SRLA presented on Gardiners Creek naturalisation, noting:

- The context and features of Gardiners Creek.
- The significance of Gardiners Creek.
- The benefits and scope of naturalising Gardiners Creek.

SRLA gave an update on community engagement, including:

- Recent and upcoming community events SRLA has/will hold within the Whitehorse municipality.
- Calling for input and ideas around further future local engagement opportunities.

Matters arising:

- John Wilson (JW) asked SRLA how far a tunnel boring machine travel in a day. SRLA noted typically 10 metres within 24-hours.
- Yvonne Yip (YY) asked SRLA when will engagement commence regarding Gardiners Creek naturalisation. SRLA advised it may occur from next year.
- JW queried how SRLA will mitigate Gardiners Creek from flooding. SRLA advised that flood modelling has helped inform appropriate controls and that SRLA is engaging closely with Melbourne Water.
- Matt Fregon suggested SRLA consider consultation Indigenous representatives including with a Registered Aboriginal Party representative, in relation to Gardiners Creek naturalisation.
- MF suggested Ashburton Festival as a good opportunity for SRLA to have a
 presence in the future, stemming from SRLA calling out for suggestions on
 future engagement opportunities.
- JW queried the timing of the Burwood replacement park celebration event.
 SRLA advised that the event starts at 8.00 am until 11.00 am, in line with a family audience.
- JW asked SRLA whether a fence at the new playground on Cummings Street will be installed. LOR advised that the design and installation of the new playground is complete with plants to become more established.
- JW gueried SRLA on future tunnel access shaft works
- LM went through new actions raised at this meeting, noting:
