Your new Narre Warren Station precinct



As part of the Victorian Government's commitment to removing 110 dangerous and congested level crossings, we've removed the level crossing at Webb Street, Narre Warren.

The Webb Street boom gates were down for up to 33 per cent of the morning peak, causing delays for 13,200 vehicles every day.

We've now completed the new rail bridge over Webb Street after installing giant concrete beams, a steel bridge section over Narre Warren-Cranbourne Road and new rail tracks. The new, elevated Narre Warren Station will open in late March 2024. We'll continue working until mid 2024 to finalise the station precinct, including the remaining car parks, path connections and the new landscaped forecourt.

The new station will feature two accessible elevated platforms, an air-conditioned waiting room and kiosk, secure bike storage, a landscaped forecourt with seating, and improved pedestrian connections to Narre Warren Village. See the next page for a map of your new Narre Warren Station precinct.


