

Works notice

Reinstatement and public realm works Grattan Street, between Royal Parade and Leicester Street

9 October to December 2023

The Parkville Station precinct has moved into the final phase of construction with reinstatement and public realm works underway.

Throughout the Parkville precinct, staged reinstatement and public realm works are ongoing until early 2024. These works include service relocations, footpath, kerb and road pavement construction, traffic signal modifications, and the installation of bus stops, street furniture, lighting and landscaping.

Reinstatement and public realm works will take place up to property boundaries, including on footpaths and directly adjacent to building entrances. There will be changes to the way you move around the precinct during these works

To enable these works, the northern footpath on Grattan Street, adjacent to the University of Melbourne Medical and Engineering buildings, will close and a pedestrian diversion will be in place.

What we are doing

- Site establishment including installing traffic barriers, temporary fencing and signage around the perimeter of the work site
- Undertaking pile top removal and backfill around the goods lift to enable public realm and reinstatement works to start
- Removing the temporary retaining wall, footpath, kerbs and road surface, which includes non-destructive digging, excavating and saw cutting
- Installing new infrastructure including underground services and utilities
- Landscaping works including installing street furniture such as benches, bollards, signage and tree plots
- Reconstructing the footpath, kerbs and adjacent road surface, which includes laying bluestone, asphaltting and line marking.

What to be aware of

- The northern footpath on Grattan Street, adjacent to the University of Melbourne Medical and Engineering buildings, will temporarily close and a pedestrian diversion will be in place
- The footpath will remain closed outside of working hours
- A pedestrian diversion will be in place via Leicester Street, University Square and Barry Street, and via a new north-south pedestrian crossing that will be established across the Parkville Station site at Barry Street and will connect to Kernot Road
- Access to the University of Melbourne Medical Building will be via the northern entrance on Medical Road
- Access to the University of Melbourne Engineering Building will be maintained via the entrances on Grattan Street and the pedestrian diversion to Kernot Road
- Pedestrian access to all local buildings, including the Medical and Engineering buildings, and businesses will be maintained
- Traffic management and signage will be in place to safely direct pedestrians around the work area
- These works are expected to generate low to medium levels of noise.

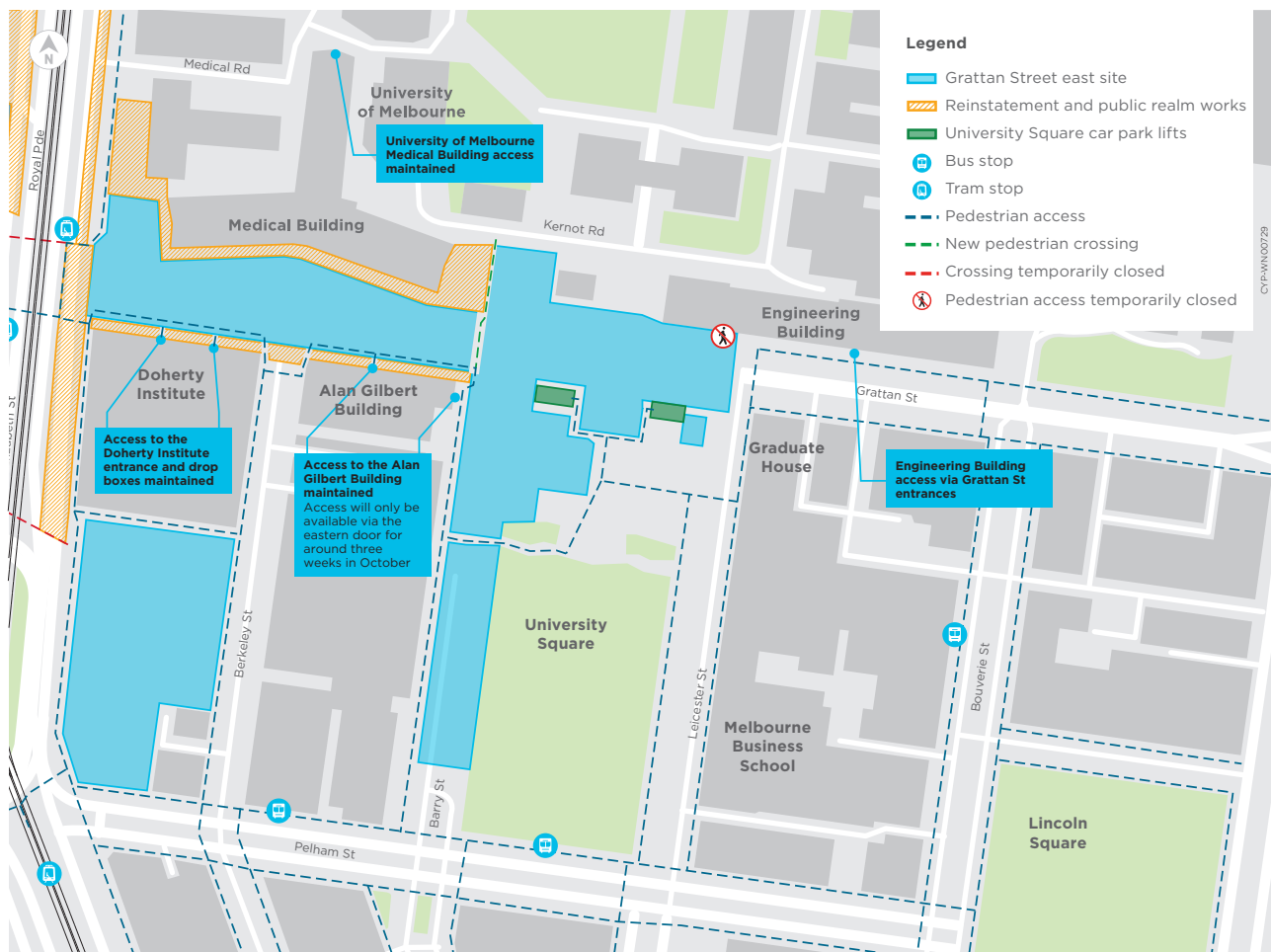
Working hours are:
