## Footpath reinstatement works

### Swanston Street, Melbourne

Thursday 21 August to late September

From 21 August to late September we will repave a section of Swanston Street between 409 Swanston Street and A'Beckett Street



#### When we'll be working

- 7am to 2:30am, Monday to Thursday
- 7am to 10:30pm Friday
- 7am to 2:30pm Saturday
- Thursday 21 August to late September

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

#### What we'll be doing

- Removing a section of existing pavement
- Reinstating that section with new bluestone paving and kerbing
- Installation of new tree plots in A'Beckett Street.

#### What to be aware of

- There will be a footpath closure between 409 Swanston Street (Druids house) and A'Beckett Street and a temporary footpath will be established to maintain pedestrian access
- Four car spaces will be temporarily occupied to facilitate an on-road pedestrian diversion. This includes one loading bay and one accessible parking space
- Nearby alternative parking is available in Little La Trobe, La Trobe and Franklin streets (see map)
- The Swanston Street western footpath and northbound bike lane will remain open via a temporary on-road diversion (see map)
- These works will produce intermittent periods of high noise
- Access to all local buildings and businesses will be maintained.

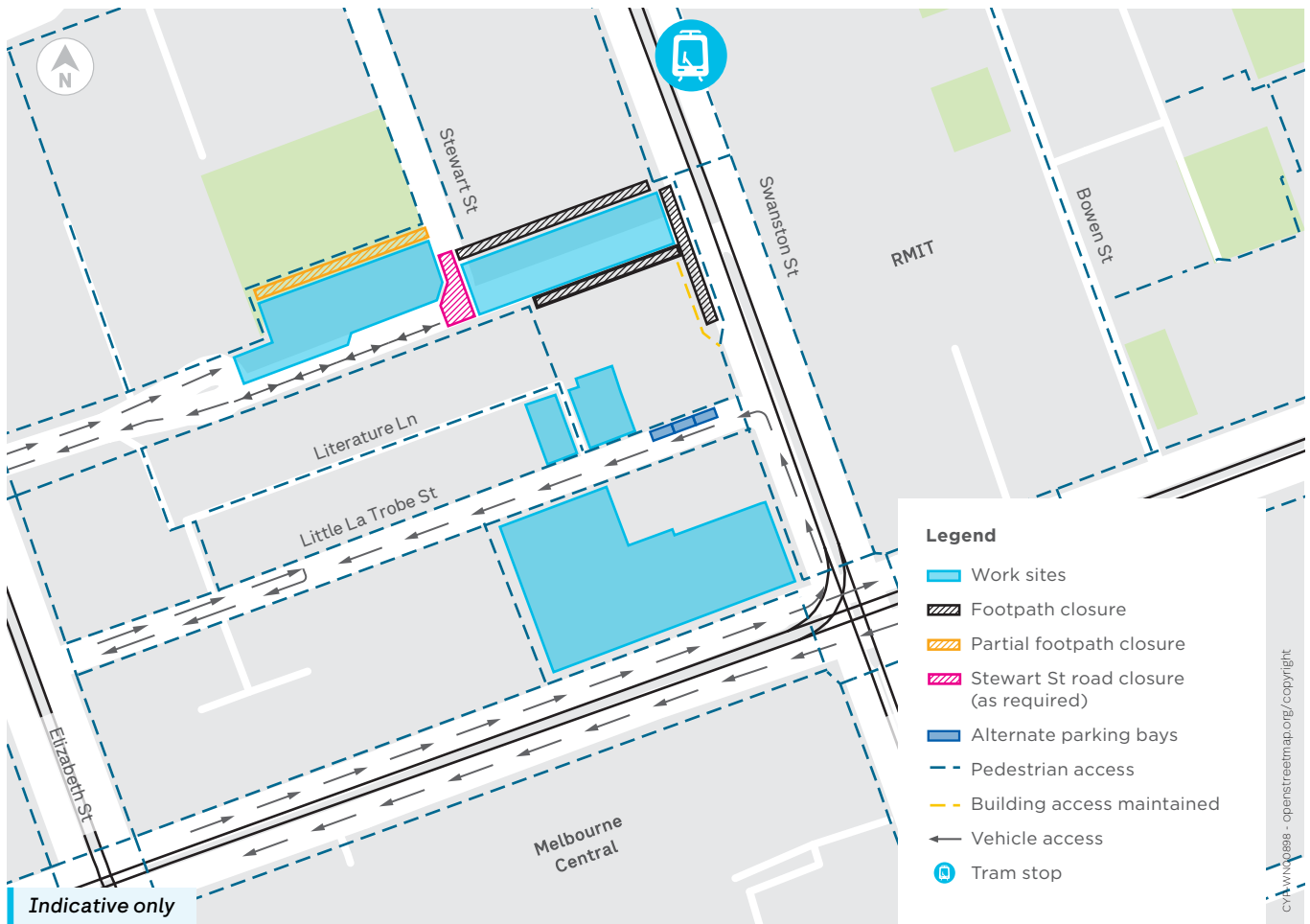
