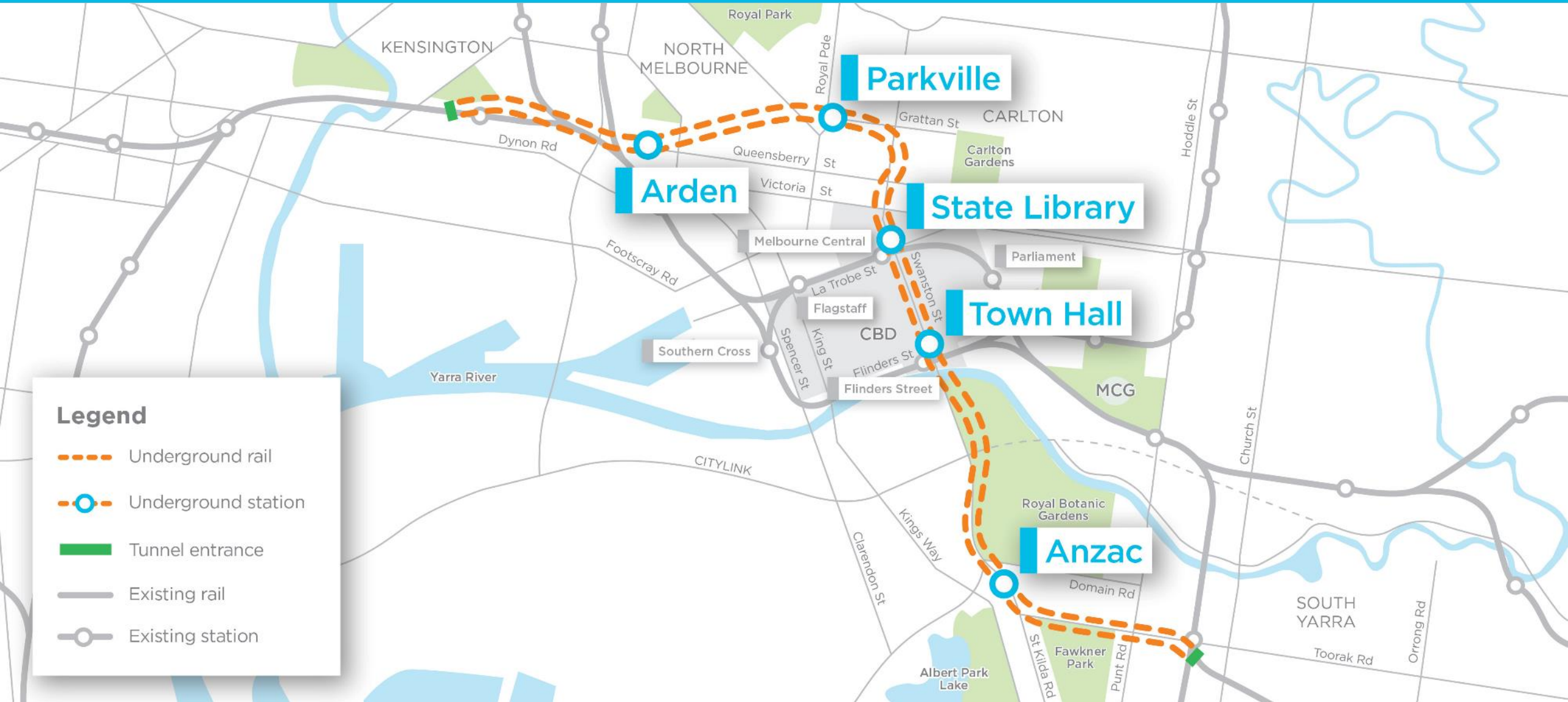

Precinct updates

Arden Station



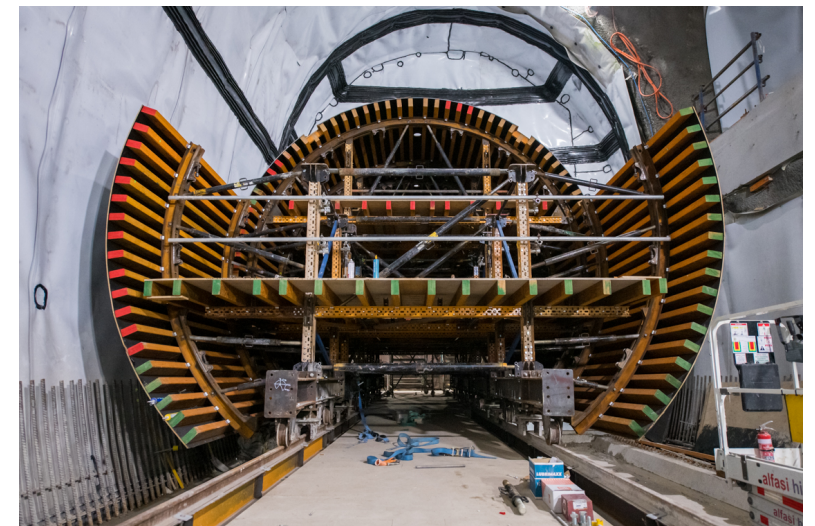
- Station arches completed, and supporting falsework removed
- Ground slab concrete pour beneath the arches complete
- Steel framework for the platform doors being installed
- Mechanical, electrical and plumbing works continue
- The first front of house elevators have been erected, with glazing being installed



- Excavation of the Royal Parade underpass is now complete
- The piles between the Grattan Street west and east sites have been removed, connecting the site for the first time
- At Grattan Street west, the base slab has been poured for the station entrances
- At Grattan Street east, the three gantry cranes are being removed in preparation for the next stage of works.



- TBM shield lining formwork underway the permanent lining that connects the Nozzle to the TBM Precast Segments
- Basement 4&5 excavation at Flinders Quarter is ongoing
- Works will commence in May to undertake works within Campbell Arcade to complete the connection with Flinders Street Station
- Surface works are continuing to prepare for first tower crane at City Square



Anzac Station



- Acoustic shed removed
- Demolition and break out of the temporary surface level of site has commenced
- Lift shafts, stairs and pedestrian walkways being installed in the tram-train interchange station entrance
- Firewalls, corewalls and permanent columns continue to be constructed in station box

(Excavation, excavated material removal, steel fixing, concrete pours and deliveries)

- Monday to Saturdays, 7am to 8pm

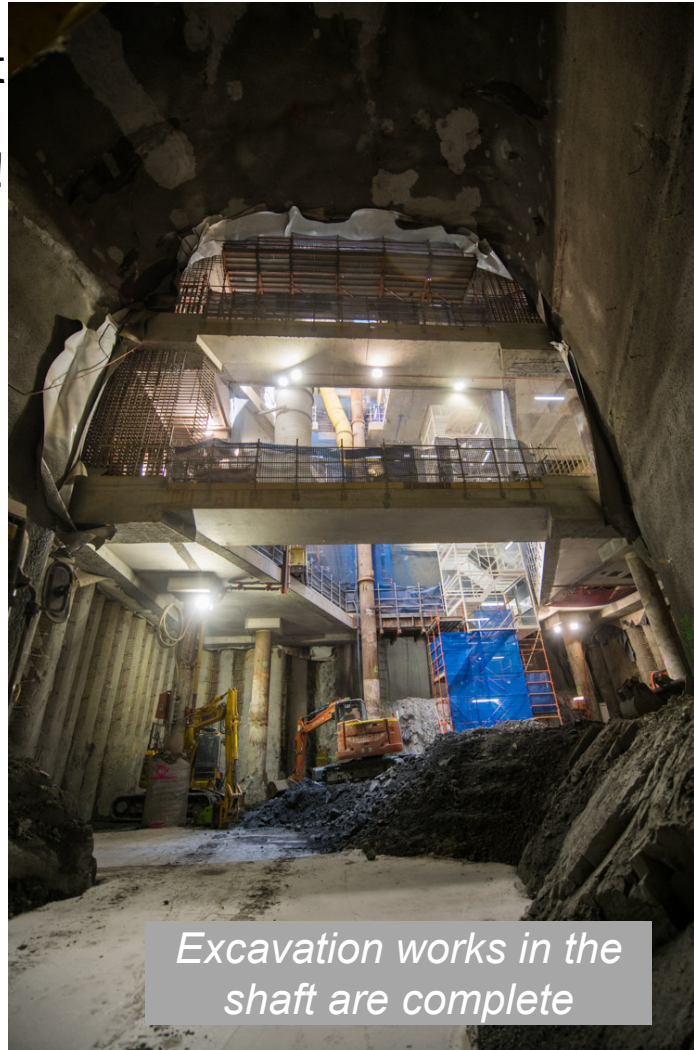


B3 level excavation

LITTLE LA TROBE STREET SITE



- Excavation of the shaft is complete
- Excavation of the Little La Trobe Street adit is close to completion. This will mark the end of excavation for the site!
- Excavation equipment is being demobilised. The scrubber will be demobilised under a weekend closure of Little La Trobe Street
- Works will soon commence from the bottom of the shaft up, and will mostly involve steel installation and concrete pours to line the shaft and internal walls.

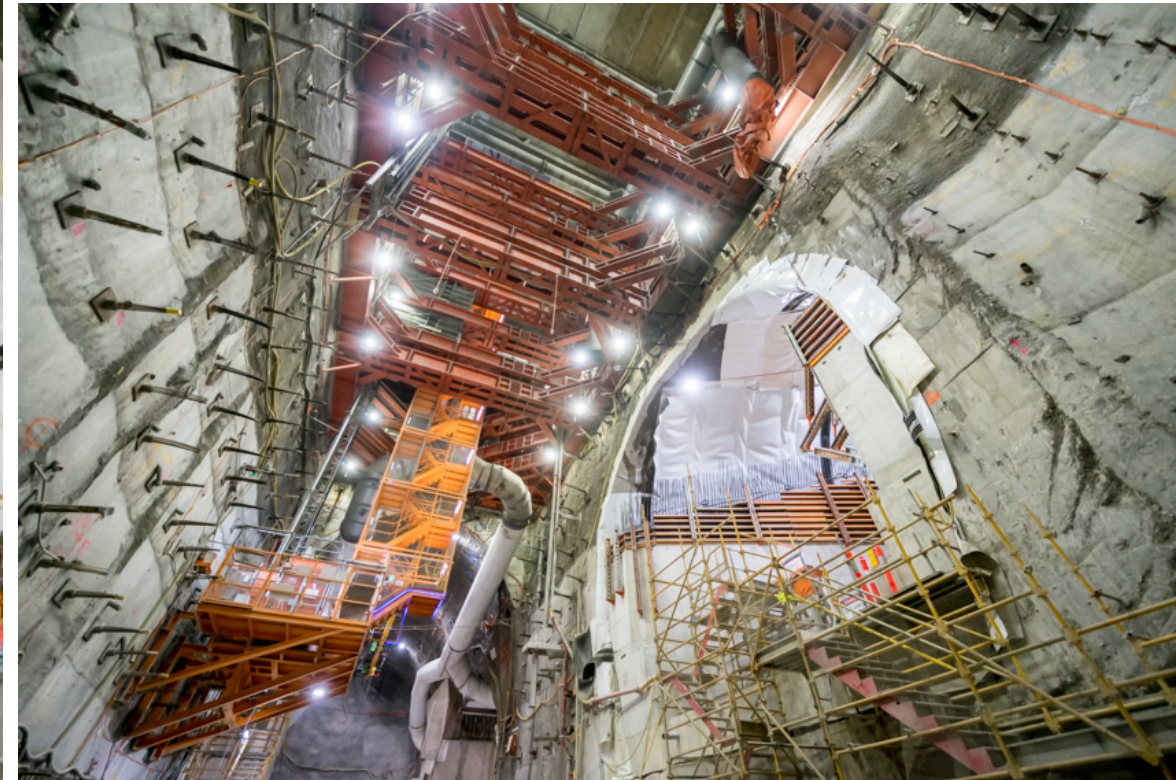

STRUCTURES AND LINING



- Inverts now completed in cavern
- Concrete pours are ongoing to construct the sidewalls
- Eastbound and westbound arch lining works ongoing
- Sidewalls continuing in March
- Undertrack crossing excavation work commencing at A'Beckett adit
- Lining works will commence in the adits following excavation
- Materials delivered from Arden bored tunnels where possible

FRANKLIN STREET SITES

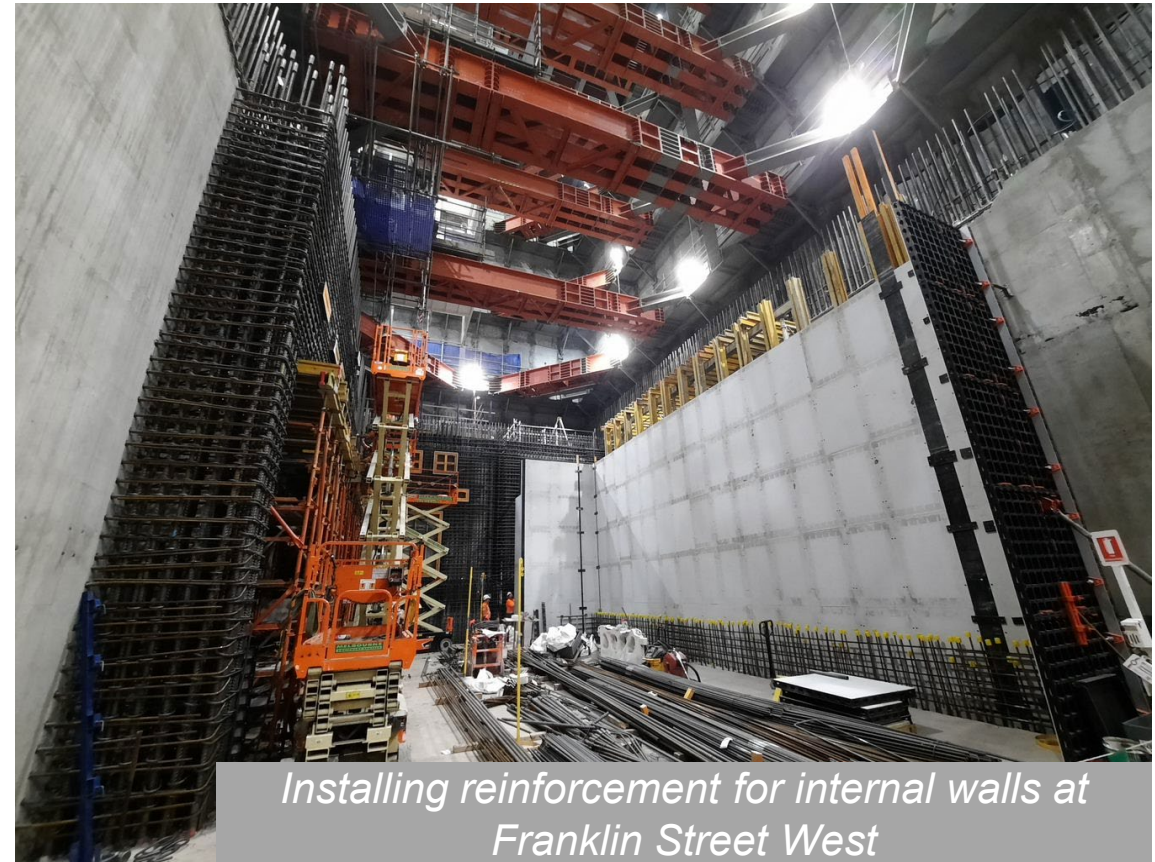


B4 slab poured at Franklin Street west

- Falsework and strut removal continuing
- Blockwork is now complete on B7 and B5 at Franklin East
- Mechanical and electrical works continuing and traction substations arrived this week
- First B4 wall poured at Franklin West
- Reinforcement is complete for lining walls at western end of shaft (at Franklin West)
- A temporary loading deck has been installed allowing for cavern logistics whilst the remaining excavation at A'Beckett adit is completed
- Laydown area changes underway at Franklin Street West with concrete line trenching commencing on Stewart Street this week.

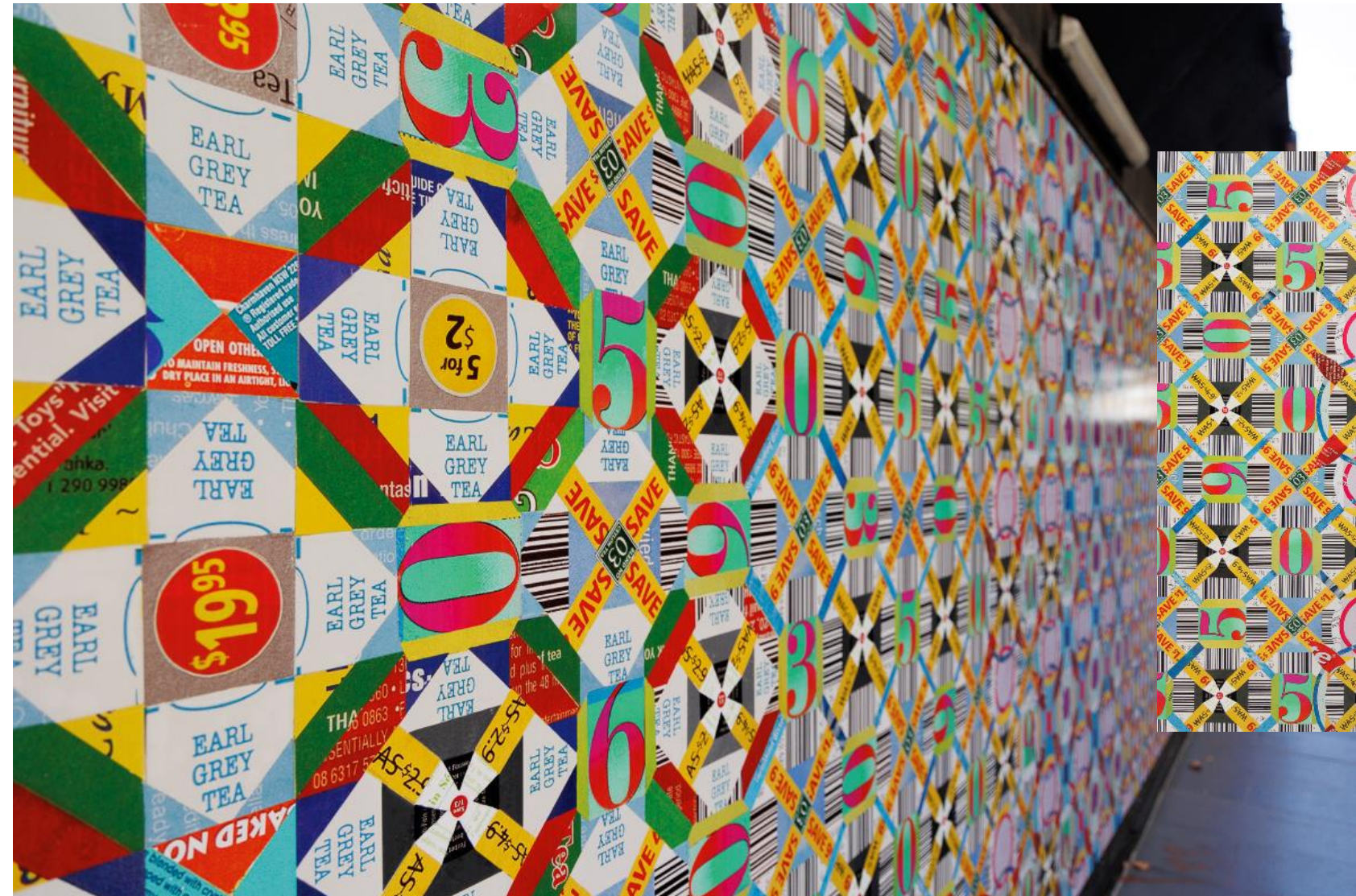
