Day works

Fencing and temporary noise wall installation for Bulleen Park & Ride

What we'll be doing

From Monday 10 May, CPB Contractors will be installing the temporary noise wall and fencing in Koonung Creek Reserve adjacent to Thompsons Road and Kampman Street, Bulleen. These works will take approximately **six weeks** to complete and will involve:

- Light construction vehicles in the area.
- Service scanning using high-pressure water and vacuum to carefully dig the post foundations.
- · Concreting the foundations.
- Installation of a temporary noise wall and fencing on the reserve adjacent to Kampman Street and Thompsons Road.
- Removal of vegetation under the supervision of independent arborists and wildlife handlers.
- Temporary closure of Thompsons Road shared user path between Kampman Street and the Eastern Freeway with pedestrian and cyclist detour in place. Refer to the map in this notification.
- Temporary traffic condition changes including lane closures on Thompsons Road and Kampman Street at times, reduced speeds, traffic and pedestrian management.

When and where are we working?

From **Monday 10 May** for up to six weeks, works will occur at the following locations:

Day works as follows:

 Koonung Creek Reserve, Kampman Street and Thompsons Road, Bulleen.

Working hours: Mondays to Fridays, 7am to 6pm; Saturdays, 7am to 1pm.

What this means for you

During these works you may notice:

- Our crews and construction vehicles working in the area.
- Noise from large equipment including excavators, concrete truck, chainsaw, woodchipper and a vacuum truck.
- Temporary changes to traffic conditions, including lane closures, reduced speed limits and traffic controllers directing traffic and assisting pedestrians and cyclists.
- Temporary closure of the shared user path on Thompsons Road between Kampman Street and the Eastern Freeway. A detour will be in place and traffic management signage to assist with wayfinding.

As part of the construction of a high-quality noise wall along Kampman Street to protect residents from noise and overall construction of the Bulleen Park & Ride infrastructure, vegetation removal is required. Expert arborist advice was called upon to ensure as many trees are retained. Where trees can be kept, a Tree Protection Plan will be put in place. The plan details what needs to be done to protect the tree from construction above and below ground.

Residents directly impacted by the works will be contacted by the team prior to the works commencing.

Our community engagement team will be available to assist residents during these works.

Safety is our priority and we ask for your assistance with following instructions, signage and maintaining social distancing during current restrictions.

We appreciate your patience and understanding throughout these works.
