

# Heatherton and Clarinda works update

## November 2025

Works are underway in Heatherton and Clarinda to deliver Suburban Rail Loop (SRL) East for Melbourne and Victoria.

#### What we are doing

#### Train stabling facility, Heatherton

- Building the eastern tunnel entrance (ETE) and western tunnel entrance (WTE)
- Building a permanent network support facility (NSF)
- Moving underground and above ground services.

#### Tunnel boring machine (TBM) launch site, Clarinda

- Building the Clarinda tunnel access structures (TAS)
- Connecting underground services.

6pm – 10pm Monday to Friday and 1pm – 10pm Saturday

#### Night works

6pm – 7am Monday to Sunday

Kingston Road, Heatherton	<b>⋄ o</b> Ongoing to late 2025	<ul> <li>Road reinstatement</li> <li>Lighting installation</li> <li>Moving and connecting underground and above ground services</li> <li>Traffic barrier movements</li> <li>Hoarding construction</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Intermittent overnight road closures from Nicholas Grove to Clayton Road from late October to late November for up to 7 nights</li> <li>Eastbound lane closure between Dingley Bypass and Clayton Road from early November for up to six weeks</li> <li>Changed traffic conditions between Nicholas Grove and Clayton Road with traffic management in place until early 2026</li> <li>Changes to 631 bus route including closure of some bus stops between Nicholas Grove and Clayton Road</li> <li>Access to homes and businesses will be maintained</li> <li>Moderate levels of noise, vibration, light and dust</li> <li>Visit ptv.vic.gov.au and bigbuild.vic.gov.au/disruptions to plan your journey</li> </ul>
TBM launch site, Clarinda	<b>⊗</b> Ongoing to late 2025	<ul> <li>Building the Clarinda TBM launch site, including civil works, concrete slab construction, diaphragm wall construction, piling and ground improvement</li> <li>Moving and connecting underground services</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Changed traffic conditions on Victory Road</li> <li>Peace Road entry at Kingston Road closed from late October for up to six weeks. Entry to Peace Road via Victory Road</li> <li>Moderate levels of noise, vibration, light and dust</li> <li>Truck movements day and night</li> </ul>

#### **Impacts**


As with all major infrastructure projects, surrounding communities may experience some impacts during construction. The Project supports businesses and residents to continue to live, work, study and shop in their community.


