

Construction update



Town Hall Station

November 2025

Major construction of Town Hall Station is complete. Final works are continuing, including final station fit out, station testing and commissioning and reinstatement of community spaces.

Works snapshot: November 2025

Major construction of Town Hall Station is complete, with final works continuing. Construction works within the Town Hall Station precinct during November 2025 include:

- Station entrance construction and underground build-out works at the Flinders Quarter and Federation Square sites
- Completion of fit-out of above ground structures and civil surface works at City Square
- Awning reinstatement preparatory works at 244 Flinders Street
- Train testing through the tunnel and along the Cranbourne, Pakenham and Sunbury lines.

City Square site

7am to 2:30am, Monday to Friday

Works occurring this month include:

- Reinstatement works including the construction of garden beds, footpaths, street furniture, paving, and delivery of materials via Flinders Lane
- Strip out and removal of site facilities
- These works are expected to generate medium levels of noise
- The Flinders Lane northern footpath will remain closed until mid-November to facilitate site access.

Flinders Quarter site

7am to 2:30am, Monday to Friday
7am to 2:30pm, Saturday



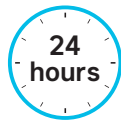
Works occurring this month include:

- Construction of the station entrance, installation of services and station fit out is ongoing
- This involves use of the tower crane, mobile surface cranes, concrete pumps, and regular delivery of materials via Flinders Street and Royston Place
- Ventilation equipment will operate during all works below ground, and site lighting will be required for evening and overnight works
- The Flinders Street eastbound lane will remain closed until early 2026 to facilitate deliveries into the Flinders Quarter site.



Federation Square site

Town Hall Station will include an entrance at Federation Square. Construction is ongoing for this entrance.

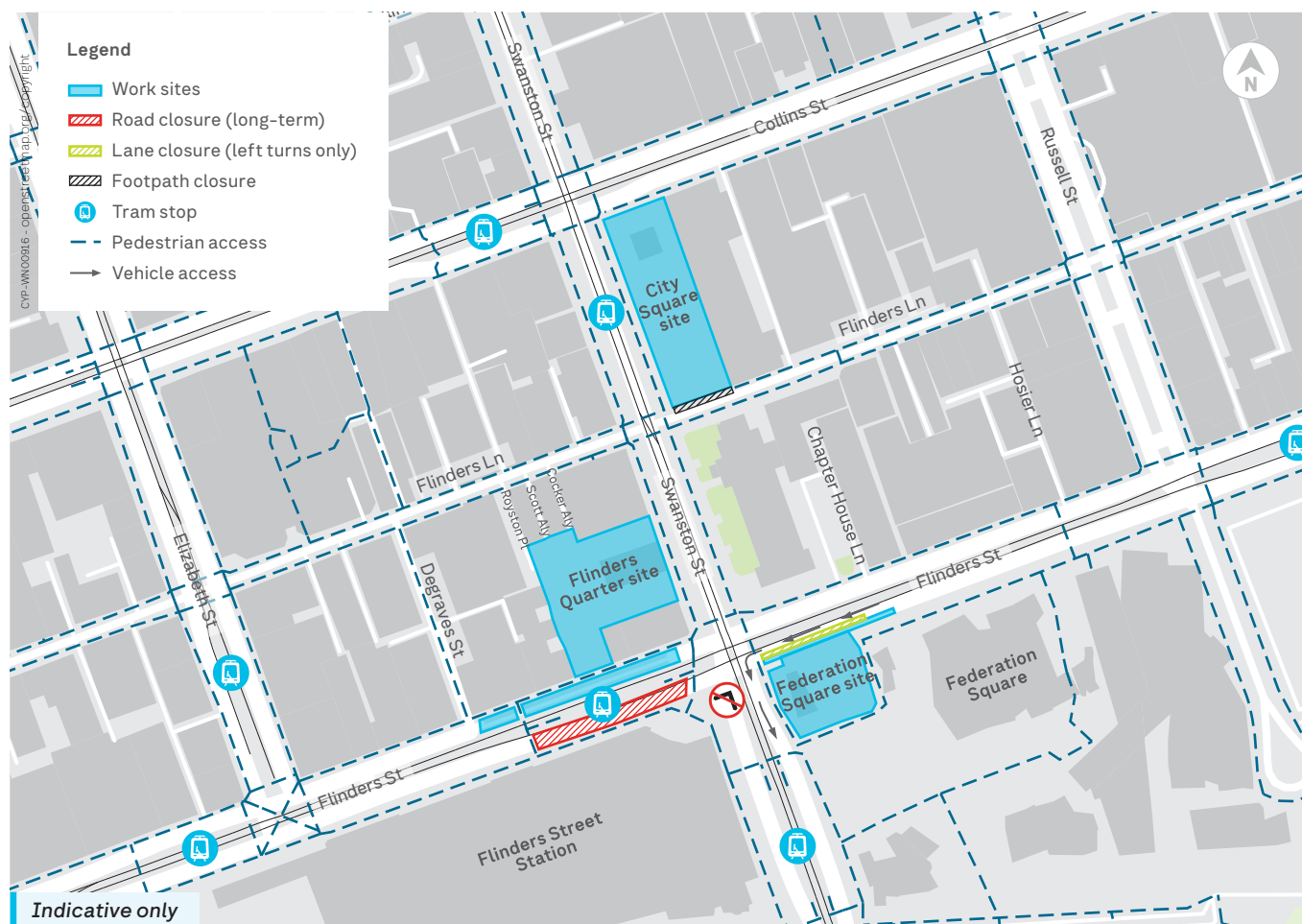


24-hours, Monday to Sunday

Works occurring this month include:

- Below ground structural works and fit-out of the station passenger areas and operational rooms, including installation of waterproofing materials, steel and concrete
- Above ground service installations, reinstatement works and structural works, involving the removal of existing pavement, installation of new drainage and conduits, and construction of a new concrete slab
- Delivery and installation of sections of the station entrance canopy is continuing over the coming months, as well as construction and fit out of the structure
- These works will generate some periods of high-level noise as well as regular deliveries via the Flinders Street loading bay and crane
- Flinders Street westbound remains closed with all vehicles to turn left at St Kilda Road.
