Paving and kerb works

Flinders Lane and Royston Place

Monday 20 January to Friday 24 January 2025

During one week in January, a series of works will take place in Flinders Lane and Royston Place, requiring a Flinders Lane road closure.



When we'll be working

We'll be working from **6pm** on **Monday 20 January** until **5am** on **Friday 24 January**, all hours inclusive.

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

What we'll be doing

- Reinstating one section of bluestone pavement on the Flinders Lane southern footpath, near the corner of Royston Place
- Rebuilding kerb, ramp and tactiles on both sides of the pedestrian crossing on Flinders Lane, near Manchester Lane and Royston Place
- Undertaking line marking within Royston Place
- Grouting of existing service pits in Cocker Alley and Scott Alley
- Materials delivery via truck and forklift at Royston Place.

What to be aware of

- These works will generate some medium-level noise and vibration during the night
- Works will include the use of a small excavator, concrete saws and hand tools
- Flinders Lane will be closed to traffic between Swanston and Elizabeth streets from 6pm on Monday 20 January until 5am on Friday 24 January
- A partial footpath closure will be in place. Please follow traffic management and signage to navigate safely around the works as pedestrian access will move from the northern to the southern footpath as works progress
- Access to residential buildings and businesses will be maintained at all times

- Access to properties on Flinders Lane, between Russell Street and Regent Place, will be maintained, and vehicles exiting this area will be required to travel east to Russell Street and detour using Flinders or Collins streets
- Access to properties on Flinders Lane, between Swanston and Elizabeth streets, will be maintained via Elizabeth Street under a contraflow arrangement
- There will be a closure of Royston Place for up to two days during line marking works.

- Flinders Lane near Royston Place (refer to map for location).


