

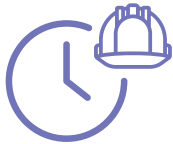
Works notification

Service relocation works update for Borlase Reserve and surrounds

What we'll be doing

We're continuing to relocate essential services around Borlase Reserve with strict health and safety measures in place. This notification aims to provide you an update on works currently underway and continuing over the next couple of months.

When are we working?



Normal construction hours

7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
7am to 1pm, Saturdays

Some activities may be required to continue slightly past these hours. All efforts will be made to complete activities as scheduled.



Out of hours/Night works hours

Weekend / evening works
6pm to 10pm, Monday to Friday
1pm to 10pm, Saturdays
7am to 10pm, Sundays

Night works

6pm to 7am, Sunday to Sunday (7 days)

Night works are often required for worker and community safety and to reduce traffic impacts.

Please note that all dates within this notification are subject to change.

Works in your area

Service relocations and road reinstatement on Borlase and Drysdale streets



Works are continuing to move utility services beneath Borlase and Drysdale streets. When these works are completed in August, permanent road reinstatement will follow.

Works will involve:

- Driveway access to 8 to 22 Borlase Street will remain closed with no vehicle access
- Access to the complex at 6 Borlase Street will be maintained via Lower Plenty Road until early August when the road is closed for reinstatement
- Borlase Street and Drysdale Street intersection will remain closed with vehicle access via Lower Plenty Road for Drysdale Street residents until final reinstatement in August
- Pedestrian footpath access and rubbish collection services will continue under current arrangements
- Road reinstatement activities including laying concrete kerb and channel outside properties, asphaltting and line marking.

What this means for you

Road closures on Borlase Street, opposite Borlase Reserve, and the intersection of Borlase and Drysdale streets have been extended until late August to safely complete early works happening in the area. Current detours arrangements will remain in place until then. Thanks for your patience while we safely deliver these important works.

Power line relocations on Greensborough and Lower Plenty roads



Works are continuing throughout June and July to relocate overhead power lines underground and remove power poles on Greensborough Road, Lower Plenty Road and Creek Bend Reserve. As part of these works there will be **continuous 24/7 works from 6pm Thursday 17 June to 6am Monday 21 June**.

Works will involve:

- Saw cutting, concrete works, digging using an excavator and use of vacuum truck
- Asphalt reinstatement and line marking works along Lower Plenty Road and Greensborough Road
- Replacing power poles on Greensborough Road and Creek Bend Reserve. These works may cause driveways to be blocked for short periods and impacted residents will be notified.
- The Creek Bend Reserve shared user path will be closed during these works
- Lane closures and reduced speeds on Lower Plenty Road and Greensborough Road with local detours in place.

Sewer and water service relocations on Greensborough Road



From June to mid-late August, we will be working in the southbound slow lane of Greensborough Road, between Drysdale Street and Finlayson Street, to connect the newly installed sewer and water pipes to the existing networks. Works will be completed during the day and night.

Works will involve:

- Excavation of a small section of Greensborough Road near the intersection of Drysdale Street
- Connecting the new pipes installed along Borlase Street with the water supply network
- Building two new sewer manholes in Greensborough Road and reinstating the road surface.

What this means for you

Works are planned to occur both day and night including Saturday and Sunday with extended hours. Lane closures will be in place along Greensborough Road between Erskine Street and Moorwatha Street.

There will be short-term lane closures in the southbound lanes of Greensborough Road and reduced speeds in place.

Drainage system installation in Borlase Reserve



Throughout June drainage works will continue in the Borlase Reserve and adjacent to Greensborough Road (north of Drysdale Street) to divert the Banyule Creek around Borlase Reserve.

Works will involve:

- Excavation to lay new culverts in the reserve
- Traffic management will be in place and there may be minor traffic delays on Borlase Street, north of Drysdale Street
- Increased truck movements in the area
- Construction noise from excavator, vacuum truck, and concrete saw
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times
- Removal and trimming of vegetation under the supervision of arborists and wildlife handlers.

Water pressure reducing station in Coleen Street Reserve and pipe track



We are continuing works near Coleen Street Reserve and in the pipe track to complete the new water pressure reducing station (PRS) by August. Some low level noise activities may be required on extended day work hours up until 10pm at night.

Works will involve:

- Laying underground water pipes and power cables
- Excavation of new trench and installation of new pipes, fencing, sheds and other water supply assets
- Construction vehicles accessing the water easement pipe track via Borlase Street
- Connection and commissioning of new pipes and the PRS and decommissioning of existing pipes.

Barrier and line marking removal on Greensborough and Lower Plenty roads



From late June to late August, we will be removing the barriers and temporary line marking along Greensborough Road and Lower Plenty Road. These works will occur at night due to worker safety and minimising traffic impacts.

Works will involve:

- Removing concrete barriers along Greensborough Road between Drysdale Street and Lower Plenty Road and between Lower Plenty Road and Borlase Street
- Removing existing temporary line-marking with hydroblasting along Greensborough Road and Lower Plenty Road and installing new permanent line-marking
- Short-term lane closures in the southbound lanes of Greensborough Road and Lower Plenty Road with reduced speeds in place
- Traffic management and signage will be in place to assist with local access.
