

- In another major milestone for our project, Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM) Vida has started digging the 2.8km citybound West Gate Tunnel.
- Vida's journey will take about 12 months, with the tunnel meeting up with the West Gate Freeway just west of Williamstown Road.

Community Liaison Group Survey Results





West Gate Neighbourhood Fund

- WGNF Grants R1: 26 of 28 grants have funding deeds in place and have received first payments
- GJ Hosken Reserve: Project completion event confirmed for 19 June
- South Kingsville Community: Internal works have been completed, external works underway and due for completion this month. Proposed event once works complete
- Outdoor Education Foundation: Together We Grow camp took place 19-28 April, with Graduation celebration taking place 29 April
- Wynspeak: The Hobsons Bay Heat was held on Thursday 5th May at Altona theatre
- Greening Brooklyn: Met with HBCC on 21 April and the 12 May.
- Cinespace: Funding Deed in place. Purchase of new property in Footscray confirmed, with settlement in June. Other Funding Sources confirmed with executed Funding Agreements in from Creative Victoria and DFFH.
- Pacific Connections: Annual Faamaopoopo Mai Expo took place Friday 22 April at Williamstown



West Gate Freeway widening Stage 4

Millers Road Early Exit

- From early June, drivers travelling west to exit at Millers Road will need to enter the correct lane shortly after the West Gate Bridge.
- Because the majority of the lanes will have all been shifted north, a ramp around the southern outbound tunnel exit will be used to take traffic to Millers Road.
- Drivers will need to be in the correct lane before the Williamstown Road exit.
- This set up will be in place until April 2023.




STAGE 4 - PAVEMENT RECONSTRUCTION AROUND TUNNEL

- Letter drops to residents within local areas



Paringa Road

- To enable re-opening of Paringa Road, noise wall length would be reduced at the eastern end of the road.
- Discussions have commenced with property owners who would be affected due to noise increases and would require off reservation noise attenuation





M80 Ramp Closures

Closures: The M80 to the West Gate Freeway citybound, and the Princes Freeway to Geelong Road citybound will be closed 24/7 for a whole weekend

Timing: From 9pm Friday 27th May to 5am Monday 30th May (next three weekend as contingency except the Queen's Birthday long weekend) **Why:** To install permanent railings on the M80 ramp which goes over the top of the Geelong Road ramp. For safety reasons, both are required to be closed

Delays: Approx 10 mins (this is based on a conservative estimate from summer roadworks in 2021 when both were closed at the same time and the additional travel time in the weekday peaks was between 8 and 11 minutes)




Footscray Road / elevated roadway





Harris Street





- Harris Street opened from Cowper Street on 14 April.
- Access restored to pedestrians from Yarraville Gardens.
- Utility relocations are progressing through to May.
- Site will be handed over to council from May.
- Harris Street will become one way, east to west.




MAJOR TRANSPORT INFRASTRUCTURE





Wurundjeri Way Extension









Inbound Tunnel Progress "Vida"



- Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM) Vida is now on her way digging the 2.8km inbound tunnel.
- Vida commenced boring on Monday 25th April and has reached 300m mid-May.
- Vida's journey will take 12 months, with the tunnel meeting up with the West Gate Freeway just west of Williamstown Road.



Outbound Tunnel Progress "Bella"

- First TBM, Bella has reached over 650m of tunnel bored.
- Further rolling notifications sent to properties near the intersection of Hyde Street and York Street on 05 May.
- Bella and Vida are the largest TBMs in the Southern Hemisphere - each measuring 15.6m in diameter and 90m long and weighing 4000 tonnes each, which is about the same as 20 Boeing 747 airplanes






Tunnelling - Engagement


- In total we've delivered already 102 rolling notifications to residents for both TBMs.

- Great to have Minister for Transport Infrastructure Jacinta Allan came for a visit on April 26 for the TBM Vida launch.








Transport of soil



Trucks leaving pivot site









Hi-Quality spoil testing results

- Results published at https://www.epa.vic.gov.au/forcommunity/current-projectsissues/west-gate-tunnel-project
- Hi-Quality started receiving soil from the project in early March 2022. It is subject to a rigorous testing process.
- The EPA approved environmental management plan (EMP) for the Bulla Spoils Facility specifies clear limits for PFAS and other contaminants.
- Testing results are provided to EPA by the 21st day of the following month
