Reinstatement and public realm works

Royal Parade eastern footpath, between Genetics Lane and Grattan Street

Mid-May to late June 2023

The Parkville Station precinct is moving into the final phase of construction with reinstatement and public realm works now underway.

Throughout the Parkville precinct, staged reinstatement and public realm works are ongoing until early 2024. These works include service relocations, footpath, kerb and road pavement construction, traffic signal modifications, and the installation of bus stops, street furniture, lighting and landscaping.

Reinstatement and public realm works will take place up to property boundaries, including on footpaths and directly adjacent to building entrances and there will be changes to the way you move around the precinct during these works.

On the Royal Parade eastern footpath, between Genetics Lane and Grattan Street, reinstatement and public realm works will take place from mid-May to late June 2023.

What we are doing

- Site establishment including installing traffic barriers, temporary fencing and signage around the perimeter of the work site
- Removing a section of the existing eastern footpath which includes non-destructive digging, excavating and saw cutting
- Installing new service infrastructure, including traffic signal conduits and cables and stormwater drainage
- Landscaping works including installing street furniture such as benches, bollards, signage and bike hoops
- Resurfacing the eastern footpath which involves constructing new kerbs and installing new asphalt pavement.

What to be aware of

- The eastern Royal Parade footpath will be closed between Genetics Lane and Grattan Street for the duration of the works, with pedestrian access maintained via the southbound service lane

- The Royal Parade southbound service lane will be closed between Genetics Lane and Grattan Street until late May, due to adjacent CitiPower works. Due to these works, traffic and cyclists will be directed to the Royal Parade inner lane
- Traffic control will be on site during working hours
- These works are expected to generate periods of medium to high level noise, depending on the work activity
- These works are weather dependent
- Ramp access to the University of Melbourne Building 184 will be via the pedestrian entrance on Medical Road during these works
- Works across the Royal Parade car park and University of Melbourne Gate 11 driveways will be staged and access will be managed by traffic controllers. Further details, including timing, will be provided to directly impacted stakeholders
- Emergency egress for local buildings will be maintained at all times
- The traffic arrangement for these works is subject to change due to endorsement from relevant authorities
- Other Metro Tunnel works are occurring in the Parkville Station precinct. These works may result in additional changes to how pedestrians, cyclists and vehicles use the area. 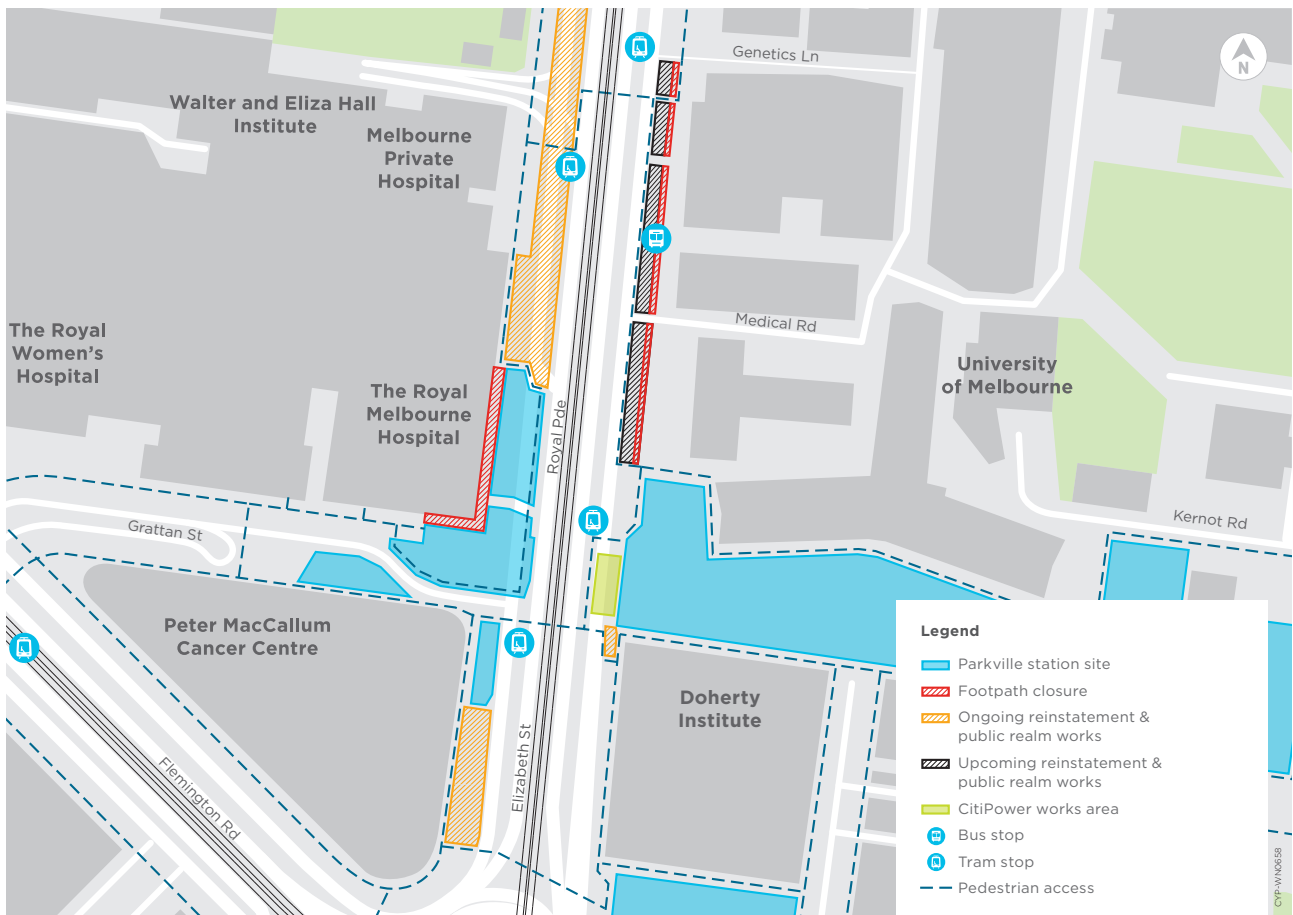
