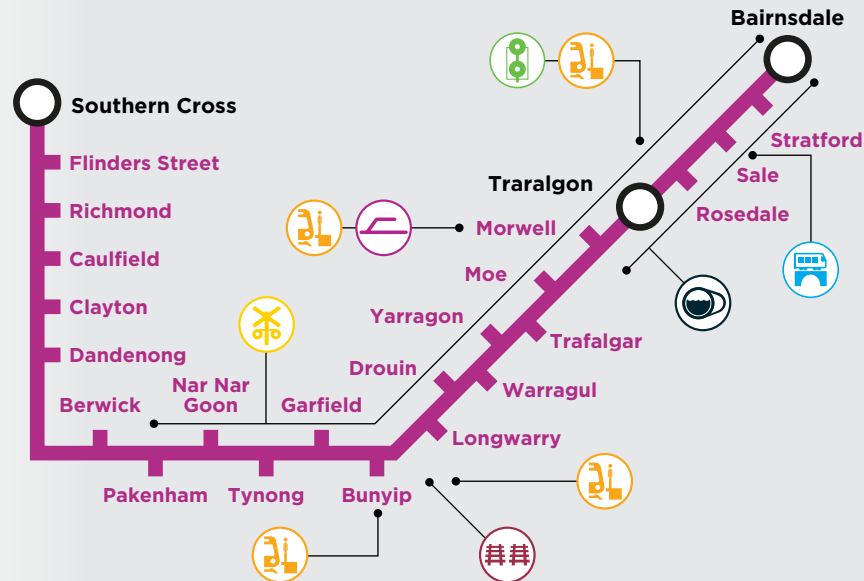

Delivering more frequent and reliable services and improved safety to passengers in Victoria's south west.



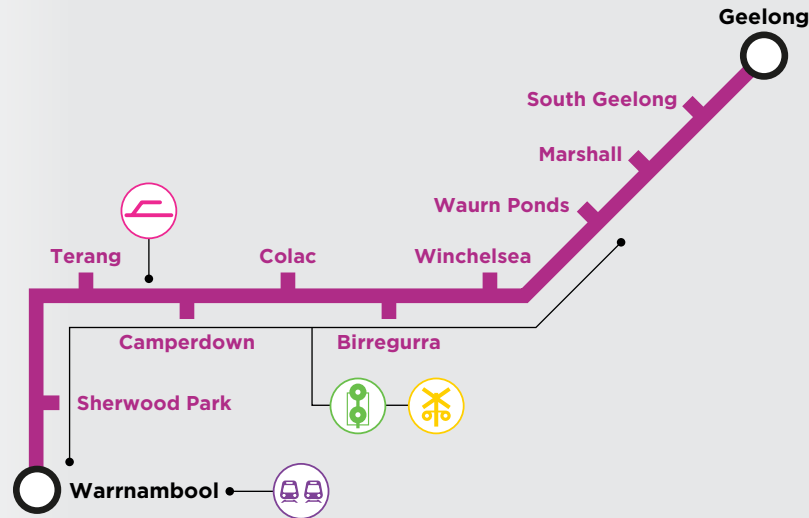
Stage 1
