


Construction update: North Melbourne

B2 – Platform level



- Western end of platform has been commissioned, permanent lighting is energised
- Protective elements have been removed from the architectural features
- Installation of the Passenger Information
 Displays (PIDS) and Distribution Antennae
 Systems (DAS) along the platform is complete
 and commissioned
- Installation of CCTV, beacon alarm systems, speakers and lighting 'flying fox' bracketry is complete
- Paving and platform seating on the platform is complete
- Over the following weeks eastern end of platform will be energised, escalator cladding, bracketry and will be finalised.






- Front of house elements are now being commissioned
- Installation of bracketry for PIDS and directional signage is underway
- Distribution Antennae Systems (DAS) systems are being installed
- Aluminium cladding above the colour back glass now complete
- Fit out of public bathroom amenities is continuing
- Granite paving is complete on the concourse level
- Installation of shark tooth baffles is complete at the entrance.

Laurens Lane



- Garden beds have been backfilled and planting has commenced on Laurens Lane
- Street furniture has been installed:
 - Bicycle hoops
 - Seating
 - Bollards
- Tree surrounds have been installed for future planting

- Glazing of retail areas is underway
- Planting has commenced in the entrance built in garden beds
- Installation of sleepers on the entrance stairs is almost complete
- Terrace wall light fittings continuing to be installed
- Installation of ceramic tiling on the western façade is 65% complete
- Station flag markers and totems have been installed.

- Kerbing, drainage, footpath and crossover reinstatements are complete on the northern side of Barwise and eastern side of Laurens streets
- Laurens Street's eastern footpath is open to pedestrians

- Kerbing is underway on Fogarty Street.





- Timing: Current 28 September 2023
- Status:
- Bike separator works
 - Laurens St, northbound lane closure between Arden and Queensberry streets
 - Laurens St cyclist lane closure between Arden and Queensberry streets, (northbound and southbound)
- Traffic and pedestrian changes:
 - Northbound vehicles and cyclists, detoured via Munster Tce
 - Southbound cyclists detoured via Dryburgh St
 - Pedestrians detoured to the eastern footpath.







Construction update: Intake sub-station (ISS)

Intake substation (ISS) fencing and landscaping



- Planting is expected to commence in early October
- Fencing installation is expected to occur in early December
- During fencing installation and landscaping works, short term width reductions of the shared use path may be required in this section of the path, south of Arden Street
- Traffic controllers will maintain movements for cyclists and pedestrians
- Community planting opportunity will be available for members of CRG, FOMPC, North Melbourne Residents Association in mid-October.



Chiller plant

- Façade, internal walls and services fit out works are ongoing. To be complete within the next week
- Chiller trench works ongoing

Western Tunnel Ventilation System

- Structure works complete
- Commissioning complete, fans operational.

Eastern Tunnel Ventilation System

- Façade installation to commence in October
- Commissioning complete, fans operational.

MEP and fit out works Station box (including the Royal Parade underpass)




- B1: Commissioning zone, power and lighting on. Final finishes ongoing, including painting and flooring
- B2: Finishes and fit out works ongoing, upper-level cladding is progressing, colourback glass complete. Final north retail façade to be completed, and remaining bracketry. Stone flooring, MEP brackets and services fit off ongoing
- B3: Commissioning zone, power and lighting on. Final finishing on back of house facilities
- B4: Commissioning has commenced. Architectural fit off ongoing. Drum light installation is complete and MEP brackets commenced.



Station surface



- Pile deheading along the northern side of the station box complete
- Minor backfill activities ongoing
- Service installation ongoing, including the water main, sewer and drainage.





























- Other architectural and final services fit out works are ongoing.













METROTUNNEL

Reinstatement and public realm works

- Public realm and reinstatement works, including service installation, footpath and roads, are substantially complete on Elizabeth Street and Royal Parade
- Areas remain partially closed and with traffic arrangements or pedestrian diversions in place for kerb and median works to enable the tram occupation
- Areas with ongoing kerb and median work includes:
 2E, 1G, 1D, 1F, 2A, 2F, 2G, 2B, 2C & 2D
- The kerb and median works facilitate the widened service lanes and enable vehicle movement back into the fast lanes at the new tram super-stops (as part of the legacy design).




Stage 1F – Elizabeth Street northbound service lane

Reinstatement and public realm works




- Timing:
 - Ongoing until mid-October 2023
- The work area will include:
 - Elizabeth Street northbound service lane between the Haymarket roundabout RMH and Grattan Street
- Traffic and pedestrian changes:
 - Partial closure of the northbound service lane. Vehicles and cyclist access will be maintained
 - Access to the Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre loading bay is maintained
 - Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre pick-up/dropoff parking on Elizabeth Street is maintained.




Stage 3A/4A/5A – Grattan Street east between Royal Parade and the University of Melbourne medical building

Reinstatement and public realm works

- Timing:
 - Ongoing January 2024
- The works area will include:
 - The northern Grattan Street footpath between Royal Parade and the eastern side of the University of Melbourne Medical Building
- Traffic and pedestrian changes:
 - Pedestrian diversions will be implemented during stages of the works. Diversions will be staged to minimise disruption
 - Access to the University of Melbourne medical building will be maintained
 - Further detailed discussion with stakeholders will be undertaken and a works notification will be provided for these works.



Stage 3C/4C – Grattan Street between Elizabeth and Barry streets



Reinstatement and public realm works and water main installation

- Timing:
 - Ongoing December 2023
- The works area will include:
 - The southern Grattan Street footpath between Elizabeth and Barry streets
- Traffic and pedestrian changes:
 - Pedestrian diversions will be implemented during stages of the works via Haymarket Walk, Barry Street and Pelham Street
 - Access to the Doherty Institute and Alan Gilbert Building will be maintained and diversions will be staged to minimise disruption.





Stage 2C/2D– Elizabeth Street (east)

Reinstatement and public realm works

- Timing:
 - Ongoing until mid-October 2023
- The works area will include:
 - Elizabeth Street southbound service lane and adjacent footpath between Grattan Street and Haymarket roundabout
- Traffic and pedestrian changes:
 - Closure of the southbound service lane and eastern footpath with diversions in place
 - Access, including deliveries, will be maintained for local businesses and institutions.





Stage 1B/1E– Grattan Street west (south)

Reinstatement and public realm works

- Timing:
 - Ongoing until mid-October 2023
- The works area will include:
 - Grattan Street west, southern side, between Flemington Road and Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade
- Traffic and pedestrian changes:
 - Eastbound traffic lane temporarily reopened
 - Pedestrian diversions will be implemented during stages of the works. Diversions will be staged to minimise disruption
 - Access to hospitals and businesses, and for emergency vehicles, is being maintained at all times.






Stage 1A/1C – Grattan Street west (north)

Reinstatement and public realm works

- Timing:
 - Mid-October to January 2024
- The works area will include:
 - Grattan Street west, northern side, between Flemington Road and Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade
- Traffic and pedestrian changes:
 - Traffic arrangements currently being drafted and detailed discussion with stakeholders will be undertaken
 - Pedestrian diversions will be implemented during stages of the works. Diversions will be staged to minimise disruption
 - Access to hospitals and businesses, and for emergency vehicles, will be maintained at all times.



- From 21 November to 30 November, buses will replace route 19 trams for 10 days from 21 November to 30 November between Queen Victoria Market and Brunswick Road
- The bus replacement services will enable the construction of an accessible tram stop
- Prior to the occupation, night works will be required. Notification for these works will be provided.






