

SUNBURY ROAD UPGRADE

DECEMBER 2022



We're adding extra lanes and improving safety on Sunbury Road.

Construction of the new Melbourne bound lanes between Bulla-Diggers Rest/Loemans Road and Shepherds Lane is almost complete. We'll move traffic onto these new lanes later this year once asphaltting on this section of road is finished.

See inside for detailed information on how we will move traffic.

We'll then start works to rehabilitate the existing Sunbury bound lanes.

We're also well progressed with piling for the new bridge over Jacksons Creek and we'll be lifting bridge beams into place early next year.

The temporary roundabouts at Francis Boulevard and Lancefield Road were completed in November so work on upgrading the intersections to traffic lights could begin.

Major work including 24/7 works will start on the Lancefield Road

intersection in January 2023 and at Francis Boulevard later next year.

To complete these works safely, there will be long term changes to the way you travel including road closures, lane changes, speed reductions and detours.

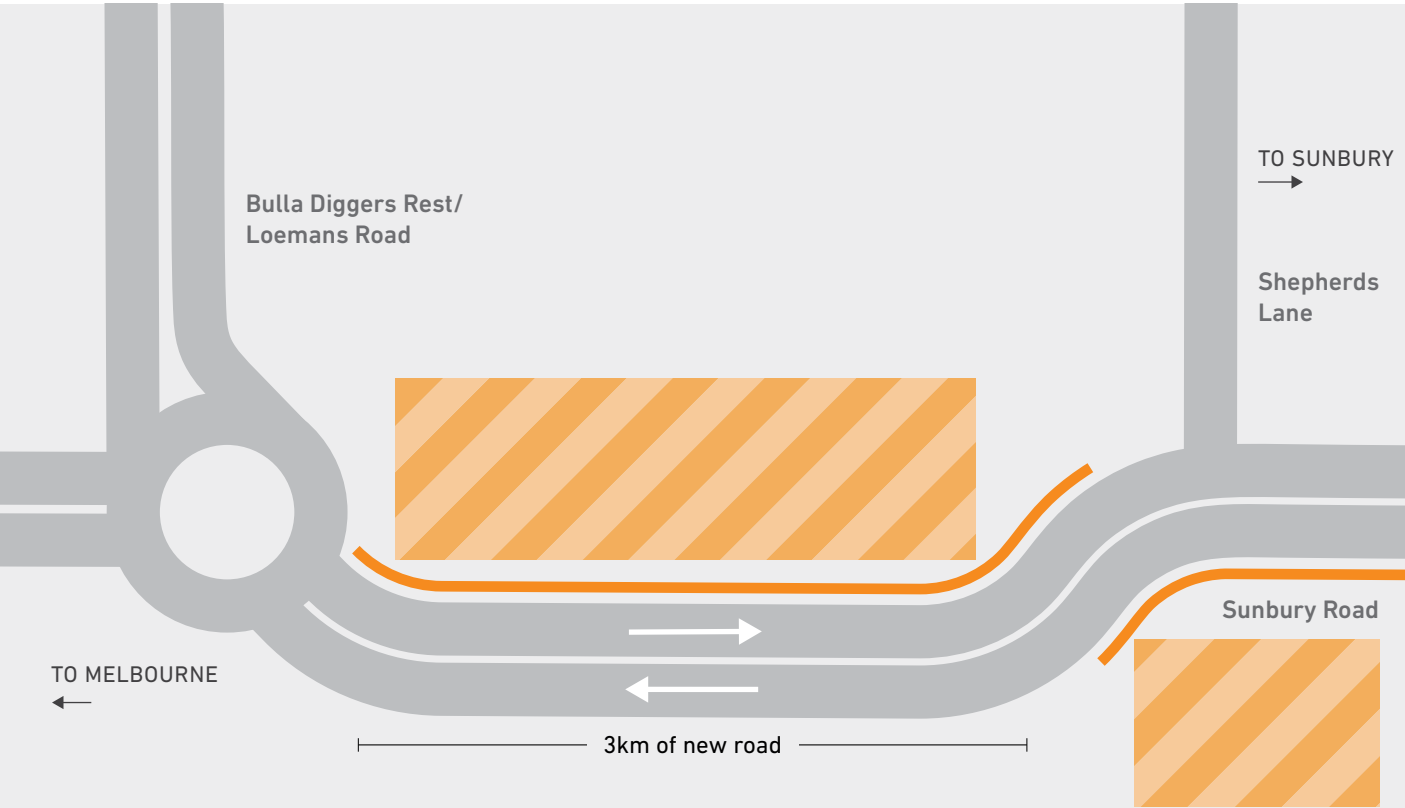

Traffic will be moving to new lanes

We'll be moving traffic onto the newly built lanes between Bulla-Diggers Rest/Loemans Road to Shepherds Lane later this year. One lane in each direction will be open while we continue to build the Melbourne bound lanes and start rebuilding the Sunbury bound lanes.

Construction blitz

From **3 January to early February**, we'll close Lancefield Road at the intersection of Sunbury Road.

We'll be working day and night to complete three months of disruptive works in weeks.

This includes:

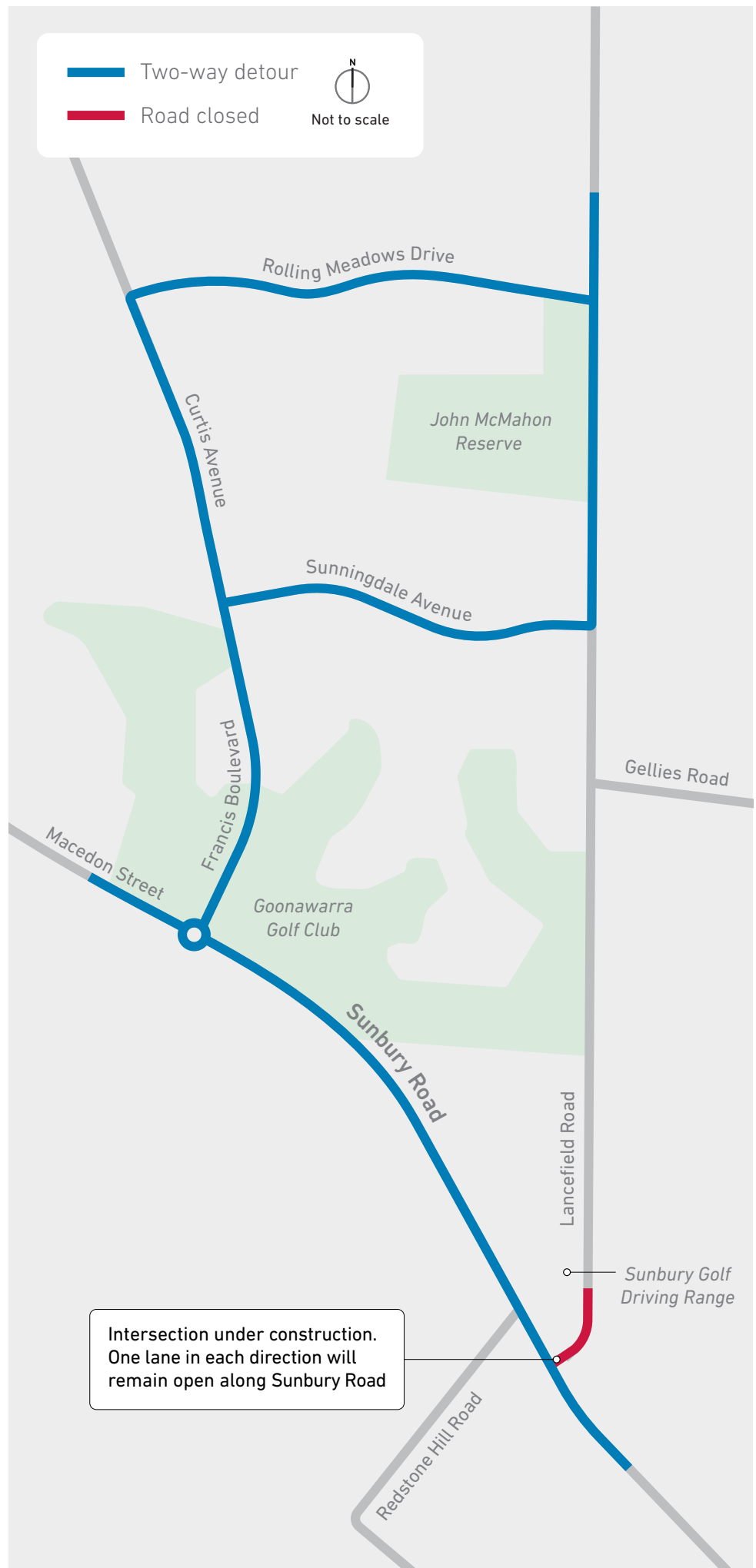
- earthworks
- installing new drainage and a new water main on the south side of Sunbury Road
- installing public lighting, guard rails, road signs, traffic lights and linemarking
- building new pavement, walking and cycling paths.

While the 24/7 construction blitz will cause disruptions to the community, working this way is a better alternative to smaller closures spread out over many months. Additionally, our work is being undertaken during a time of reduced traffic during school holidays.

Bridge beam lift

We'll close Sunbury Road in both directions between Francis Boulevard and Powlett Street early next year for three nights to safely lift the 38 metre long bridge beams into place and get ready to build the bridge deck. Detours will be in place. Bus service 486 will be impacted after 8.30pm
