Jeni Coutts (JC)	<p>Welcome and introductions</p> <p>Introduced new presenters Matt Watson, Alex Chan and Jonathan Rowlands</p> <p>Announced Luke Minton has moved into a new role and Shondelle Mathews will be attending these meetings going forward.</p> <p>Announced Natalie Pearson is leaving NELP. Jeni acknowledged Natalie's contribution to the group and wished her well in her new role. Elizabeth Patena will be the NELP lead going forward.</p>

	<p>Acknowledged apologies</p> <p>Previous actions</p> <p>MG: Why doesn't my request for complaints appear as an action? JW: This has been removed as it is now a regular part of the Spark presentation</p>
<p>Kate Zisos (KS)</p> <p>Alex Chen (ACh)</p> <p>Matt Watson (MW)</p>	<p>Spark Works Update</p> <p>ACh ran through a video of the site discussing aspects of the construction site and works. Provided timeline of key activities through to January 2024 at Watsonia and Yallambie sites.</p> <p>SP: How far down does the launch box need to be? AC: 10 metres</p> <p>SP: How high will the conveyor be? ACh: From the road to the bottom of the conveyor is approximately 8 metres</p> <p>JC: Will there be egress from the vent tunnel? MW: Access and egress is from the main box</p> <p>SP: What are the generators used for? AW: They power the hydro-mills and the bentonite plant.</p> <p>SP: What will the power source be once the generators are removed? MW: The substation will provide power once Jemena connects it.</p> <p>SP: Are they diesel generators? ACh: there will be fewer generators onsite once the substation is connected.</p> <p>MG: Is Banyule Creek 'barrelled' underneath? MW: Yes</p> <p>MG: Water from the construction site that goes into a pond is there any treatment? A batch discharge or continuous as the ponds fill? JR: We reuse water where we can, when we can't we do a batch discharge water is treated to be the same or slightly better than it was.</p> <p>MG: What treatment does it have? JR: PH, electrical conductivity, total dissolved solids, turbidity.</p> <p>JC: Is any of this information available online? JR: Water treatment is managed in line with the Project's strict Environmental Performance Requirements and environmental standards, including the EPA's Environmental Reference Standard. These documents are available online at North East Link's website and EPA Victoria's website.</p> <p>SP: Are you meeting the timelines? MW: Yes, we are meeting timelines</p> <p>GJ: Have you had many unexpected issues arise compared to what you prepared for? MW: There have been some small ones but nothing major.</p> <p>MM: Has the recent rain posed a challenge? MW: We have lost a couple of days on occasion as the site is still being set-up but we are prepared for a one in one hundred year rain event.</p> <p>Environmental Management</p> <p>Can the Bentonite plant be built in? JR: Due to its size the bentonite plant is unable to be built in. We always try to mitigate noise at the source and have placed blankets on the desander and use centrifuges rather than shakers as they are quieter. Once Jemena turns the substation on the generators powering the bentonite plant will be removed</p> <p>JC: When will the substation be turned on? JR: We are planning to turn these on in November but are waiting for Jemena to confirm.</p> <p>WH: What are the bentonite plants hours of operation at the moment? JR: 6pm - 2am generally, it would be rare, excluding a safety reason, that they would work past this. It also depends on what tasks are being performed as some, such as drilling, can't be stopped once it starts to maintain the integrity of the foundations.</p> <p>WH: Site lighting continues to be an issue for some residents JR: We are continually working on reducing impact on residents but also need to ensure there is adequate lighting for works to continue safely. If there is a specific light tower reported that is an issue, we can investigate and see if we are able to redirect it. WH: I will follow up with residents and see if there are any specific issues.</p> <p>SP: Water is also a major concern JR: Street drainage is captured in an existing underground drainage network. Construction water near the desanding basin is treated to EPA standard before being treated and discharged.</p> <p>MG: What is the treatment? JR: It's manually and chemically treated to drop the sediment, dose it with an acid alkaline.</p> <p>MG: Have you looked into the erosion effect downstream of the hardstands? JR: We assess to ensure there is sufficient capacity before we discharge water and it goes through rocks to slow the flow so there is not enough speed to cause erosion and sedimentation downstream.</p>

	<p>MG: Where does the carpark drain into? JR: The water goes through a series of filters which only allow water through and is then discharged into the stormwater system.</p> <p>Community Engagement</p> <p>MG: Was the Community Event at Winsor Reserve just for the local residents? KZ: Yes, invites were sent to residents of Somers Avenue, Torbay Street, Wattle Drive, Lindsay Street and Tuckfield Court. This was a barbeque and also to give residents an opportunity to provide feedback on what artwork they would like to see on hoarding.</p>
Scott Lambert (SL) Kim Norton (KN)	<p>Northern Package Update</p> <p>MM: The Nillumbik Disability Advisory Group has advised that the information residents have been receiving is really good as they are including disability services during the rail disruptions. SM: I will pass this feedback onto MTM.</p> <p>MG: How long does the community have to provide feedback on the UDLP? KN: 21 days</p> <p>SP: When does the 21 days start? KN: From the day the UDLP opens</p> <p>MM: If people aren't able to get online is there assistance available to make a submission? KN: Yes, they are welcome to go to the Hub or we can arrange a suitable option.</p>
Jeni Coutts (JC)	<p>Open Forum</p> <p>SP: It's unclear when coming from the north along Greensborough Highway where the lane is to get onto Watsonia Road KZ: We are planning a line marking refresh so I will raise this with the traffic team to see if this can be included</p> <p>GJ: I'm in frequent contact with the AMA Team. KN: Some residents closest to the works have been offered property condition surveys and this will be offered to more residents in future.</p> <p>MM: I have received feedback that taxis are being used from the west rather than the north for the workers onsite. KZ: I will look into this</p> <p>MM: The feedback from the taxi company is they are happy with the progress of the works</p> <p>MG: Why and how long for are the drill rigs working on Banyule Rd in Rosanna? JR: They are doing geotechnical and groundwater investigations and should be finished in less than a month.</p> <p>MG: Has the tunnel route been confirmed yet? JR: This is currently not available but should be in the coming months</p> <p>SP: Will the TBM route be determined by ground conditions? JR: No, Engineers will determine this.</p> <p>MG: How many more homes have been acquired since the last update from Lower Plenty Rd to Watsonia? EP: There have been no further acquisitions, however some residents have taken up the offer of VPS.</p> <p>MG: Will we be able to do a site tour? KZ: Yes, we are trialling how these will run at the moment and will let you know when a date is available.</p> <p>AH: I have a contact that would like to be a NEL supplier, how do they apply? JC: KZ will provide the details</p> <p>Next meeting 27 October JC Thanked NBLG members and presenters and closed the meeting at 11:41am</p>
