Changes today, better transport tomorrow

Work is well underway for the future of Sunbury, with major changes already improving the local road and rail network.



Gap Road has reopened to traffic

Transforming road and rail transport in Sunbury

We've reached a major milestone with the removal of Sunbury's worst traffic bottleneck – the level crossing at Gap Road.

With the new rail bridge built and excavation of dirt underneath complete, the new road underpass opened to traffic on 30 September.

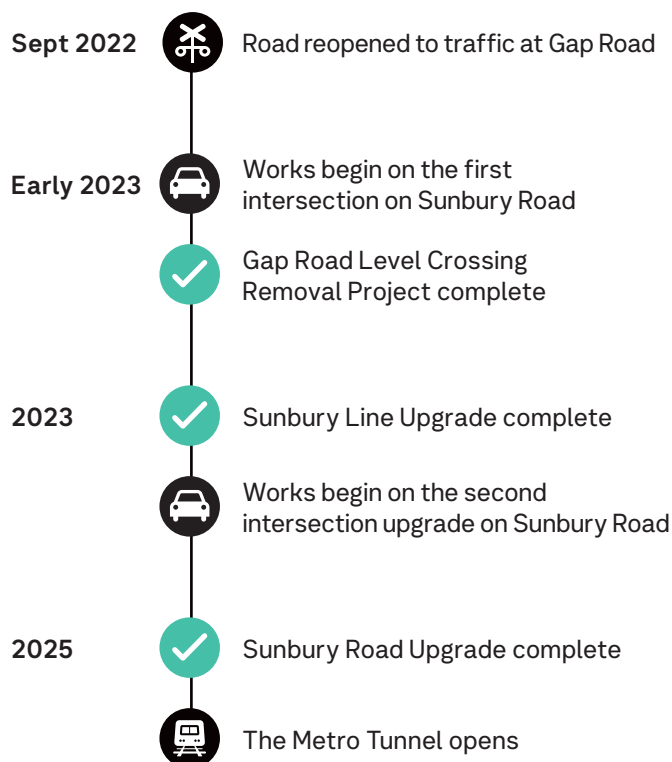
The underpass features separated cycling and walking paths to safely connect the growing Sunbury community. Major construction is complete, but landscaping and minor finishing works will continue into early 2023.

Meanwhile, we're on track to complete works upgrading the Sunbury Line in 2023. The Sunbury Line Upgrade is preparing the Sunbury rail corridor for bigger, more modern trains that will run through the Metro Tunnel when it opens in 2025. It will enable a train every five minutes on the Sunbury Line and save up to 40 minutes a day on a return journey to Parkville for Sunbury Line passengers.

Construction is also ramping up on the Sunbury Road Upgrade, with barriers being installed in the coming months along the entire stretch of road so work can begin on building additional lanes, new intersections, and a new bridge over Jacksons Creek.

Work on the new bridge is expected to start before the end of 2022, and combined with the widened Sunbury Road, will double the capacity from two to four lanes and improve the flow of traffic once complete in 2025.

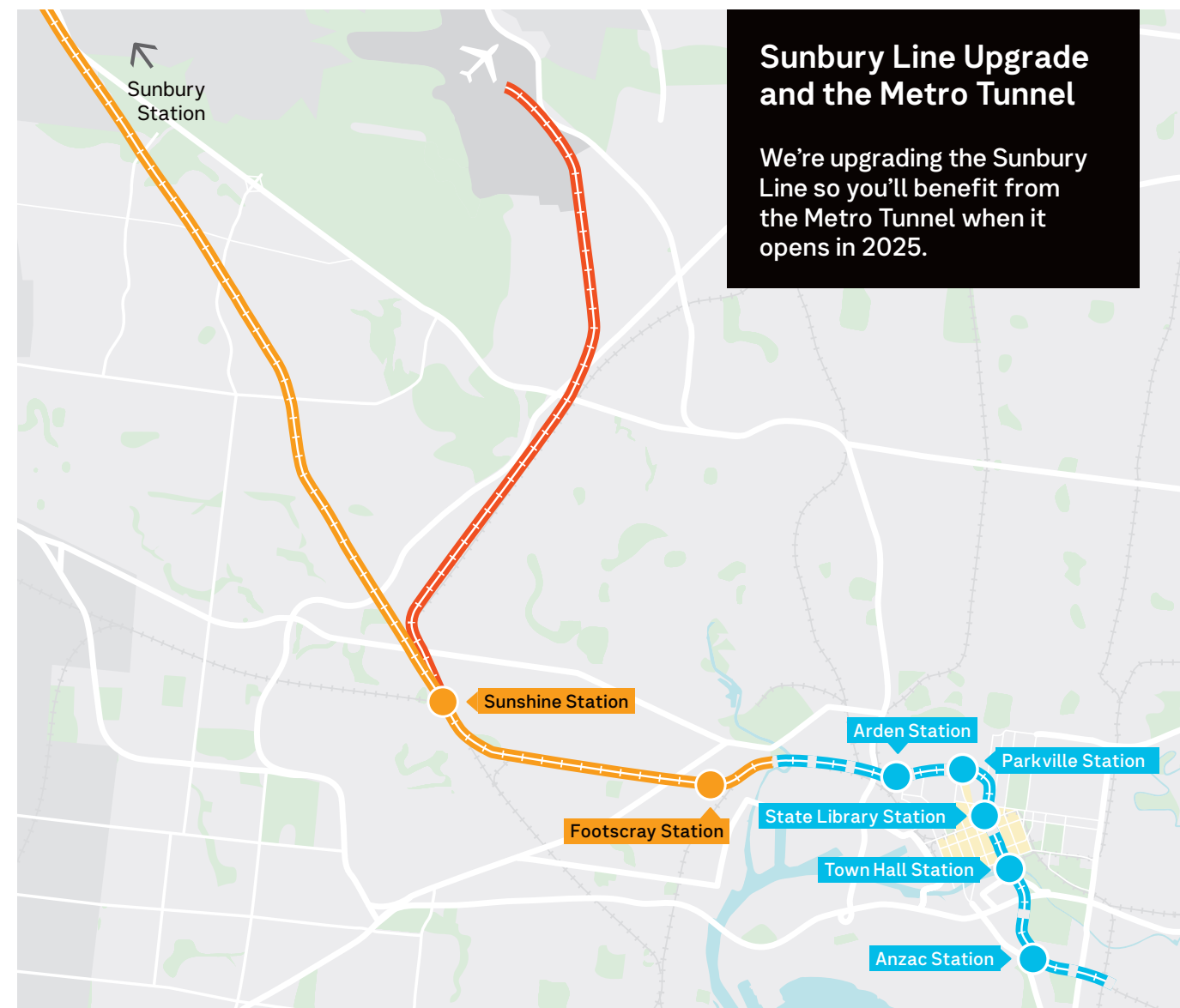
Sunbury Road Upgrade

There will be lane closures and speed reductions as required on Sunbury Road between Powlett Street and Bulla-Diggers Rest Road until late 2022.

Footpaths along Sunbury Road, near Jacksons Creek, will be closed from Powlett Street to Francis Boulevard until July 2023, and under Jacksons Creek Bridge until March 2024.

New Sunbury Station car park

Good news for commuters, with plans approved for the new Sunbury Station car park. Located on Evans Street, the new multi-storey car park will have room for 300 vehicles as well as more bicycle parking facilities.



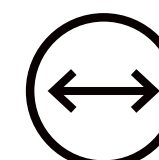
A train every five minutes on the Sunbury Line
