- AP expressed concern regarding traffic during MU Orientation Week and beginning
  of semester. Suggested clear communications to MU staff and students would be
  required, including signage throughout the area and on campus and all-staff email.
  - Action: SRLA to investigate having a pop-up on MU campus during Orientation Week.
- Nick Davis (ND) noted if 24/7 road closures are required, CSIRO would appreciate early warning to inform staff. Provided feedback that traffic management for recent works has worked well.
- Rahul Pradhan (RP) noted primary concern for the Notting Hill community is the longer-term, structure planning for SRL East, rather than current works.
- RP noted they run a local community WhatsApp group. SRLA can provide key
  updates to NHNH to send to the group.
  - Action: SRLA and NHNH to discuss further opportunities for popups at the centre.
- AP raised concerns about lack of clear cycling connection to the M-City development. Finding a way to integrate M-City into the rest of the precinct would be well-received by community members.
  - o NHNH added there is no bus that goes directly to M-City.
  - SRLA noted this feedback was received also from Monash City Council.
     The conversation will continue throughout 2025 on how the precinct as a whole will develop and change over time.
