Works notice



Overnight Asphalting

Victoria Street

8 to 12 July 2025

From 8 to 12 July we will asphalt Victoria Street to reinstate the westbound traffic lanes and southern footpath between Cardigan and Swanston streets.



When we'll be working

To safely complete these works and minimise disruption to traffic on Victoria Street the road works will take place overnight, **9:30pm** to **2:30am**

- Westbound lane closures:
 9:30pm Tuesday 8 July to
 2:30am Saturday 12 July
- Southern footpath closure:
 24 hours Tuesday 8 July to
 Friday 11 July.

The timing of work may change depending on weather.

What we'll be doing

- Closing the westbound lanes of Victoria Street between Russell and Swanston streets overnight to:
 - Remove parts of the existing road surface and lay new asphalt along sections of the westbound lanes
 - Install car detector loops in asphalt at intersections and pedestrian crossings
 - Line marking
- Closing the southern Victoria Street footpath between Franklin and Swanston streets during the day and night to remove parts of the existing footpath surface and lay new asphalt.

What to be aware of

- All westbound lanes on Victoria Street will be closed between Russell and Swanston streets during these works
- Detours will be in place during the westbound closure, via Lygon, Queensbury and Bouverie streets (see map)
- A pedestrian detour will be in place via the northern footpath on Victoria Street or the Franklin Street northern footpath (see map)
- Traffic controllers in place to assist with the changes to access
- Car detector loop installation takes approximately an hour per location and can generate periods of high level noise during the cutting of asphalt to install the detector loop
- Removing the existing road surface and laying new asphalt are expected to generate periods of low to medium levels of noise.


