The Metro Tunnel is the biggest upgrade of Melbourne's train network since the City Loop opened in 1981.

The Metro Tunnel includes new rail tunnels under Melbourne's CBD, stopping at five new underground train stations.

It will mean all Victorians will benefit from new train connections to key destinations, including:

- The Royal Melbourne Hospital, Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre and the University of Melbourne via Parkville Station.
- St Kilda Road near the Shrine of Remembrance. Royal Botanic Gardens, and Albert Park, via Anzac Station.

Geelong Line Upgrade

The Geelong Line Upgrade, completed in 2024, has enabled more new services to be added to the line and many existing services to be extended to start and finish at Waurn Ponds.

Improvements for Geelong Line passengers in the past decade have included:

New train stabling yard in Waurn Ponds and 8km of new duplicated track.



2,400 regional train services delivered each week. That's a 55% increase since 2015.



Regional fares capped, saving passengers over \$40 on return long-distance V/Line journeys.
