

Construction update



Bridge beams and screening installed over Racecourse Road.

Works are progressing to remove all three level crossings in Pakenham, with rail bridges installed at McGregor Road, Main Street and Racecourse Road. New stations at Pakenham and East Pakenham are also taking shape.

During November, the project will be undertaking the following works:

- Continuing to build the rail bridge between Pakenham Station and Racecourse Road including the installation of the final L-beams, overhead steel, ballast, sleepers and rail
- Construction of the platform and station buildings at East Pakenham Station
- Installation of structural steel and panels which will form Pakenham Station's roof
- Upgrade works on Ryan Road
- Preparation for landscaping works between McGregor Road and Main Street.



What to expect:

- Construction vehicles and machinery movement
- Increased noise, dust and vibration
- Additional lighting at times
- Traffic management and detour signage
- Work hours Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm, and Saturday 7am to 3pm

Racecourse Road closure

Racecourse Road will be closed at the level crossing from **Thursday 23 to Friday 24 November**. This is to allow for the safe completion of works on the rail bridge.

Detour via McGregor Road and Princes Highway. Please allow additional time to move around the area and follow signage and traffic controller's instructions.

Main Street/Bald Hill Road lane closure

A southbound lane closure will be in place on Main Street/Bald Hill Road between Station Street and Webster Way between **Monday 27 and Wednesday 29 November**.

Detour via Station Street and Racecourse Road. Pedestrian access will be maintained.

Buses replace trains

From **9.30pm Friday 24 November until 3:00am Monday 11 December** buses will replace trains between Dandenong and Pakenham.

Coaches will also replace trains on the Gippsland Line during this period.

While trains are not running, we will be working in the rail corridor between **7am and 7pm Monday to Friday, and 7am to 3pm Saturday**.

This will enable us to safely install the canopy at Pakenham Station and complete overhead electrical and signalling works.

Access changes to Pakenham Station

From **late November 2023 until mid-2024** access to the carpark and Pakenham Station will change. This will allow construction to commence on the northern side of the new station.

Signage will be in place to help you move around the area.



Changes to how you travel

- Traffic management is in place for the safety of the community and workforce. Follow the signage and instructions when travelling around the project area
- At times, we will temporarily close roads, lanes, footpaths, and carparks
- Impacted residents and businesses will be notified
- Due to an increase in construction activity, there will be more truck movements and traffic in the area.

Every effort will be made to complete these works during scheduled hours, however at times works may be required to continue past standard working hours.
