

## Reinstatement and public realm works

### Franklin Street, between Elizabeth and Stewart streets

From August until October 2024

The State Library Station precinct is moving towards the final phase of construction with reinstatement and public realm works underway.



#### When we'll be working

- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am to 1pm, Saturdays

For the safety of pedestrians and vehicles, site establishment activities for each stage will occur between 6pm and 6am.

Throughout the State Library Station precinct, staged reinstatement and public realm works are ongoing until late 2024.

These works include service relocations, footpath, kerb and road pavement construction, traffic signal modifications, and the installation of street furniture, lighting and landscaping.

Reinstatement and public realm works will take place up to property boundaries, including on footpaths and directly adjacent to building entrances. There will be changes to the way you move around the area during these works.

#### What we'll be doing

- Site establishment including installing traffic barriers, temporary fencing and signage around the perimeter of the work sites
- Removing sections of the existing traffic lanes and kerb, traffic islands and vehicle and motorcycle parking bays. This will include non-destructive digging, excavating and saw cutting
- Installing new infrastructure including stormwater drainage
- Reconstructing the traffic lanes, parking bays, kerbs and road surface, including asphaltting and line marking
- In the coming months, work will be undertaken to construct protected bike lanes and complete the parking and traffic lane arrangements. Notification will be provided prior to these works.

#### What to be aware of

- The works will be staged to minimise disruption and to provide limited parking during works. Please refer to the maps for indicative timing
- Vehicles will be able to travel both eastbound and westbound around the work sites
- Pedestrian access will be maintained
- Traffic management and signage will be in place to safely direct vehicles, cyclists and pedestrians around the work sites
- Access to buildings and businesses will be maintained at all times
- These works are expected to generate periods of medium to high level noise, depending on the work activity
- These works are weather-dependent, and timing will be based on site progress, which is subject to change. Local stakeholders will be directly informed of changes.

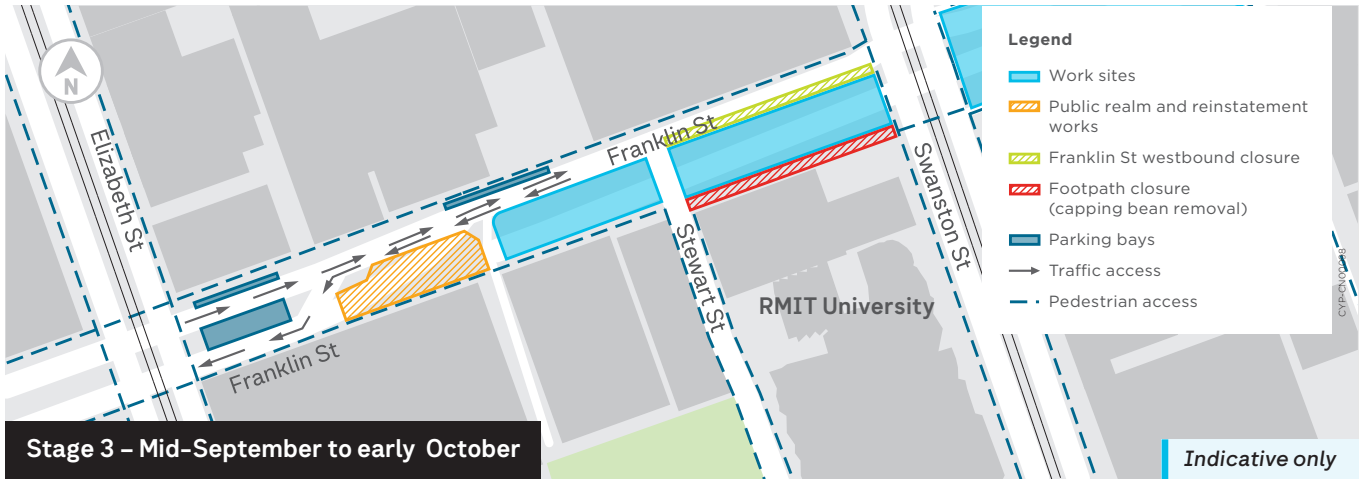
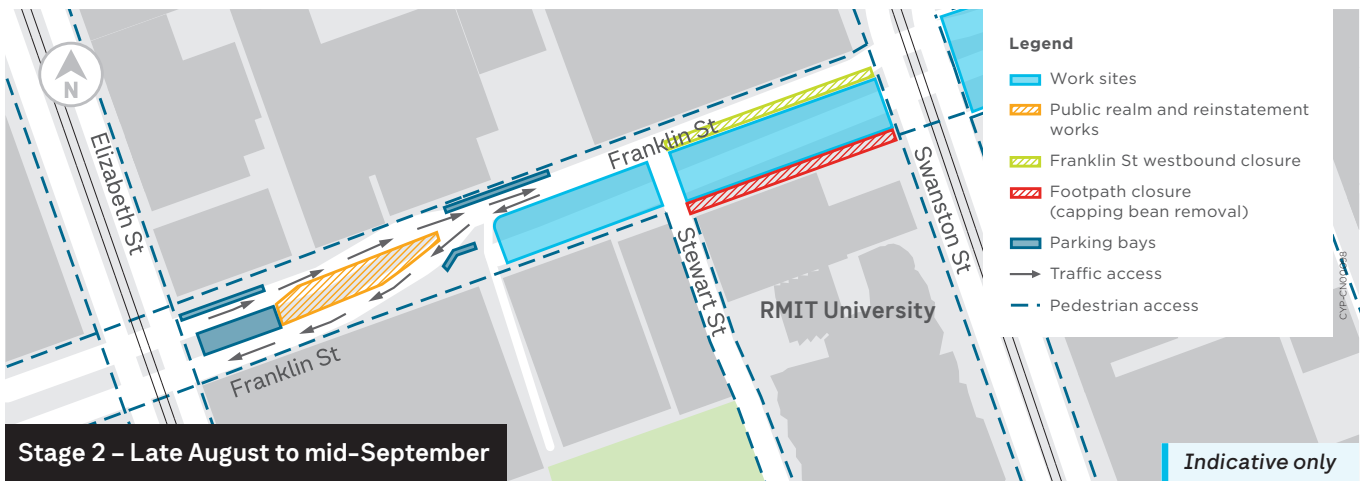
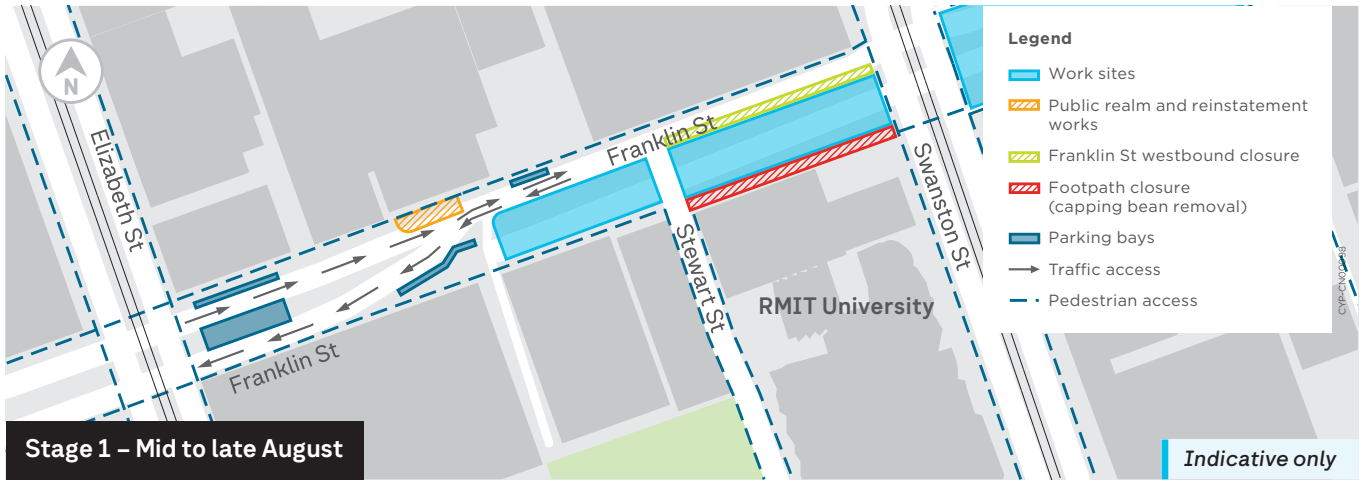
