Works notice



One week closure of St Kilda Road southbound

St Kilda Road

From 8pm 7 April - 13 April 2024

Works were recently completed to reinstate St Kilda Road to two lanes in each direction through the Metro Tunnel Project area. With these works now complete, we will install the tram tracks connecting St Kilda Road into Domain Road.



When we'll be working

To safely complete these works and minimise disruption to traffic on St Kilda Road works will take place **24/7**

 8pm Sunday 7 April to 6am Saturday 13 April 2024

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

What we'll be doing

- Closing the southbound lanes of St Kilda Road between Dorcas Street and Toorak Road from 8pm Sunday 7 April 2024 to:
 - Prepare sections of the existing road for the installation of tram tracks
 - Install tram tracks connecting into Domain Road
 - Complete asphalting and reopen St Kilda Road on Saturday 13 April 2024

What to be aware of

- St Kilda Road southbound lanes will be closed between Dorcas Street and Toorak Road
- Detours will be in place for southbound traffic via Dorcas Street and Kings Way
- Cyclists will be detoured via Government House Drive, Birdwood Avenue, Domain Road, Domain Street and Bromby Street (See Map)
- Pedestrian access will be closed along the eastern side of St Kilda Road between Park Street and Melbourne Grammar School.
 A pedestrian detour will be in place via the western side of St Kilda Road and the Anzac Station tram stop (See Map)
- To minimise the duration of the closure, works will be carried out overnight
- Removing the existing road surface and installing new tram tracks is expected to generate periods of medium levels of noise.

Where

- Works will be carried out at the intersection of Domain Road and St Kilda Road
- Due to the nature of these works, progress may be impacted by weather conditions.
