

Works notice

Bowen Crescent closure at St Kilda Road and driveway closures

Thursday 14 December to Saturday 16 December 2023

Bowen Crescent will be closed at the St Kilda Road intersection to build a raised pedestrian crossing. We are asphalting parts of St Kilda Road northbound between Bowen Crescent and Bowen Lane. These works require closures of local driveways.

What we are doing

- Closing Bowen Crescent at the intersection of St Kilda Road from 14 to 16 December
- Closing the Bowen Crescent driveway of 400 St Kilda Road between 8am and 4pm on Friday 15 December to lay asphalt over utility trenches
- Closing the St Kilda Road driveway of 400 St Kilda Road between 8am and 4pm on Thursday 14 December and 8am to 4pm on Friday 15 December
- These works will require the use of excavators with hammer attachments to break back the road surface, saw cutters, Non-Destructive Digging trucks, compaction equipment, delivery trucks, forklifts and asphalt pavers
- Installing new kerbs and constructing a raised pedestrian crossing.

What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate high levels of noise during the breaking back of the existing road surface and some vibration when compacting the new raised pedestrian crossing
- There will be a detour in place from St Kilda Road to Bowen Crescent via Albert Road and Kings Way
- There will be a detour in place from Bowen Crescent to St Kilda Road via Kings Way
- There will be a pedestrian detour in place to cross Bowen Crescent near Queens Lane
- Some parking on Bowen Crescent will be occupied to allow for these works to take place safely

- There will be some delays accessing the Bowen
 Crescent driveway of 400 St Kilda Road on Thursday
 14 December as profiling works are underway, Traffic controllers will coordinate entry and exit on the day
- On 16 December, the Bowen Crescent intersection will reopen in both directions.

When


- The full closure of Bowen Crescent at St Kilda Road will be in place 24 hours a day from from 7am Thursday 14 December to 6pm Saturday 16 December 2023
- Works will take place during standard construction hours on Friday
- Due to the nature of the works we may work past standard construction hours on Saturday, but will not work beyond 6pm.
