

Upcoming day works for North East Link

Site investigations will be happening near you soon as part of planning work for North East Link

What we'll be doing

We'll be doing geotechnical investigation in your area over the coming month. This involves:

- Using a drill rig and support trucks to establish a bore hole
- Drilling a bore hole 5 metres deep and 15 centimetres in diameter
- Restoring the site after works are complete.

Where and when we'll be working

In the rail corridor between Macleod train station and Greensborough train station.

- Monday 19 July to Friday 30 July.

What this means for you

Drilling works will take place between 7:00 am and 6:00 pm, Monday to Friday. While these works will not impact your property, you may notice:

- Noise generated from the drilling rig and support trucks when in use
- All train services will continue to run during these works.

Traffic controls will be directing cyclists and pedestrians when required safely around drilling sites. To ensure your safety and the safety of workers please follow any instructions and signs.

We appreciate your patience and understanding throughout these works.
