

Upcoming day works for North East Link

Site establishment works at the Veneto Club, Bulleen

We're moving close to 100 above and underground services such as power, water, gas, sewerage and telecommunications to make way for North East Link.

From **Thursday 10 June 2021** until **mid 2021** CPB Contractors will establish a work site at the **Veneto Club, Bulleen** to support the construction of the Yarra East Main Sewer.

What we'll be doing

Works include:

- Surveying and use of hand tools to take ground samples
- Scanning the ground to locate services with handheld electronic equipment
- Using high-pressure water and a vacuum truck to carefully expose underground services and verify their location
- Installation of temporary safety fencing barriers
- Trimming of vegetation may be required
- Implementing environmental controls such as tree protection, silt traps and dust suppression measures
- Installation of temporary site facilities and toilets
- Construction of a retrieval shaft ready for retrieving a laser guided drill head in the coming months
- Boring the new sewer pipelines between the shafts from Bulleen Park to the Veneto Club
- Temporary reinstatement of the work site
- Stage 2 works will re-commence in late August 2021 with the opening and commissioning of the new sewer and decommissioning of the redundant sewer.

When we'll be working

7am to 4pm, Monday to Friday
From **Thursday 10 June 2021** until **mid 2021**.

Any work scheduled to occur outside these hours will only proceed after residents have been notified.

What to expect

During works you may notice:

- Work crews in the area
- Noise from machinery and equipment, such as a vacuum truck, an excavator, roller and light vehicles
- Vibration while we compact the work area
- Traffic controllers to help guide you safely through the area.

Managing impacts

CPB Contractors are committed to minimising construction impacts for the community and will implement the following mitigation measures where appropriate:

- Covering loads on trucks, when transporting excavated material
- Dust suppression using water carts and binding agents
- Noise control equipment and sound blankets may be used on machinery and tools
- Tree protection zones to retain as many trees as possible.

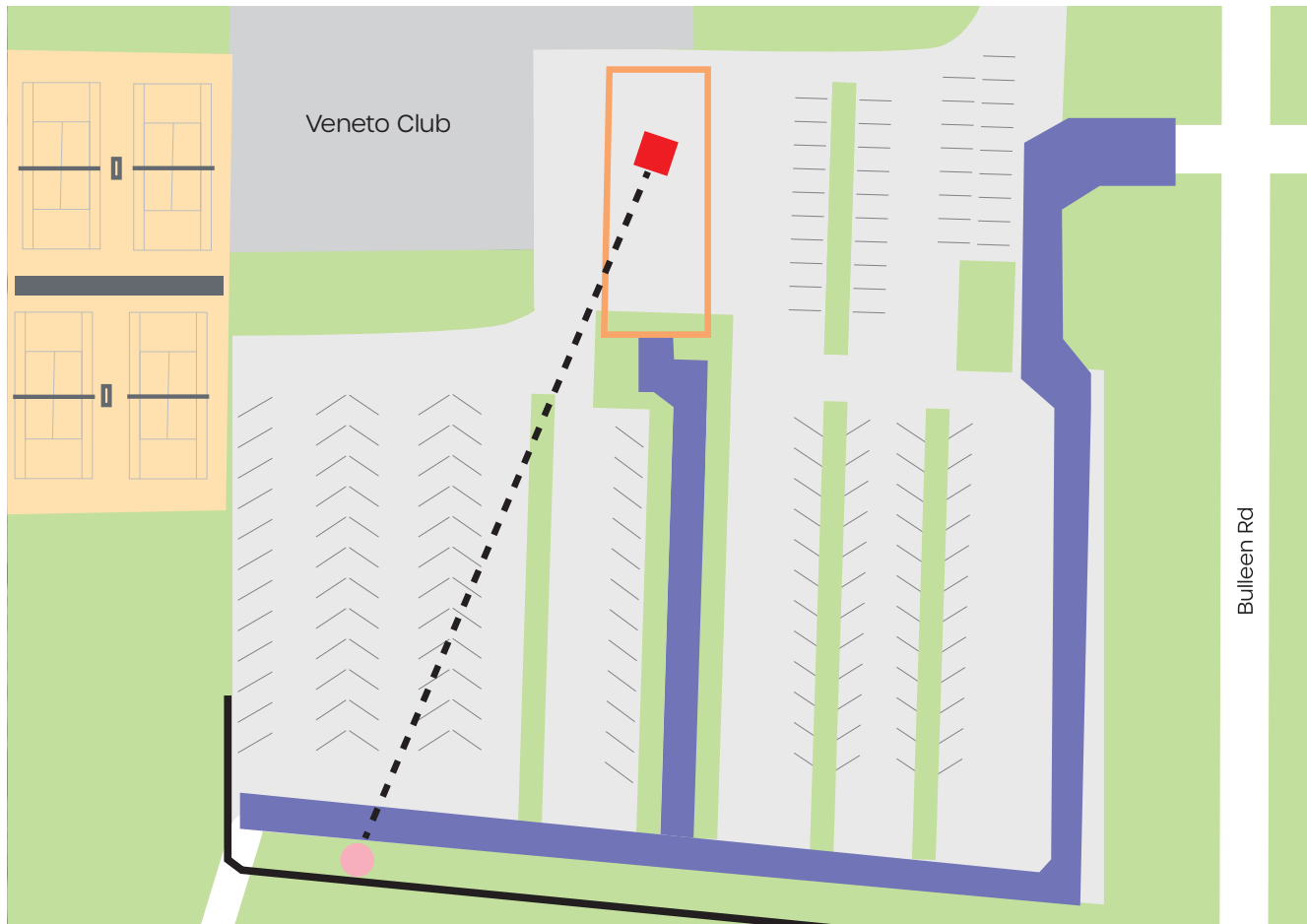
Our community engagement team will be onsite and available to assist residents during the works.
