

## Works Notification

### Excavation and out of hours works McNab Avenue, Footscray

**October - December 2022**

As part of the Sunbury Line Upgrade, we are delivering power upgrades that will allow bigger, more modern trains to run on the Sunbury Line. We're upgrading substations in Footscray to improve the capacity, reliability and frequency of services for passengers.

To support power upgrade works, we will temporarily close a section of Railway Reserve park and establish a small project site compound.

#### What we are doing

##### Excavation and site establishment works

- Establishing a small project site compound to allow for excavation works to take place within Railway Reserve park
- Non-destructive digging (NDD) to investigate ground conditions and confirm the location of existing underground services
- Installing temporary fencing and closing a section of the footpath in Railway Reserve park
- Reinstating the garden beds and pedestrian pathway in Railway Reserve park following excavation works

##### Out of hours works

- Pulling and connecting new cables from electrical equipment in the Hyde Street commuter car park at Footscray Station to the existing Footscray substation on McNab Avenue
- More information will be provided about these works at a later date.

##### Excavation and site establishment works

Monday 3 October to Friday 18 November 2022

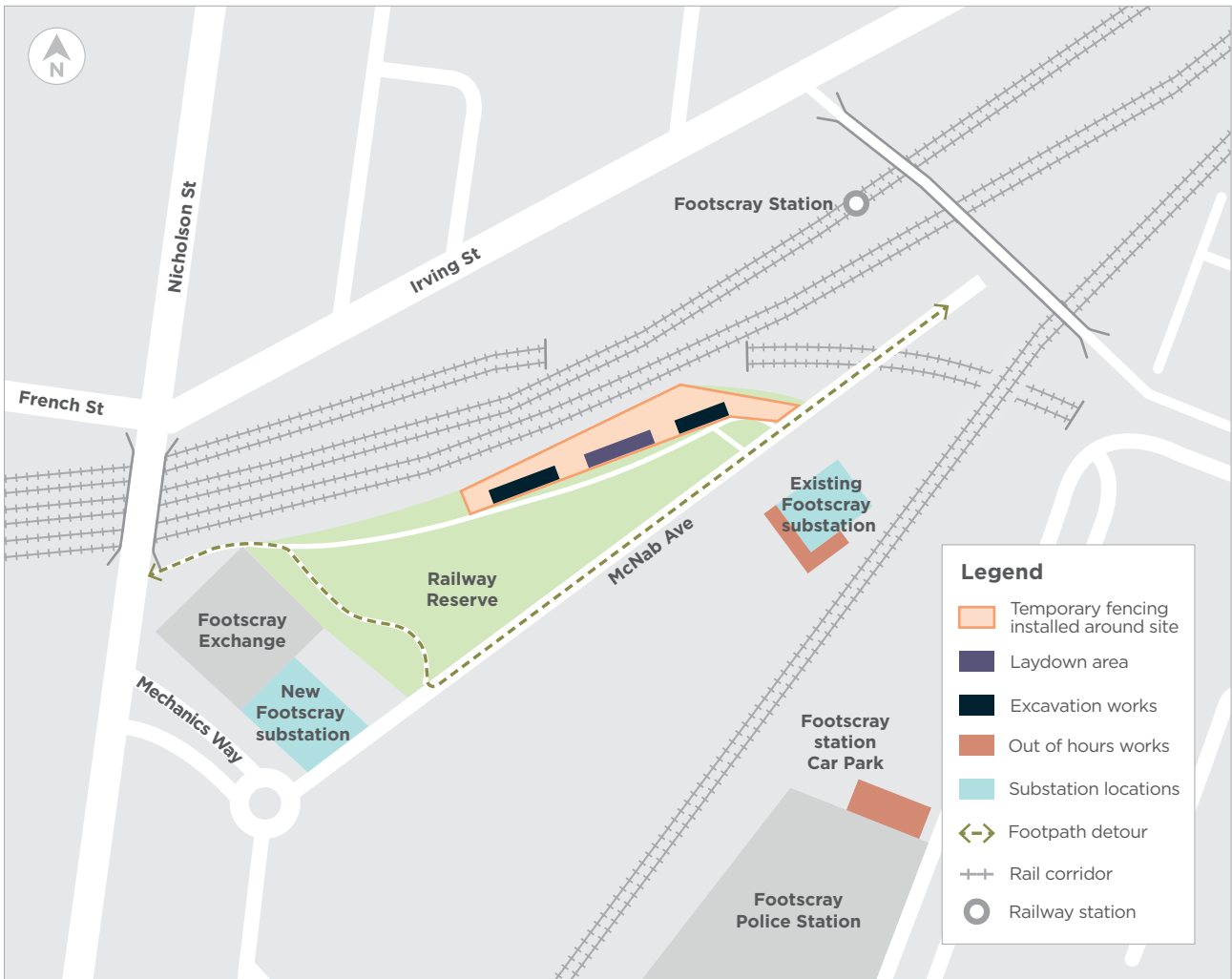
- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 7am to 1pm, Saturdays

##### Out of hours works

- From 6pm Friday 18 November to 6am Monday 21 November
- From 6pm Friday 25 November to 6am Monday 28 November
- From 6pm Friday 4 December to 6am Monday 7 December

##### What to be aware of

- These works are expected to generate medium to high levels of noise and dust
- Pedestrian detours and wayfinding signage will be in place along McNab Avenue to safely guide people to and from Footscray Station
- Pedestrian access to Footscray Station will be maintained at all times
- Temporarily removing small sections of asphalt and a garden bed within Railway Reserve park, that will be reinstated once excavation works are complete
- During this time there will be an increase in construction vehicles accessing McNab Avenue. Traffic controllers will be present at times to assist with vehicle, pedestrian and cyclist movements around the area
