

Works notice

Overnight works on St Kilda Road

Tuesday 12 to Friday 15 September

In September, the project will be combining a series of works over multiple nights. To safely do these works, they must take place overnight while St Kilda Road is closed in both directions, and trams aren't running. By bundling these works together, it reduces the overall number of nights.

What we are doing

- From Tuesday 12 to Friday 15 September St Kilda Road will be closed for three nights in both directions. Works will take place on the road itself and close to the tram tracks
- These works include:
 - Profiling and resurfacing the St Kilda Road and Park Street intersection
 - Excavating and installing power and irrigation connections at three locations across St Kilda Road
 - Line marking, traffic light and street pole installations
 - Installation of turf in medians
 - Removal of parts of the existing hoarding from the tram platform to create more room for passengers.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate periods of high-levels of noise associated with saw cutting, removal of the road surface prior to excavation, and the use of cranes to install traffic lights and light poles
- St Kilda Road will be closed each night in both directions, between Kings Way and Dorcas Street, from 8pm to 6am, on Tuesday 12, Wednesday 13 and Thursday 14 September
- Detours will be in place for traffic travelling northbound along St Kilda Road via Kings Way, Park Street, Wells Street and Dorcas Street
- Detours will be in place for traffic travelling southbound along St Kilda Road via Dorcas Street and Kings Way
- Access to driveways on St Kilda Road will be maintained at all times under the guidance of traffic controllers.

When

- These works will take place overnight from 8pm to 6am, each night on Tuesday 12, Wednesday 13 and Thursday 14 September.
