Footpath closure

Flinders Street northern footpath

Monday 28 July to Friday 1 August, and one week in late August

The Flinders Street northern footpath will close at times in July and August to commence reinstatement of the awning at 244 Flinders Street. All footpath closures will be from 9pm to 2:30am.

When we'll be working

- 4:30pm to 2:30am, Mondays to Fridays
- Monday 28 July to Friday 1 August 2025
- One week in late August 2025

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

What we'll be doing

- Removing sections of the existing building façade and installing hoarding at 244 Flinders Street to enable reinstatement of the awning
- Installing the hoarding from Monday 28 July to Friday 1 August, between 4:30pm and 2:30am with a footpath closure in place from 9pm to 2:30am to safely complete the works
- Diverting pedestrians via a temporary pedestrian path onto Flinders Street under the direction of traffic controllers between 4:30pm to 9pm
- Installing steel for the awning in late August, followed by the installation of the awning canopy.
- Notification will be provided closer to the date.

What to be aware of

- The Flinders Street northern footpath adjacent to 244 Flinders St will close from 9pm to 2:30am with a pedestrian detour in place via the southern Flinders Street footpath (see map):
 - For two nights in late July during the hoarding installation
 - For one week in late August during the steel installation for the awning

- During these closures, the Flinders Street pedestrian crossing to the Swanston Street/Flinders Street #5 tram stop, will remain open to Degraves Street (see map)
- Access to the tram stop will be maintained at all times via the southern end of the pedestrian crossing and northern end from Degraves Street
- From 4:30pm to 9pm, the footpath will remain open via a temporary pedestrian path onto Flinders Street under the direction of traffic controllers
- The footpath will be open with a reduced width outside of working hours
- Access to all local buildings and businesses will be fully maintained during the closures
- Traffic control, pedestrian and business signage will be in place during these closures.


