

Heatherton and Clarinda works update

July 2025

Works are underway in Heatherton and Clarinda to deliver Suburban Rail Loop (SRL) East for Melbourne and Victoria.

What we are doing

Stabling Facility, Heatherton

- Building the Eastern Tunnel Entrance (ETE) and Western Tunnel Entrance (WTE)
- Building a permanent Network Support Facility (NSF)
- Moving underground and above ground services.

Oay works

7am – 6pm Monday to Friday and 7am – 1pm Saturday

Extended works

6pm – 10pm Monday to Saturday

Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM) launch site, Clarinda

- Building the Clarinda Tunnel Access Structure (TAS)
- Connecting underground services.

Night works

6pm – 7am Monday to Sunday

24-hour works

7am – 7am Monday to Sunday

Stabling Facility west, Heatherton	© Ongoing to late-2025 ▲ Early-July to late-2025	 Building the WTE including office mobilisation, earthworks, concreting, commence guide wall construction, compacting, drainage works, machinery assembly, piling and hoarding installation Site investigations Safe removal of hazardous material 	 To safely deliver works, some construction activities including concrete pouring will need to be undertaken until 10pm Workers in specialised protective clothing as we continue safe removal of hazardous materials Moderate levels of noise, vibration, light and dust Increased truck movements and delivery of large machinery for up to three nights

Kingston Road, Heatherton	♥ Ongoing to late-July 2025	 Moving and connecting underground and above ground services Traffic barrier movements Site deliveries via Kingston Road 	 Westbound lanes closed between Old Dandenong Road and Dingley Bypass ongoing to early-July No right turn onto Old Dandenong Road ongoing to early-July Overnight road closures between Nicholas Grove and Dingley Bypass for traffic barrier movements at times from early-July to late-July Changed traffic conditions day and night between Golf View Road and Clayton Road with traffic management and detours in place Moderate levels of noise, vibration, light and dust Changes to 631 bus route including closure of some bus stops between Nicholas Grove and Clayton Road Visit ptv.vic.gov.au to plan your journey
Old Dandenong Road, Heatherton	♥ Ongoing to late-2025	 Moving and connecting underground services Road reinstatement Traffic barrier movements 	 Southbound closure and northbound lane closure between Kingston Road and Madden Road ongoing to early-July. Northbound traffic maintained Overnight road closure between Kingston Road and Madden Road for up to four nights from mid-July to late-July Overnight road closure between Kingston Road and Madden Road for up to 2 nights for traffic barrier movements in early-July. Changed traffic conditions, with traffic management and detours in place Moderate levels of noise, vibration, light and dust
TBM launch site, Clarinda	② Ongoing to late-2025	 Building the Clarinda TBM launch site, including civil works, backfilling of ponds, d-walling and ground improvement 	 Changed traffic conditions on Peace Road and Victory Road Moderate levels of noise, vibration, light and dust Increased truck movements day and night

Impacts


As with all major infrastructure projects, surrounding communities may experience some impacts during construction. The Project supports businesses and residents to continue to live, work, study and shop in their community.

- Using water and dust suppressants
- Maintaining access to homes and businesses.
