

Buses replace trains on the Hurstbridge Line

March and April 2023



We're busy on the Hurstbridge Line

As part of Victoria's Big Build, we're delivering further improvements, including more train services, less crowding on peak trains and better connections to public transport in Melbourne's north east.

While you're on the bus, crews will work around the clock building new modern stations at Greensborough and Montmorency. Teams will also work to duplicate the track between Greensborough and Montmorency and Diamond Creek and Wattle Glen.

During this time, planned maintenance works and upgrades that keep the railway running safely and reliably for passengers will also take place.

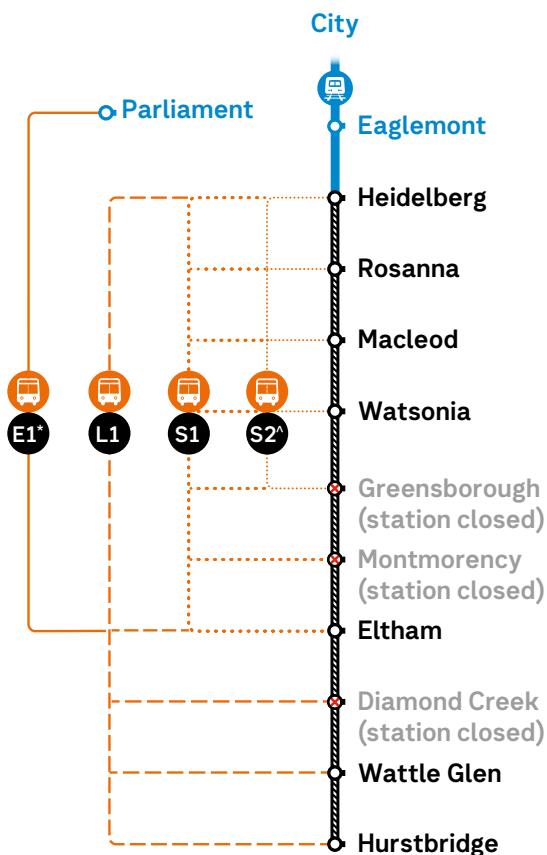

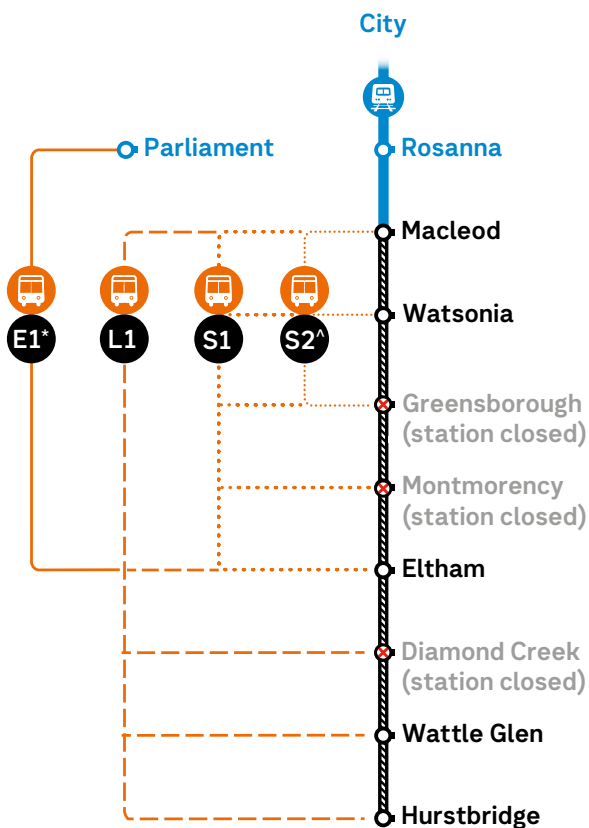

Station Closures

Greensborough, Montmorency and Diamond Creek stations will close from **9pm Thursday 16 March to 3am Sunday 30 April**.

At Diamond Creek Station myki facilities remain open at the entrance to Platform 1.

The new Greensborough and Montmorency stations will open and 2.5km of duplicated rail track along sections of the line when trains resume on **Sunday 30 April**. Works will continue on final touches for parking and around station precincts **until mid-2023**.

Changes to travel – pedestrian and parking

There will be changes to car parking across Greensborough, Montmorency and Diamond Creek stations from **Tuesday 21 February to Friday 5 May**.

There will also be access changes and pedestrian crossing closures at these stations from **Monday 6 March to Sunday 30 May**.

Travelling on a replacement bus

Accessibility

Most train replacement buses will be low-floor models to assist passengers.

If you need help or cannot board a replacement bus, please contact PTV, prior to travelling, on **1800 800 007** or speak to our staff at the bus stop for alternative transport arrangements at no cost.

Bikes and pets

Bicycles, dogs (with the exception of animals identified by an Assistance Animal Pass) and surfboards are not allowed on train replacement buses.

Ticketing

Where possible, you should touch on and off at the beginning and end of your journey.

When catching train replacement buses, you can touch on and off at your connecting train station.
