Franklin Street bike lane works

Franklin Street

22 to 24 September

We are installing green paint in the bike lanes to improve safety.



When we'll be working

- During the night from **6pm to 4am, Monday 22 and Tuesday 23 September**
- There will be limited vehicle access to Franklin Street during night works. Vehicle access will be maintained outside of these dates and during the day.

The timing of work may change due to weather.

What we'll be doing

- Setting up the site.
- Installing the green paint in the bike lanes
- Ensuring bike lanes remain clear during paint drying times.

What to be aware of

- We are installing green paint in the bike lanes on Franklin Street to increase visibility and improve safety
- These works may produce low to medium levels of noise

- The works will occur in two stages to reduce access impacts to each building to a single night only (see map)
- To safely carry out these works, bollards will be set up on the footpath and the bicycle lanes will be closed
- During night works, pedestrians can only cross Franklin Street at the dedicated pedestrian crossings at Elizabeth and Swanston streets
- Pedestrian access to businesses and residential buildings will be maintained at all times.

Stage one - 22 September

- Franklin Street will be closed overnight between Freeman Drive and Swanston Street for one night from 6pm to 4am on 22 September
- During these times, no vehicles will be able to access Franklin Street between Stewart and Swanston Street including for deliveries and waste collection
- Access to the Milano building car park will be via Therry Street on the night of 23 September
- Access to Stewart Street will be maintained via A'Beckett Street
- Franklin Street between Elizabeth Street and Freeman Drive will be open.

Stage two - 23 September

- Franklin Street will be closed overnight between Elizabeth Street and Freeman Drive for one night from 6pm to 3 September with Franklin Street reopening fully from 4am on 24 September
- During these times, no vehicles will be able to access Franklin Street between Elizabeth and Stewart streets including for deliveries and waste collection
- Access to the 58 Franklin Street car park will be via Therry Street on the night of 23 September under the direction of traffic control
- Access to the Milano building car park and Stewart Street will be maintained from Swanston Street to the Milano building car park and to Stewart Street.

Where we'll be working

- Franklin Street between Elizabeth and Swanston streets.




