

Works notice

Kerbing and asphaltting works

Arden Street, North Melbourne

Wednesday 7 June to Saturday 17 June 2023

A section of the westbound lane on Arden Street will be temporarily closed to support kerbing and asphaltting works. During this time there will be vehicle, cyclist and pedestrian access changes.

What we are doing

- Setting up traffic control on Arden Street between Lloyd and Laurens streets
- Closing a section of the westbound and bicycle lanes on Arden Street near the level crossing between Wednesday 7 June to Saturday 17 June outside of peak hours
- Installing bluestone kerbing and asphalt on Arden Street near the level crossing.

What to be aware of

- The westbound vehicle and cyclist lane and southern footpath on Arden Street will be closed during working hours
- During working hours, access to the Moonee Ponds Creek trail via the southern side of Arden Street will be closed, access via the northern side of Arden Street will be maintained
- Traffic management will be in place to assist two-way vehicle, cyclist and pedestrian movements
- Vehicle and pedestrian access to driveways and properties on the southern side of Arden Street will be maintained
- Construction vehicles, including excavators and compacting rollers will be used to support works
- These works are expected to generate low to medium levels of noise
- To reduce impacts to the community, these works will take place outside of peak hours, from 9am to 4pm weekdays and 7am to 3pm on weekends.

When

- From **Wednesday 7 June to Saturday 17 June**
- 9am to 4pm, Monday to Friday and 7am to 3pm, Saturday.

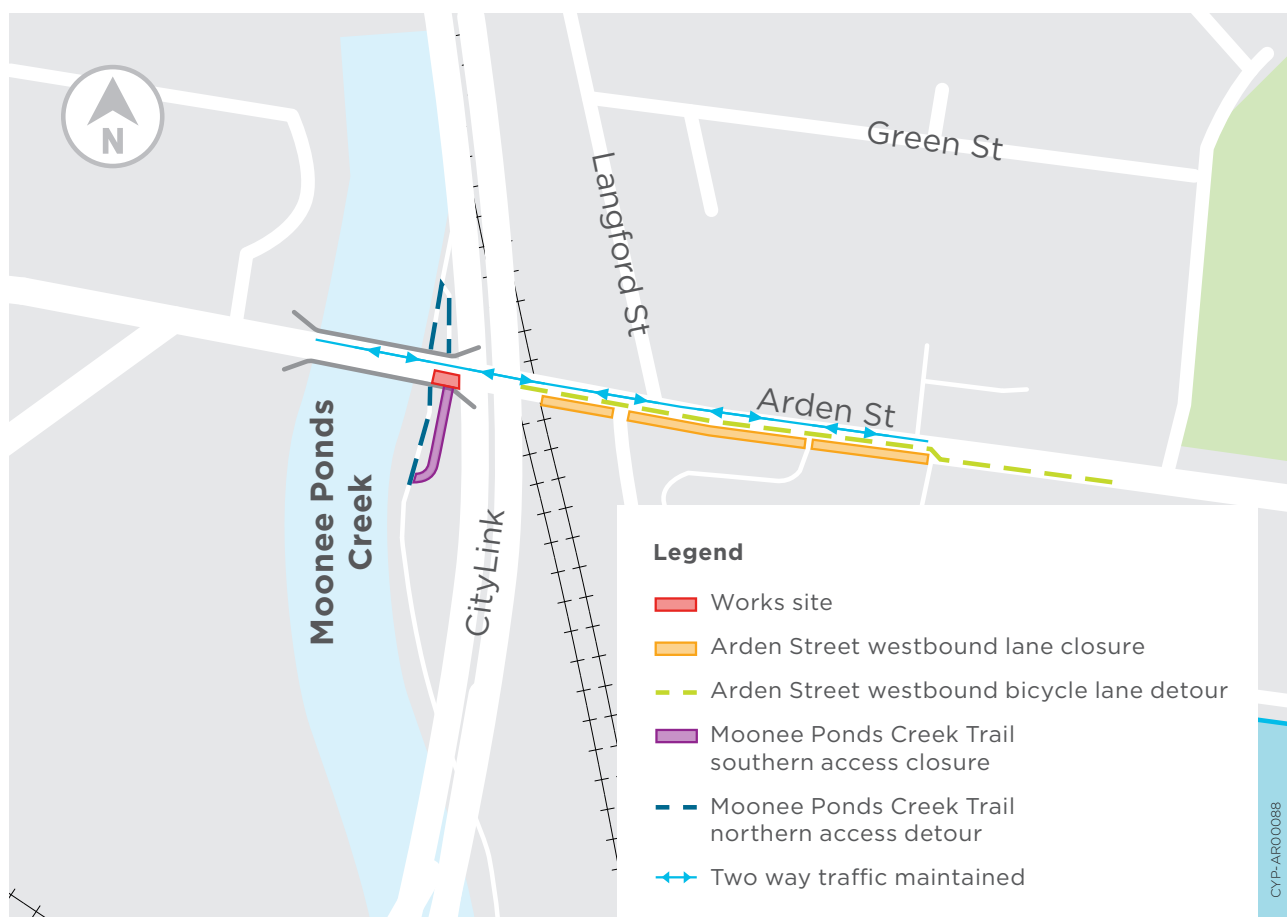
