Shepparton Line Upgrade – Signalling Upgrades

Shepparton Line Upgrade is delivering more frequent and reliable services on modern VLocity trains.

Coaches will replace trains for all or part of the journey on the Shepparton and Seymour lines, from **Sunday, 7 September to Tuesday, 16 September**. Works during this time will help us prepare for commissioning the line's new signalling system later in the year.

What we're doing

- Signalling works will take place between Shepparton and Seymour, 24 hours a day while coaches replace trains.
- Installation of a new radio communications tower in the Seymour Station precinct. This will include:
 - crane assembly and lifting sections of the communications tower
 - excavation and concrete pouring
 - crushed rock installation for maintenance walkway
 - retaining wall and staircase installation.

What to expect

- An increase in heavy vehicle movements while we transport materials and equipment.
- Potential increase in lighting and noise while we work day and night.
- Traffic management in place for the safety of road users and work crews.

Changes to the way you travel

- Coaches will replace trains for all or part of the journey on the Shepparton and Seymour lines between **Sunday 7 September and Tuesday 16 September**. Please plan ahead by visiting vline.com.au
