

Works notice

Accessible tram stop construction Elizabeth Street and Royal Parade, Parkville

5 October to December 2023

The Parkville Station precinct has moved into the final phase of construction with reinstatement and public realm works underway.

These works include service relocations, footpath, kerb and road pavement construction, traffic signal modifications, and installation of bus stops, a new accessible tram stop, street furniture, lighting and landscaping. There will be changes to the way you move around the precinct during these works.

From 5 October, early works will commence to enable the construction of an accessible tram stop on Elizabeth Street and Royal Parade, between Haymarket Roundabout and Genetics Lane. There will be bus replacement services at various times in November along sections of the Route 19 tram line.

What we are doing

- Site establishment, including installing water barriers, temporary fencing and signage around the perimeter of the work site
- Removing existing road infrastructure in the Elizabeth Street and Royal Parade inner lanes, between Haymarket Roundabout and Genetics Lane, which includes non-destructive digging, excavation and saw cutting
- Installing permanent infrastructure, including underground services, traffic signals and tram network services
- Cranes and hand tools will be in use to install new poles and associated infrastructure
- Constructing kerb and road pavements and tram platforms
- Completing landscaping works, including reinstatement of the tram corridor, adjacent medians, street furniture and other infrastructure related to the new tram stop
- Out of hours activities will occur as part of these works to minimise the impact on the public transport network
- There works are expected to generate intermittent periods of medium to high levels of noise.

What to be aware of

From 5 October

- The east-west pedestrian crossing on Royal Parade, adjacent to the Royal Melbourne Hospital car park, will close until early December to facilitate traffic signal works
- The Route 19 Stop 11 University of Melbourne/Royal Parade inbound tram stop, located near the Royal Melbourne Hospital car park, will permanently close.

From 21 October

- The inner lanes of Elizabeth Street and Royal Parade, between Haymarket Roundabout and Genetics Lane, will permanently close to enable a new accessible tram stop
- All vehicle and cyclist access on Elizabeth Street and Royal Parade will be permanently maintained via the outer lanes
- The right turn from the Royal Melbourne Hospital car park onto Royal Parade will close until early December
- Emergency vehicle access will be maintained at all times via the Royal Parade/Grattan Street intersection
- A single east-west pedestrian crossing at the Royal Parade/Grattan Street intersection will be open, and will switch between the north and south side of Grattan Street during these works.

Monday 30 October to Wednesday 1 November, and Sunday 5 to Wednesday 8 November, from 8pm to 6am

- Overnight works will take place to safely install new tram network infrastructure, including poles and overhead wiring.

From 14 November

- The Route 19 Stop 10 Royal Melbourne Hospital/Royal Parade inbound and outbound tram stop, located at the Grattan Street/Royal Parade intersection, will temporarily close until 30 November to enable the removal of tram infrastructure.

From 21 November

- The Route 19 Stop 11 University of Melbourne/Royal Parade outbound tram stop, located near the Royal Melbourne Hospital car park, will permanently close
- 24/7 works will commence in the Elizabeth Street/Royal Parade tram corridor, between Haymarket roundabout and Story Street, with buses replacing trams
- Further information will be provided ahead of these works, including any public transport, vehicle, cyclist, pedestrian or property access changes.

When

Working hours are:

- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am to 3pm, Saturdays
- 6pm to 7am, Monday to Sunday (as required).

Major 24/7 works in November 2023

From **Sunday 5 November to Wednesday 8 November**, from 9.30pm to the last tram each night, buses will replace Route 19 trams between Stop 7 Queen Victoria Market/Elizabeth Street and Stop 19 Brunswick Road/Sydney Road

From **21 November until 30 November**, 24/7 construction works will occur on Elizabeth Street and Royal Parade, to construct the new accessible tram stop between Haymarket roundabout and Genetics Lane

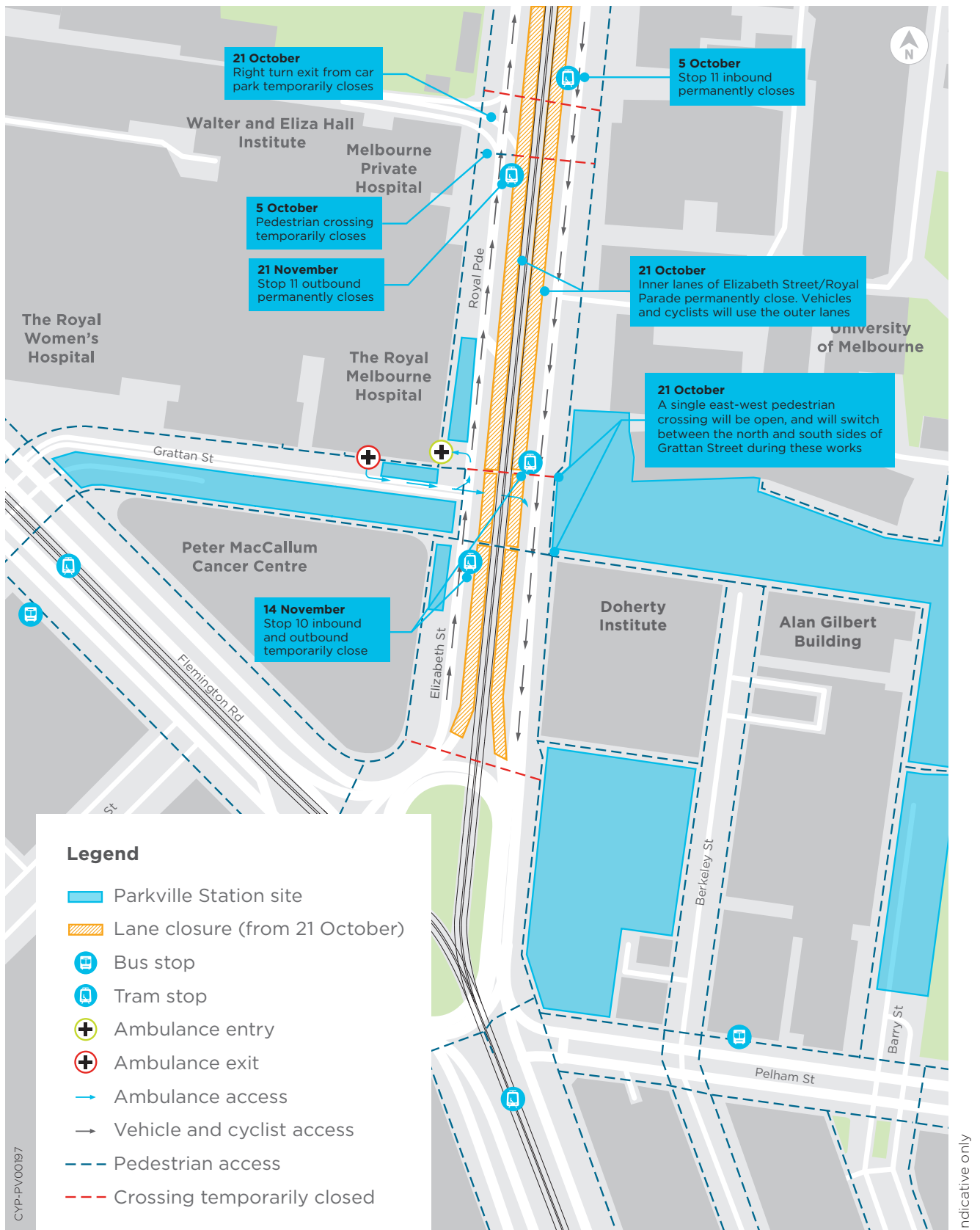
During this time, buses will replace Route 19 trams on Elizabeth Street and Royal Parade, between Stop 7 Queen Victoria Market/Elizabeth Street and Stop 19 Brunswick Road/Sydney Road

From 30 November, the new Royal Melbourne Hospital/Royal Parade accessible tram stop will be in operation
