## Equipment delivery

### St Kilda Road, Melbourne

30 October 2024

As part of the ongoing operation and maintenance of Anzac Station, a specialty boom lift has been manufactured and will be delivered to the station in late October.

Due to its size, the boom lift needs to be lowered into the station via the service hatch in front of 400 St Kilda Road, requiring an overnight closure of St Kilda Road northbound lanes.



#### When we'll be working

 9pm to 6am, Wednesday 30 October

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

#### What we'll be doing

- Installing safety barriers around the service hatch (located in front of 400 St Kilda Road) and opening the service hatch, using hand tools
- Establishing a site on St Kilda Road to set up a crane, which will be used to lift the service hatch and lower the boom lift into the station box via the service hatch
- Closing the service hatch.

#### What to be aware of

- This will require the closure of St Kilda Road northbound between Toorak Road and Bowen Lane, from 9pm to 6am
- Traffic will be detoured via Kings Way and Park Street
- Driveway access for The Botanica will be via Bowen Crescent.
  Significant delays are expected when lifting works are underway
- Traffic controllers will be in place to assist with entry and exit of pedestrians and vehicles to buildings
- There will be intermittent periods of medium to high level noise associated with these works.


