

Works notice

Out of hour works and Childers Street closure Childers Street, Kensington

Between Tuesday 28 March and Thursday 30 March 2023, between 11pm and 6am

The final sections of track slab have been laid in the tunnels and in late March the track form gantries used to install these track slabs within the tunnels will be removed from the western portal tunnel entrance.

Between Tuesday 28 March and Thursday 30 March, Childers Street will close for one night to enable the removal of a gantry from the western tunnel entrance. These works will take place for approximately 3 hours between 11pm and 6am and require the use of an oversized truck.

What we are doing

- Setting up traffic control on the corner of Kensington Road and Childers Street and on the corner of Childers and Tennyson streets
- Closing Childers Street for three hours between Tuesday 28 March and Thursday 30 March between 11pm and 6am
- Removing a track form gantry from the western portal tunnel entrance and lifting the gantry onto an oversized load truck.

What to be aware of

- Between Tuesday 28 March and Thursday 30
 March for one night between 11pm and 6am,
 there will be no vehicle access into Childers
 Street from Tennyson Street, Kensington Road or
 Hobsons Road
- A traffic detour will be in place via Kensington Road, Derby and Tennyson streets
- The truncation on Tennyson Street will be temporarily removed to enable access to the Lloyd Street Business Estate
- Access to properties will be maintained
- Pedestrian access to South Kensington Station will be maintained.

When

 One night, between Tuesday 28 March and Thursday 30 March, for three hours between 11pm and 6am.
