# The biggest ever investment in Melbourne's north east

Victoria's longest road tunnels will fix the missing link in Melbourne's freeway network. We'll also complete the M80 Ring Road in Greensborough and overhaul the Eastern Freeway. These three major projects will take 15,000 trucks a day off local roads, and reduce travel times by up to 35 minutes across the north east.



The Ring Road Completion will seamlessly connect the M80 Ring Road to the North East Link tunnels, passing through traffic under a new Grimshaw Street interchange and two new landscaped bridges at Elder Street and Watsonia Road.
