

# Construction update



## Domain Precinct

October 2024

Works to construct the Metro Tunnel's Anzac Station are nearing completion, with good progress on the final major works above ground. This update provides an outline of current and upcoming works in your area in October 2024.

### Works snapshot: October

In September, the section of parkland between St Kilda Road and Kings Way was opened to the public. This included additional angled parking on Albert Road.

The one way connection from 1 Albert Road to St Kilda Road was also opened, while final landscaping commenced in the Albert Reserve.

In October 2024 works within the Domain precinct will focus on the completion and reopening of Domain Road, completion of landscaping works at the Albert Road Reserve station entrance, and the reinstatement works at Edmund Herring Oval.

Later in 2024 works will focus on final rectification works and the handover of completed areas to local councils, as the main works are complete.

Construction works within the Domain precinct during October 2024 will include:

- Reinstatement works on Domain Road and construction of a new dual purpose bus and tram stop
- Edmund Herring Oval reinstatement works
- Asphaltting of Domain Road footpaths.

## Upcoming works in your area

### Domain Road construction and Edmund Herring Oval reinstatement

#### Between St Kilda Road and Domain Street



#### Ongoing – 2024

- Final footpath asphaltting will take place in October
- Domain Road will reopen to traffic soon, in mid-October
- The reinstatement of Edmund Herring Oval will continue in October, once complete the oval will be handed back to City of Melbourne.

### Station entrances construction

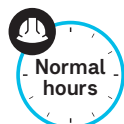
#### Albert Road Reserve, west entrance



#### Ongoing – 2024

- During October, works will continue on landscaping around the station entrance within Albert Reserve.

#### Ongoing – 2024

- Hard landscaping works around the station entrance will continue in October, works will include installation of signage and final fitout of the station forecourt.

#### Concourse and platform level of station box

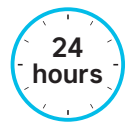


#### Ongoing

- Major construction and finishing works have been completed within Anzac Station
- Internal system testing is now underway within the station.

### Equipment Delivery

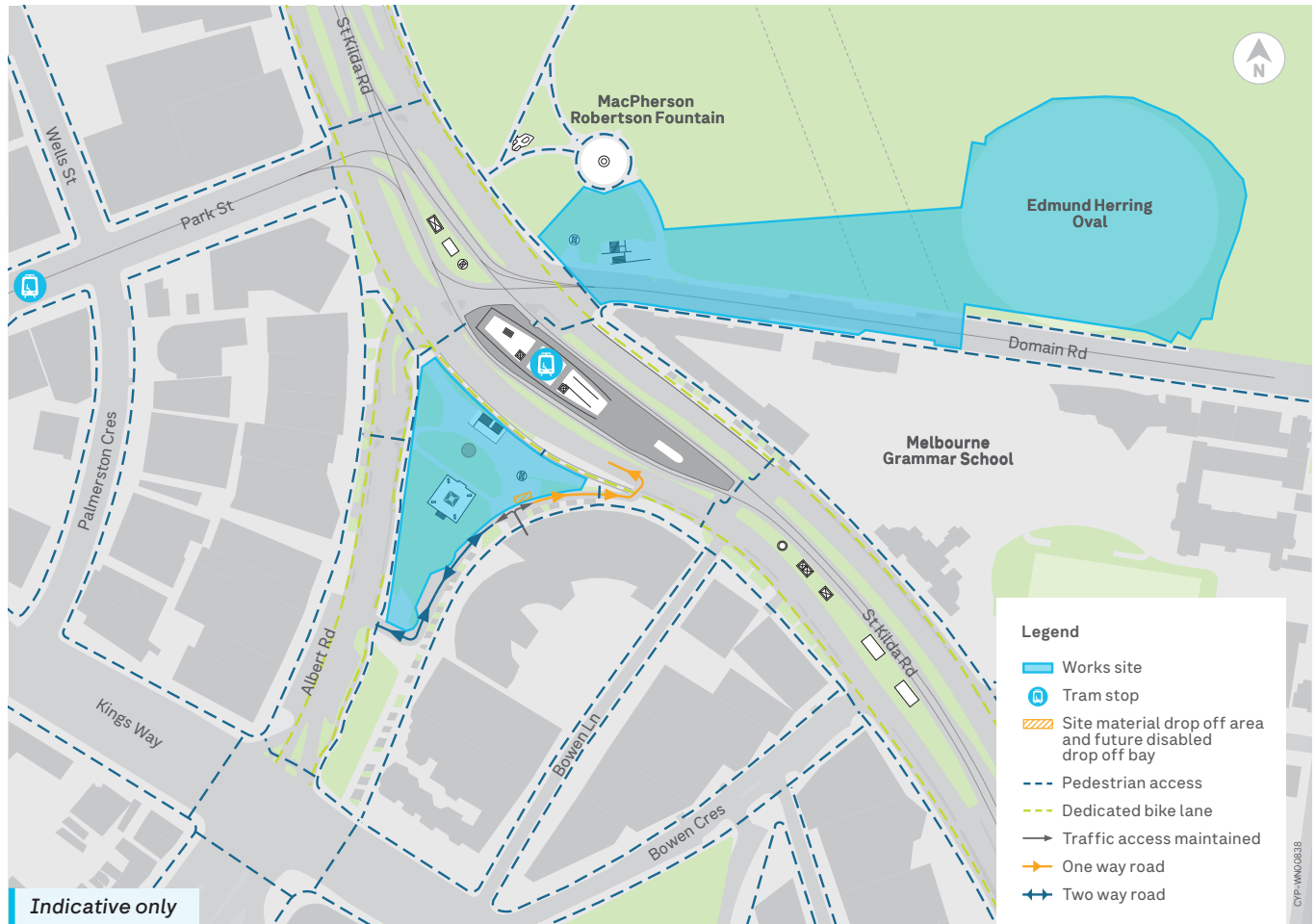
#### St Kilda Road Service Hatch



#### October 2024

- As part of the ongoing operation and maintenance of Anzac Station, a specialty boom lift has been manufactured and will be delivered to the station
- Due to its size it will need to be lowered into the station via the service hatch in front of 400 St Kilda Road
- This will require the the overnight closure of St Kilda Road between Toorak Road and Albert Road
- Traffic will be detoured via Kings Way and Park Street
- Driveway access for The Botanica will be via Bowen Crescent. Delays are expected when lifting is underway
- Traffic controllers will be in place to assist with entry and exit to buildings
- Further information will be provided closer to the date.

## Traffic and transport impacts October 2024

### Domain Road Reopening

- Domain Road will reopen to traffic on mid-October.

### Oversized deliveries

- While most deliveries to the Anzac Station site will occur during normal hours, some deliveries to and from site that are classified as 'oversized' will be required outside of normal working hours and overnight. Whenever oversized deliveries are expected overnight, crews will be reminded of noise requirements on site.

### Domain Road pedestrian footpath

- The pedestrian footpath from St Kilda Road up Domain Road will close for one day during October to complete the final layer of asphalt. Detour signage will be in place on the day.

## Domain Road reopening soon in mid-October

We are working to complete the final reinstatement works along Domain Road, which include the final asphalt and installation of street furniture.

Domain Road, between St Kilda Road and Dallas Brooks Drive is scheduled to reopen to traffic in mid-October

We will provide more information soon, closer to the date.
