











Business engagement








Maribyrnong River Bridges

Tunnels community engagement update

Recent notifications

- 9th February: Tunnel Boring Machine breakthrough at Southern Inbound portal.
- 27th February: Construction update northern portal and surrounds.
- 1st March: Construction at the northern portal on Whitehall Street and surrounding areas.
- 7th March: Last Rolling Notifications for the tunnel boring machine works.

Recent stakeholder/business engagement

Stakeholder engagement

- Doorknocks have occurred with residents near works such as Southern Portal for 24/7 cross passages works, tunnel boring machine breakthrough/ dismantling and road closures.
- Drop-in session at information centre for residents and the public. (8 March 2023 from 5pm-8pm)
- Temporary vibration and noise monitors installed.


Business engagement

- Engaging with businesses along Youell Street regarding parking impacts.
- Engaged with 67 business along Williamstown Road, Francis Street, Whitehall Street and Hyde Street regarding additional transports on the road.





Tunnelling Progress



- Bella final push. The TBM boring the 4km outbound tunnel, has excavated 3360 metres and installed 1400 rings as of 9am this morning (23/03)
- Bella is continuing to bore under the West Gate Freeway and is approaching the outbound portal.
- Vida has completed her journey and has broken through at Williamstown.

Vida Demobilisation



- Cutter head split and shield removed.
- Main drive to be transported back on site on super transporter.
- All large trucks will be moving overnight other trucks will be running 24/7 but don't require road closures
- Demobilisation will be completed May/June.

Bella Upcoming Breakthrough



- Breakthrough expected to occur in May.
- Most demobilisation works of the TBM will be completed with a crane.
- Reduced truck loads to be expected post demobilisation.
- Demobilisation will be completed within 3-6 months of breakthrough.



AN8	СРВЈН	CPBJH to confirm total number of trees to be replaced and removed.	Action to remain open. Landscape design packages are progressing with tree planting sketches sent to HBCC for comment around the changes to Kororoit Creek and Macarthur Road. Landscape designers will then update the packages in response to comments received.
ALL3	CPBJH / TU	CPBJH / TU to follow up an earlier than end 2023 re-opening of Federation Trail between Millers Road and Fogarty Avenue.	Action to remain open. Addressed last CLG by JV Construction Managers. All project parties working toward a solution.

Informal follow ups from last meeting:

- Horseshoe Bridge (Bridge 75) status update
- CPBJH to follow up with traffic team on traffic light sequencing around Williamstown Road inbound left turn lane to assist in current and future congestion planning.
- CPBJH to follow up on rubbish clean up around Fogarty Avenue Soccer Club car park.
- Trucks using Moore Street will be discussed further between MTAG and the Project.
- CPBJH to follow up with SW about an agreed site visit to Stony Creek Reserve to see progress of works in the area.
