

# Heatherton and Clarinda works update


July 2025


Works are underway in Heatherton and Clarinda to deliver Suburban Rail Loop (SRL) East for Melbourne and Victoria.

## What we are doing

### Stabling Facility, Heatherton


- Building the Eastern Tunnel Entrance (ETE) and Western Tunnel Entrance (WTE)
- Building a permanent Network Support Facility (NSF)
- Moving underground and above ground services.

Northbound traffic maintained</li> <li>— Overnight road closure between Kingston Road and Madden Road for up to four nights from mid-July to late-July</li> <li>— Overnight road closure between Kingston Road and Madden Road for up to 2 nights for traffic barrier movements in early-July.</li> <li>— Changed traffic conditions, with traffic management and detours in place</li> <li>— Moderate levels of noise, vibration, light and dust</li> </ul>
TBM launch site, Clarinda	🕒 Ongoing to late-2025	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>— Building the Clarinda TBM launch site, including civil works, backfilling of ponds, d-walling and ground improvement</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>— Changed traffic conditions on Peace Road and Victory Road</li> <li>— Moderate levels of noise, vibration, light and dust</li> <li>— Increased truck movements day and night</li> </ul>

## Impacts

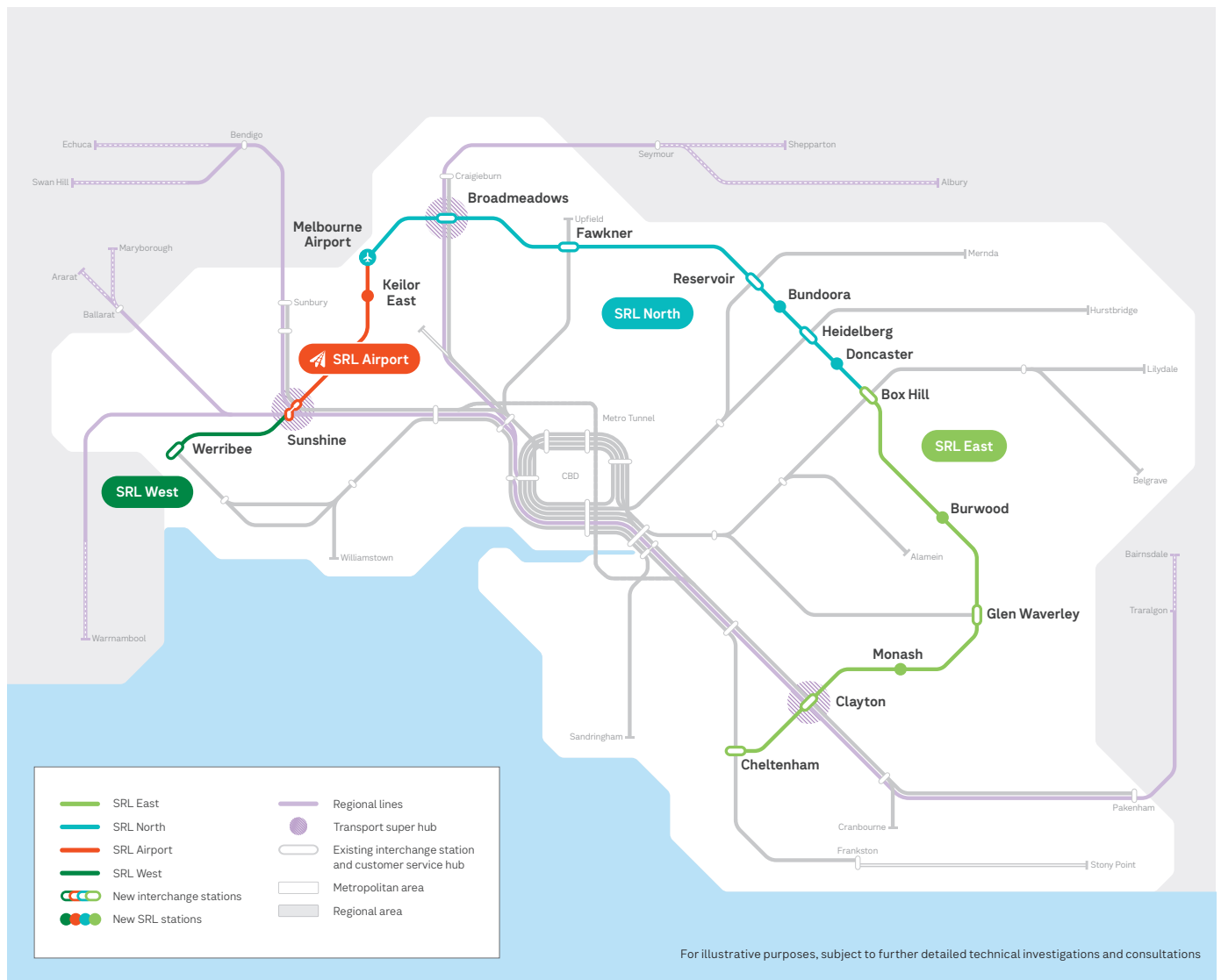
As with all major infrastructure projects, surrounding communities may experience some impacts during construction. The Project supports businesses and residents to continue to live, work, study and shop in their community.

- Covering trucks to minimise dust
- Monitoring noise, dust and vibration levels
- Using noise blankets and hoarding to minimise noise, dust and light spill
- Safely removing hazardous materials in accordance with regulations
- Using water and dust suppressants
- Maintaining access to homes and businesses.
