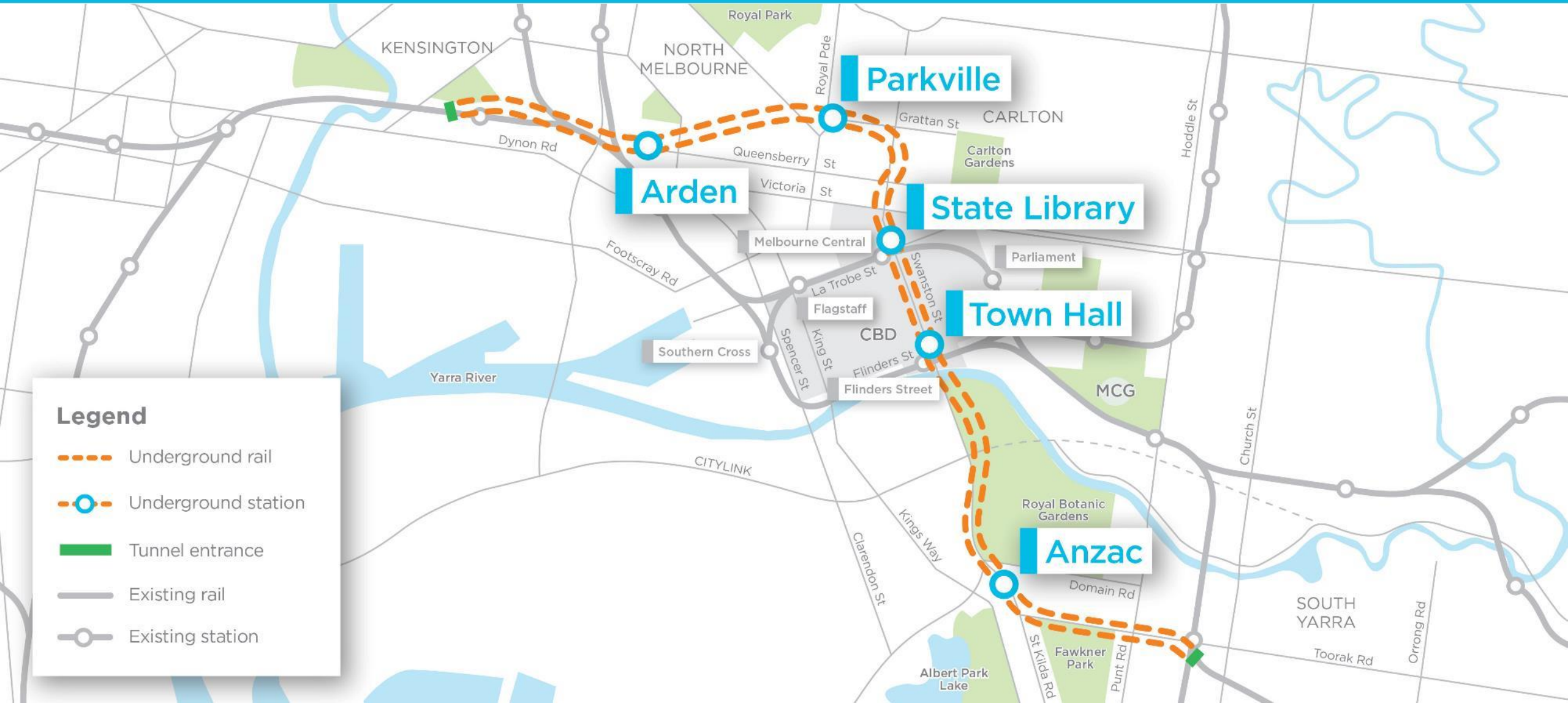

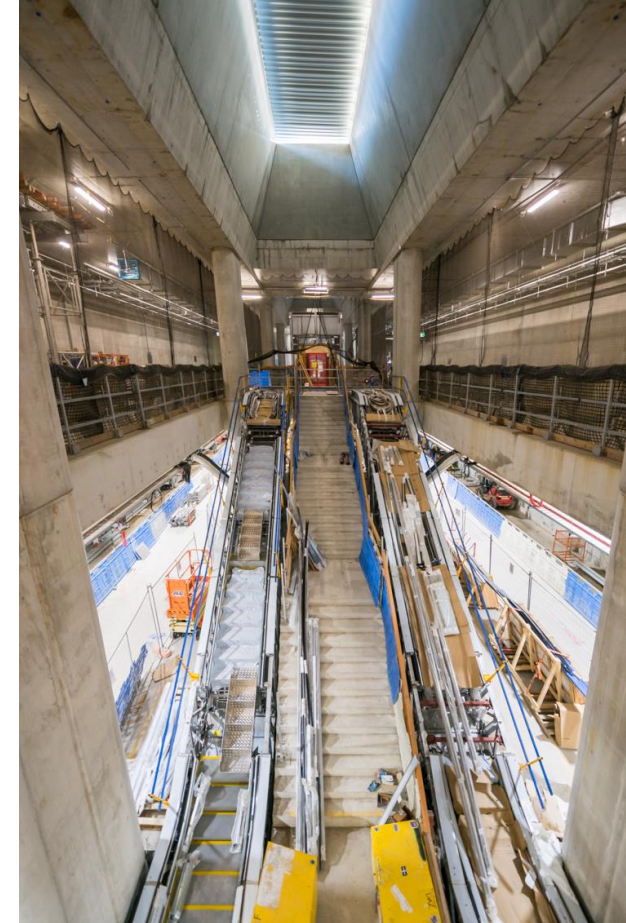
Project Alignment



ARDEN STATION



- Installation of the precast brick cladding around the new station entrance is nearly complete
- Future skylights for the station are now installed
- Escalators are now installed linking the main station entrance down to the concourse level



PARKVILLE STATION



- In the station box, architectural and mechanical, electrical and plumbing fit out works are ongoing
- In the station entrances next to the hospital, permanent structure works are ongoing
- All three gantry cranes have now been removed



ANZAC STATION



- Tram interchange on St Kilda Road is progressing with the cross laminated timber panels now installed on the roof of the canopy
- Platform construction continues underground

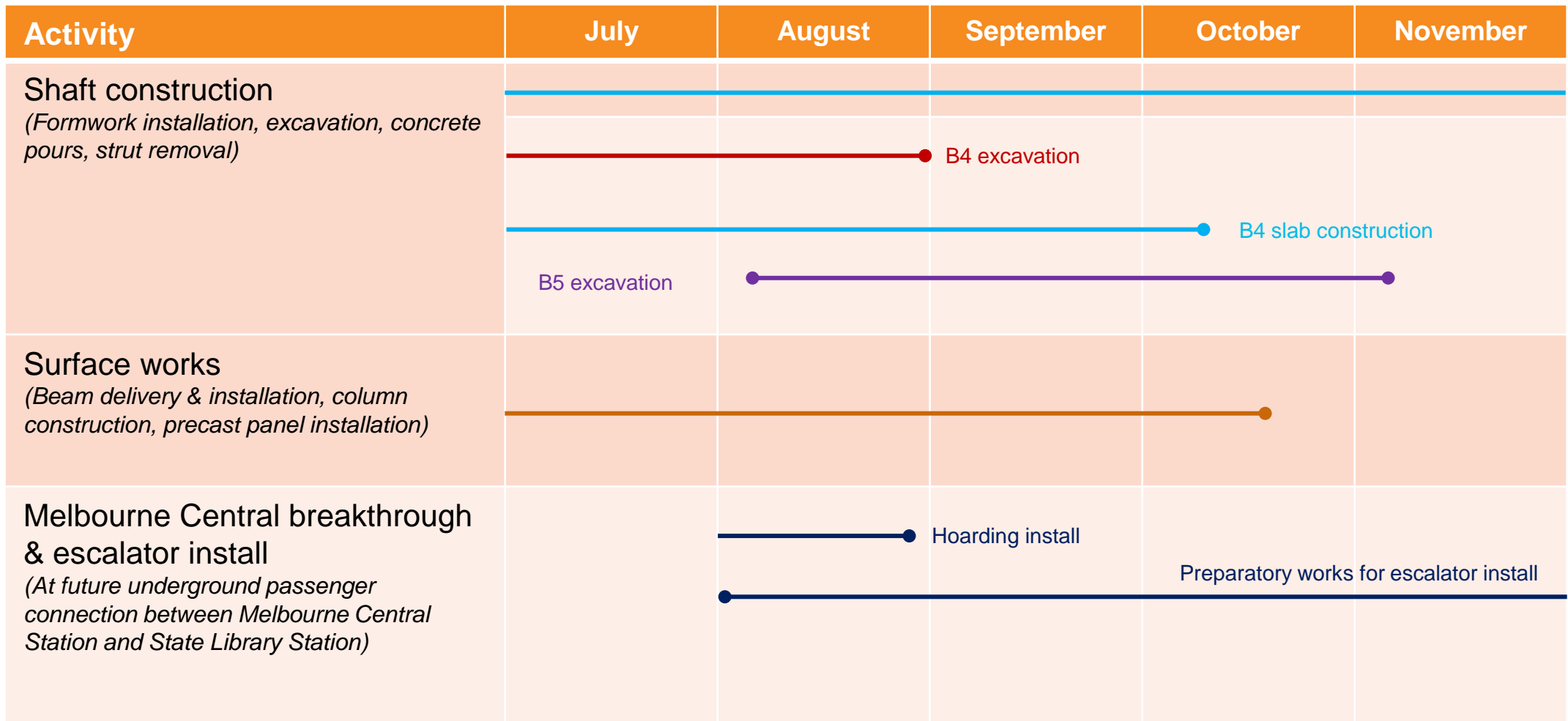

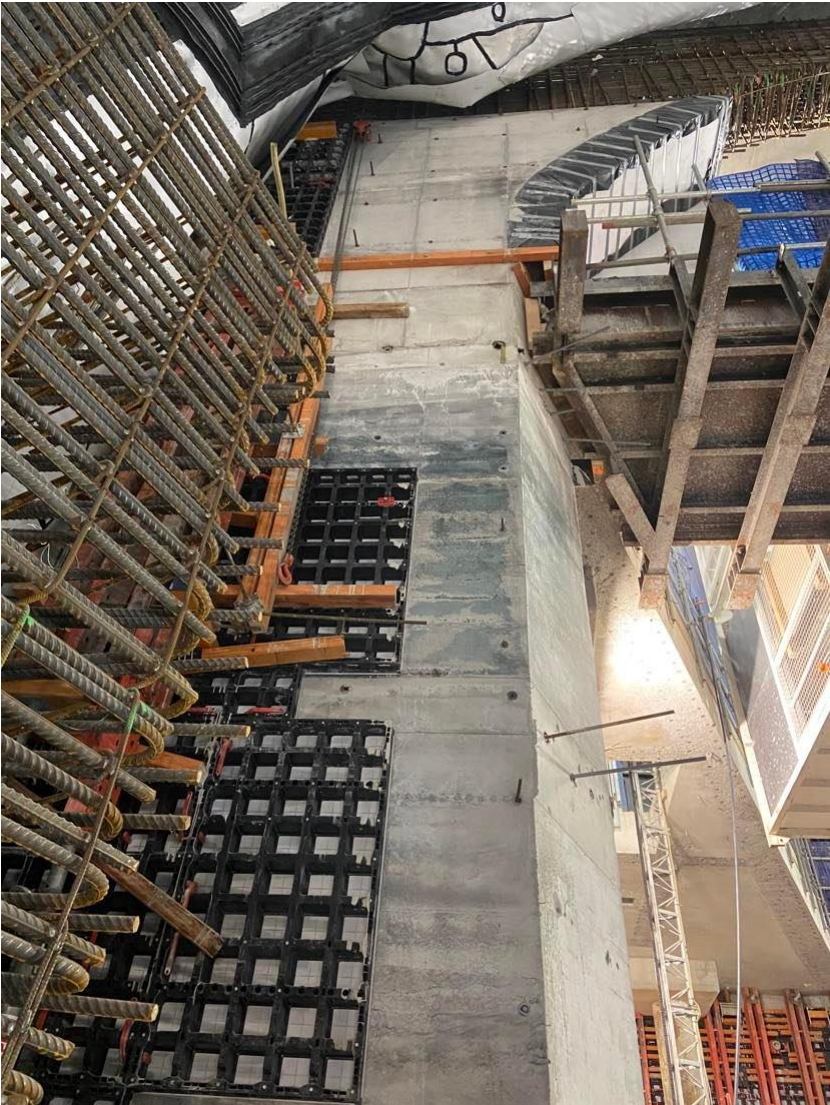

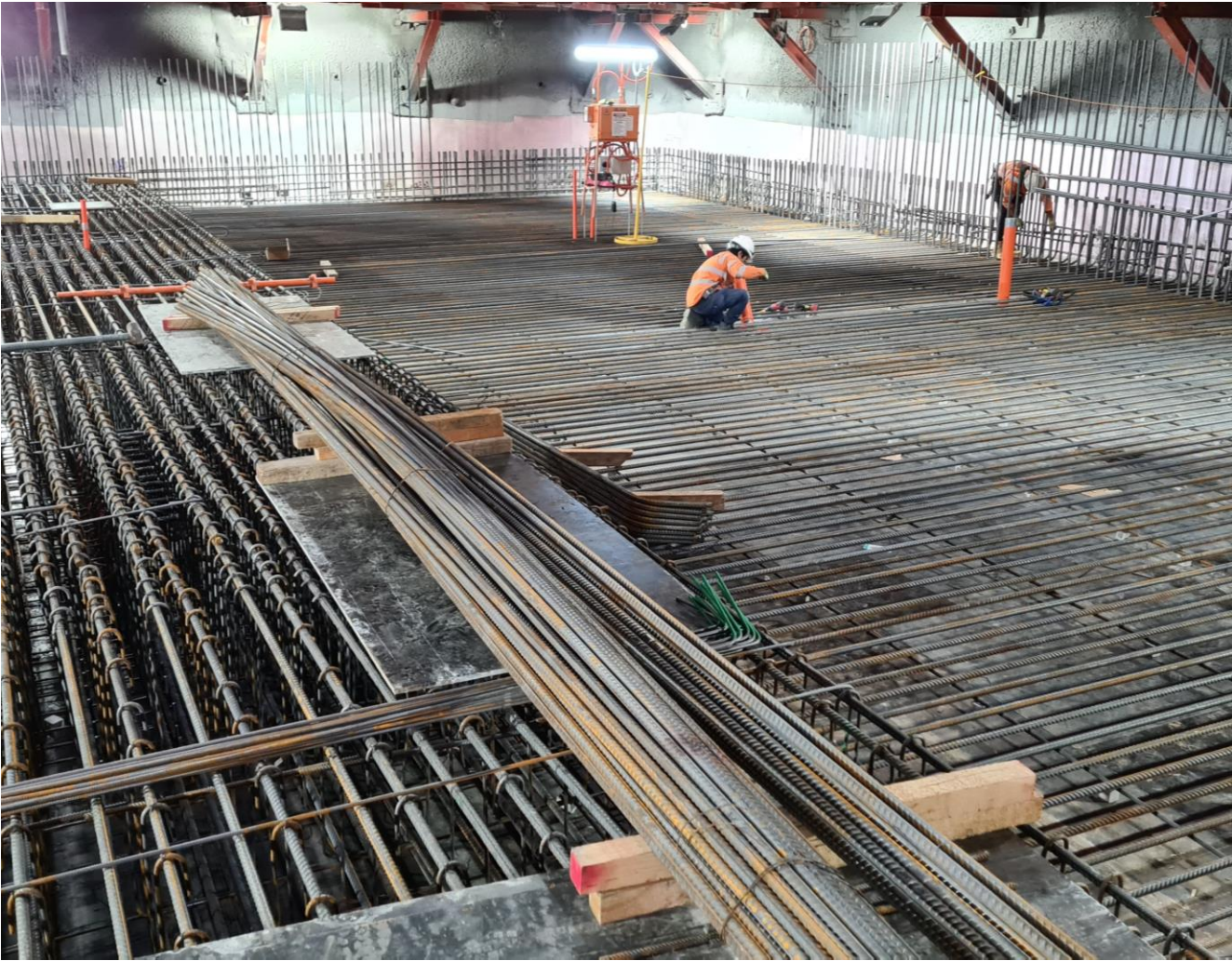

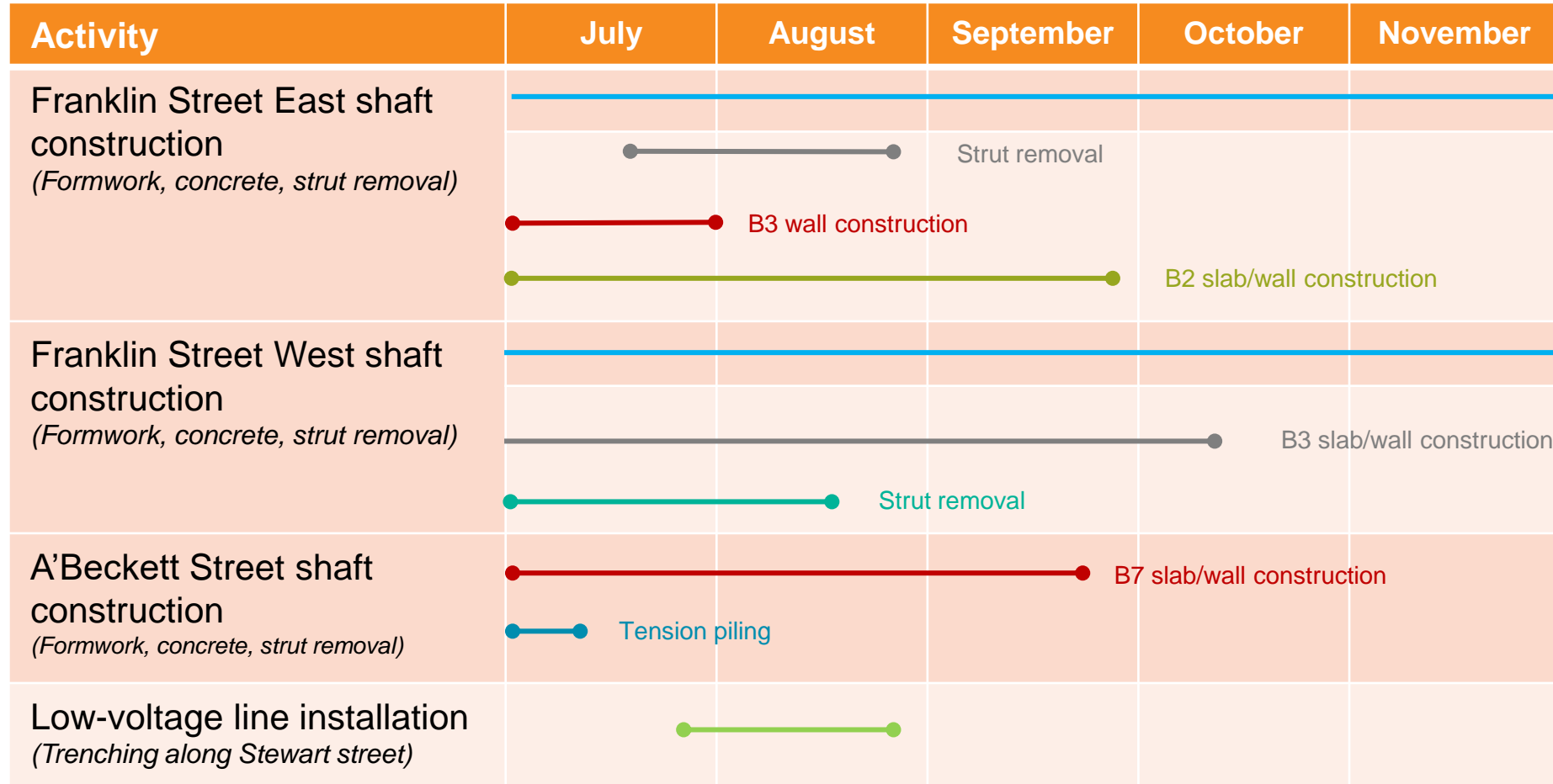

- Flinders Street full footpath closure scheduled for 3 months in 2022, rescheduled to 2023
- Benefits include
 - Support local business and CBD activity through key periods - September school holidays, AFL Grand Final series, Spring Racing Carnival, Christmas trade and January holidays including the Australian Open
 - Support increased pedestrian movements to local businesses following the reopening of the pedestrian crossing at the Flinders Street Tram Stop, and by maintain the temporary mid-block pedestrian crossing (near Woolworths) into 2023
 - Reduce the expected duration of the footpath closure by undertaking works in summer (less wet weather, illness)
 - Enables other disruptive works activities scheduled for 2023 to be undertaken simultaneously
- The revised construction program – for the 2023 footpath closure and single eastbound traffic lane reopening – is currently being developed in consultation with stakeholders
