

Works notice

Above ground structure works under road closure Little La Trobe Street

From 7am Tuesday 28 November 2023

As previously advised in the State Library Station November construction update, above ground structure works will require a road closure of Little La Trobe Street, between Elizabeth and Swanston streets, to operate a 130 tonne mobile crane on the street.

What we are doing

- Operating a 130 tonne mobile crane on Little La Trobe Street to construct the eastern above ground structure
- These works involve setting up a crane on the street which will lift large pre-cast concrete panels from trucks onto the Little La Trobe Street site
- The crane will remain on the road even when it is not in operation.

What to be aware of

- The works are expected to take up to two weeks to complete with the aim to reopen as soon as works are complete
- During this closure, access to Little La Trobe Street and Literature Lane will be maintained via Elizabeth Street (see map)
- Local vehicle access to businesses and residential buildings will be maintained at all times under traffic control
- Pedestrian access will be maintained with stop and hold arrangements in place (as required)
- Please allow additional travel time during these works
- A second closure will be required at a later date (details will be provided closer to the time)
- Some of these works will generate high levels of noise. Please contact the project team if you have any concerns.

When

- 24-hours, Monday to Sunday
- From 7am Tuesday 28 November until the work is complete.

Where

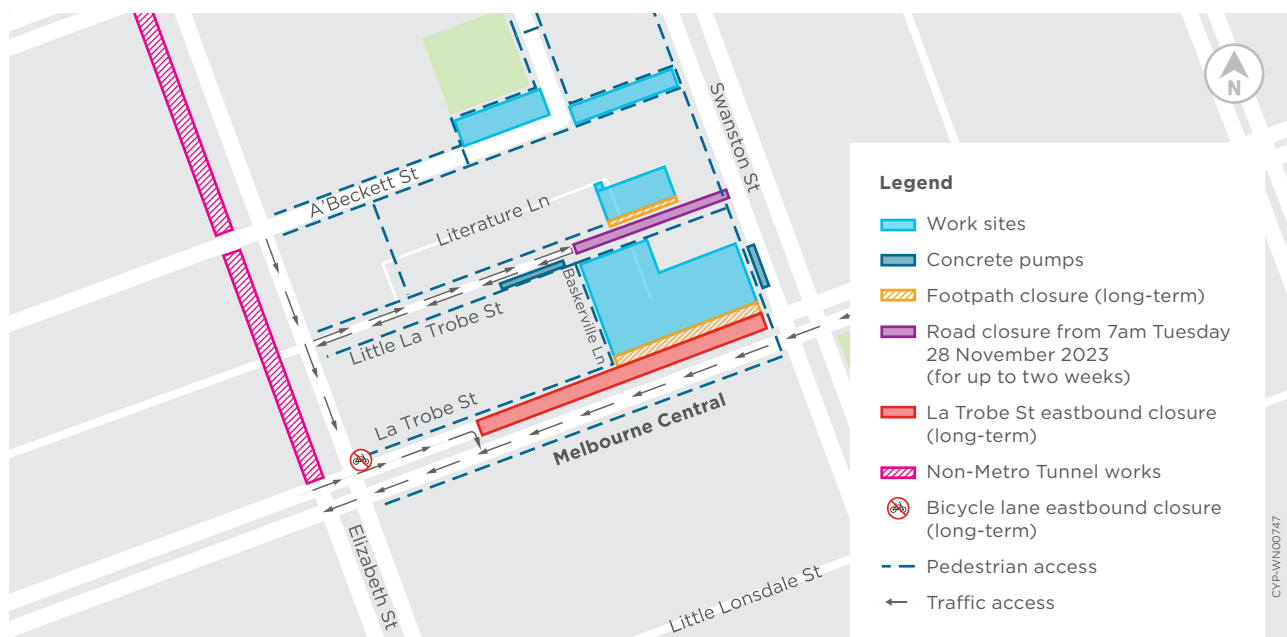
- Little La Trobe Street, between Elizabeth and Swanston Streets.
